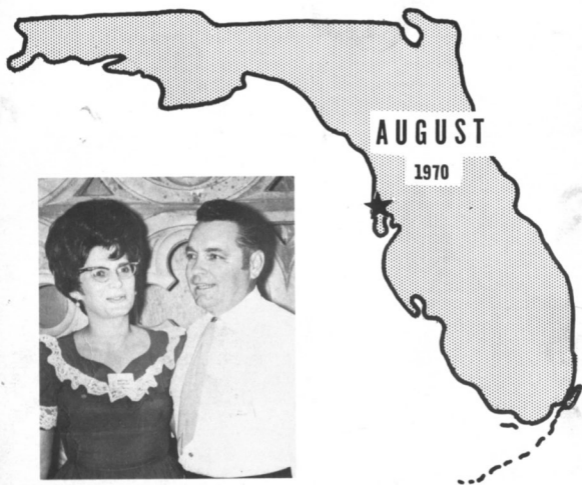

More memories - 1st chairman **BILL MUENCH** heading the organization for 5 years of important growth **JIM GALLOWAY**, chairman now for the past 9 years **KAY MACK**, sec. 14yrs and **HELEN GALLOWAY**, treas. 14yrs with able help from Ruth Muench, Pat McClumpha and Ed Mack.

Our trip to form the charter square is past history now, but the same rules and regulations apply. 4 couples (non-Knotheads) travel the 100 miles, one way to a prearranged dance. More than a square may travel together, but **ALWAYS COUPLES ONLY** (1 male and 1 female) Application blanks and more information may be obtained from Jim Galloway, Lutz, Fla. or Kay Mack, sec Clearwater.

Caller of the Month

ART SPRINGER

Would you believe Art and his taw, Martha, traveled across the ocean to learn to square dance! That's right, they had never been exposed to American square dancing until they were stationed in Wiesbaden, Germany in 1962. There some friends took them to an open house that their square dance club was having, and they were rarin to go when the next class started. Six months after graduation, the club caller, Lloyd Pole, was due to return to the states and conducted a callers's clinic to groom his replacement. Art attended the clinic and was chosen to succeed Lloyd.

When Art's tour was over, he was transferred to Ft. Worth, Texas where he called for 3½ years. He was on the staff of Coffey's College of Squares and Rounds in Mineral Well's, Texas and is past secretary of the North Texas Callers Association.

Then Uncle Sam sent Art to Vietnam for a year to an isolated area where there was no opportunity to square dance. He was glad to get back into the square dance scene at his next assignment in Panama City, Florida.

Two years ago Art retired from the Air Force, and the Springers put their roots down in Martha's hometown--Tampa. They have six children ranging in age from 16 to 6 years old.

Art leads a double life: during the day he's a computer programmer, and at night you'll find him either teaching square dancing in Tampa and Lake Seminole or calling for his clubs in Tampa, Lake Seminole Resort, and Englewood, Florida. He travels around Florida on weekends calling, and carries his rod and reel along in case he finds a good fishing hole on his way.

Round Dance Instructor of The Month



CLIFF AND LORRAINE HENDRICKS,

after thirty years of ballroom dancing, were first exposed to pattern round dancing while watching TV in 1961. The program was coming from Cobo Hall in Detroit, scene of the National that year. Shortly after that they enrolled in a basic round-dance class taught by Dick and Ella Reinsberg. They taught their first class in Michigan and Pensacola, Florida, in 1962.

Following Cliff's retirement, the Hendricks attended several of Frank Hamilton's round-dance leader workshops, starting with Prudhommes in Canada. They also attended round-dance teacher seminars by Manning and Nita Smith at Indiana Beach; Purdue University; College Station, Texas; and Camp Grandview in Alabama. The Hendricks taught at the National in 1966 at Indianapolis, and then they take part in Florida conventions and Round Dance Council workshops, schedule permitting.

