 2.....Waltz fwd R, L, R drifting apart almost to arm's length as in a "Floatout";
 3.....Raise L hand & keep R hand low as M backs up L, R, L with W wrapping LF to end facing COH & LOD; (NOTE: The action of Meas 3 thru 6 simulates a modified LF closed-pos turning box in wrapped-pos)
 4.....Fwd waltz twd COH;

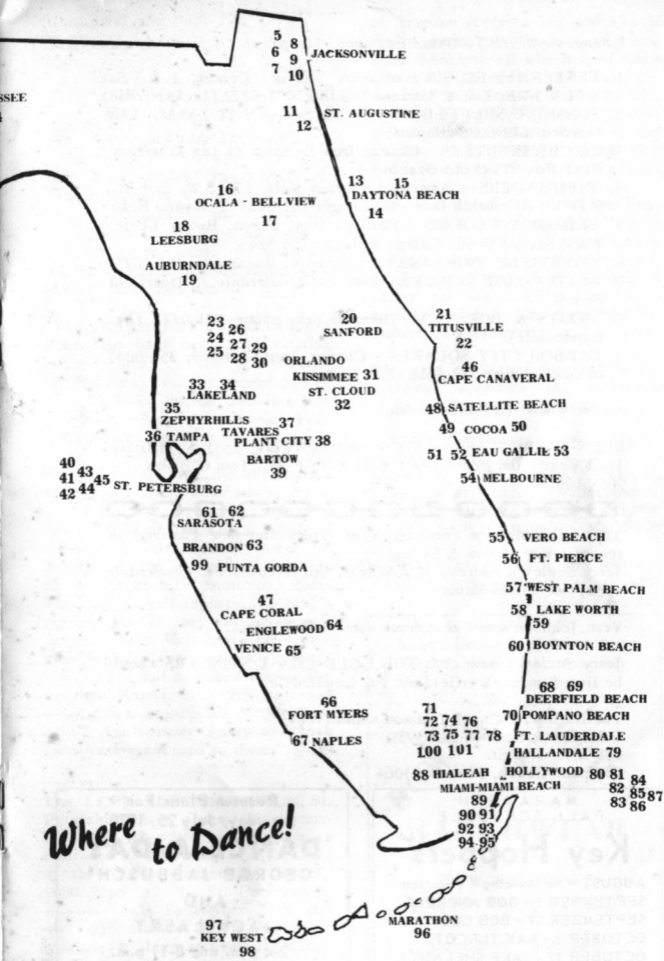

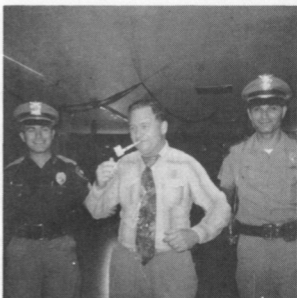

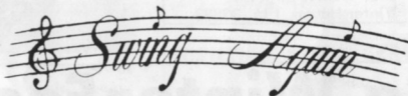
