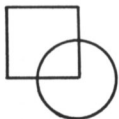

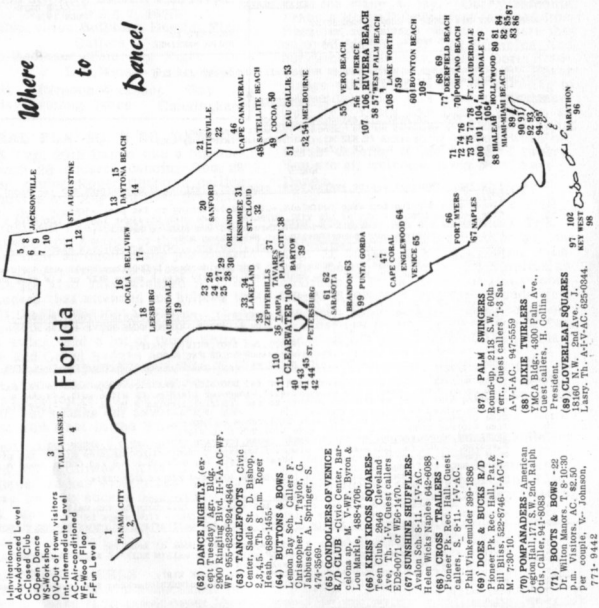

To start off with this month we have a Grand Square Type Gimmick we feel will help the dancers to dance to the beat of the music. It is called the 'Rainbow Stroll' and like the Grand Square, Grand Prowl, Star Prowl and all other Grand Square type movements is real smooth when danced to the beat whether it be a Hoedown and/or Singing Call.

RAINBOW STROLL: By Mac Parker of Arlington, Virginia

Description; From a static square, all dancers facing in all walk forward three steps on fourth step everyone turns alone, man turns Left Face, lady turns Right Face to face out of the square taking corner person as new partner and walk toward corner of the square in three steps and on the fourth step do a California Twirl to face back into the middle of the square. Repeat this action three more times, all dancers end in opposite position facing with original partners. From here it is the callers choice for getting the dancers back to their original home positions. Movement takes 32 counts to complete. Teaching hint; have man start his walk with the Left Foot, the Ladies start on the Right Foot.

If you wish to cue the 'Rainbow Stroll' just call;

RAINBOW STROLL, WALK THREE TURN, WALK THREE TWIRL, WALK THREE TURN, WALK THREE TWIRL, WALK THREE TURN, WALK THREE TWIRL, WALK THREE TURN, WALK THREE TWIRL, LEFT ALLE. ETC...

SCOOT BACK: by Lee Kopman, Long Island, N.Y....Review figure for Oct. 1970.....

Description: From a parallel Ocean Wave Line the dancers facing in step forward and do a Turn Thru and step back into the same Wave they were in while the dancers facing out just simply fold into the vacated spot left by the dancers who did the Turn Thru. This changes the ends to the centers, the centers to the ends. Movement takes four counts. When started from a Left Hand Wave a Left hand Turn Thru is used.

Teaching examples by Lee Kopman;

Heads square thru four hands you do
Make an Ocean Wave and balance too
SCOOT BACK--SCOOT BACK again(Zero)
Box the Gnat, Change hands
Swat the Flea, Left Allemande, etc..

Heads lead right Circle to a Line
Star thru, Do sa do, Make a Wave Rock it too
SCOOT BACK, Swing thru, Girls trade
Square thru 3/4's, Left Allemande, etc...

Following figures by Fred Christopher

Heads square thru four hands you do
Swing thru, Make a Wave, Rock it too
SCOOT BACK, All eight circulate
Turn thru, Left Allemande, etc....

Heads right circle to a line
Dance forward eight, Eight fall back
Spin the top across, Then SCOOT BACK
Boys fold, Peel off, Tag the line right
Wheel & Deal, Square thru 3/4's man
Corners all, Left Allemande, etc...

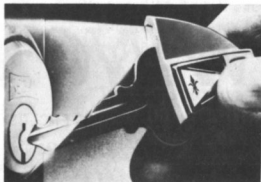