Although Cliff calls square dancing three times each week, Lorraine's first love is rounds. Her start at dancing was at the age of 6: toe and ballet until 19, then ballroom until bitten by the round-dance bug. Lorraine teaches two basic round-dance classes each year, and she has one weekly fun and one inter-round-dance. She also teaches rounds at the Cloverleaf Square and Round Dance Club. For the past three years the Hendricks have conducted one square-dance week and one round-dance week at Rainbow Lake Lodge, Brevard, N. C.

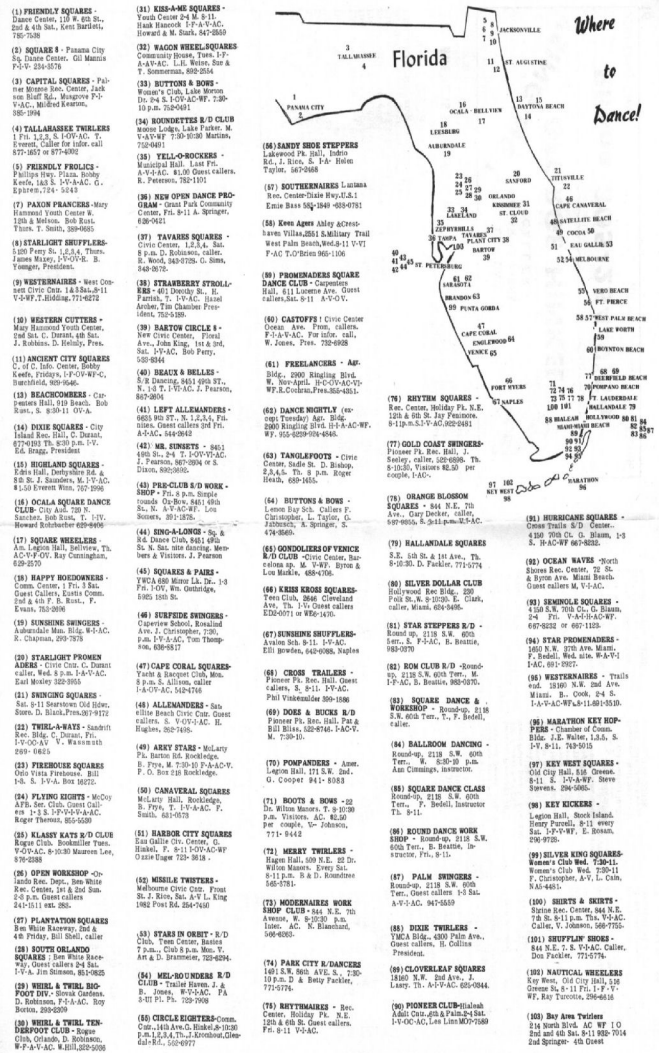

ODDS & ENDS

Here is a recipe for moist, delicious cake slices that can be mixed right in the baking dish.

GOOEY BARS

½ lb. Butter or Oleo (melt)
add
1 cup of Brown Sugar
1 cup of White Sugar
add
4 eggs & mix
add
1 1/3 cup flour -
2 teaspoons Baking Powder
2 teaspoon Vanilla
Mix and add
1 cup Chopped Pecans
Bake about 25 Minutes at 350
375 degrees or until springy
to touch

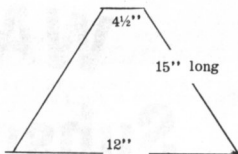
GORED SKIRT

8 GORE SKIRT

4 1/2" at top, 12" at bottom - 32" waist allowing 1/2 on each side for seam allowance.

10 GORE SKIRT

Cut gores skightly smaller and ease in to belt if needed.



Lets try your hand at the above pattern With the 15" length gores I add a ruffle about 9" this of course depends on your own height & does not include the seam or hem allowance. You can use 4 to 6 widths of 36" material cut 12" long this should leave enough for the hem. Cut your gores & sew all together leaving side opening for Zipper. Measure your belt and sew on. For a skirt the belting material sewed into helps hold up better and doesn't tend to curl up. Shire your bottom ruffle & sew to skirt. For a short double ruffle you will have to lengthen the gore and attach 2 rows of ruffles. This is only recommended for the 10" gore skirt, as the width at the bottom of the 8 gore would be too skimpy. Here's to luck on your efforts.
