# Round Dance Instructor of The Month



JIM AND ALINE INFANTINO have been a familiar couple to fellow dancers at square and round-dance ffairs in Florida for over seven 'They entered the picture shortly after the National Square Dance Convention in Miami Beach in 1962, although they were not a-ware of its existence at the time Their participation and eventual leadership in the round-dance field evolved from a series of events perhaps similar to most instructors. Jim enrolled in ballroom classes in 1957 -- he says "he didn't know his left from his right." At Dolly Mc-Dade's Dance Studio in Fitchburg, Mass., where he lived, he soon acquired dancing skills and styling techniques in the more popular rhythms of ballroom dancing.

Aline grew up in Vermont in an environment of country music and quadrilles played, called and danced by members of the family. She was not seriously exposed to ballroom dancing until 1960, having met and married Jim, and moved to Miami where they attended Jack Bell's Dance Studio 4 evenings a week.

In 1960 they went through a course of square-dance basics with Jack Lasry, then joined Ted and Lois Mack's round - dance class where they were still dancing when they began assisting the McIntyres with their round -dance group. After Mr. McIntyre's death the Infantinos were asked to take over the instruction. They taught rounds for the Ox Bows and Dixie Twirlers, eventually forming their own Dixie Bows club.

Jim and Aline were the round-dance instructors for the "Week-end Whirligig" at the DiLido Hotel. Miami Beach, in 1965 and 1966. In 11967 they taught at the State Convention in Jacksonville; this was high lighted by their appearance on T.V. with several round dance leaders of Fla. In 1968 they were chairman of the round dance portion of the State Convention in Miami Beach.

This couple has exhibited round daning at several Miami functions, including Boss' Night held by the National Secretaries Assn., and many charitable affairs, On several occassions, they taught at A' 'Day of Rounds'' in Ft, Lauderdale. To further round dancing they appeared in 1965 and 1966 at the Saddle Club in Hendersonville, N.C. They were MC'c for a portion of the Fri, evening program at Nationals. Heads swing and star thru,
Circle up four Head men break,
Two lines of four Pass thru,
Wheel and Deal
All face your partner, Star thru
Centers in, Cast off 3/4's
Just the ends star thru
The others square thru count four
you do
Spin chain thru with the outside two
Girls circulate double without a
stop
Spin the top, pass thru
Bend the line, star thru
Dive thru, pass thru, L.A. Etc.

#### WHEEL & WHAT No. 2

Heads square thru four hands you do Circle four, Head men break four in line
Go right and left thru, Same ladies chain
Pass thru, Wheel and Deal
Just the centers do a partners trade
Swing thru, All 8 circulate
Girls go double, Boys trade
Spin the top, Go right and left thru
All face your partner, Star thru
Bend the line, Slide thru
8 chain three, L.A. Etc.

#### SIMPLE HASH

Heads lead right, Circle to a line
Pass thru, Bend the line
The ends star thru, Pass thru
Seperate, around one, four in a line
Pass thru, Cast off 3/4's
Pass thru, Ends fold, Swing thru
All 8 circulate, Boys trade,
All 8 circulate, Turn thru, L.A. Etc.

#### TRAVELER

Heads fan the top, Pass thru Star thru, Pass thru, Break the line Spin chain thru, Girls circulate Girls turn back, Couples circulate 28 Couples Hinge and Trade, Double pass thru Boomerang, Relay the top, Keep your cool Swing thru, Girls circulate Boys trade, Boys circulate Turn thru, L.A. Etc.

#### HEY THERE

Heads pass thru, Seperate around one Squeeze in, Line up four Pass thru, Ends cross fold Square thru four hands you do Ends run, Ends fold, Dixie Daisy (Partner) Centers out, Ends fold, Box the gnat Change hands, L.A. Etc.

#### JUST FUNNIN'

Head ladies chain, Turn 'em around Chain 'em back Dixie style Make a wave and rock it awhile Pass thru, Star thru, Slide thru Spin chain thru, Girls circulate Girls fold, Peel off, Bend the line Slide thru, L.A. Etc.

#### ROUND OFF EASY

Side two couples go right & left thru Same ladies chain across from you 1 & 3 half sashay, Lead out to the right Circle four, Ladies break Line up four Pass thru, Round off, Girls square

3/4's around, L.A. Etc.
