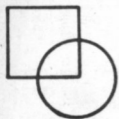
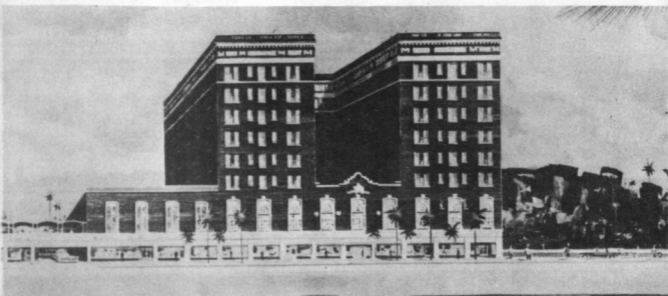

CHOREO COMMENTS

Tag the line is pretty standard today but one position I have seen tag the line called from is very poor. The ocean wave is really a poor position to call tag the line. Oh yes, the dancers can manage to do it but the two center dancers are not in a good position to pass right shoulders as they turn to face the center of the wave. Check it out for your self and see what you think.

EXPERIMENTAL BASIC

While calling at the Washington Cotillion in late Oct. I was exposed to the call **Swing Across** by Mack Parker from Va. I have experimented with several groups for two months now and I feel it is worth while giving a try, but not with limited basic groups or very in-experienced dancers.

Swing Across is based on swing thru and moves the end dancers in parallel ocean waves to the diagonal opposite end.

Teaching SWING ACROSS.

1. Ends will remain ends, centers will remain centers in the same wave.
2. The ocean waves are re-formed exactly in there original position, at the heads or at the sides.

Heads square thru four-do sa doe to a wave. (boys on end girls in the center). **Swing Across** can be directed to just the head men, just the side men or all four men as they are the ends of the wave.

Head men **Swing Across**--Head men turn the girl by the right until the two men meet diagonally across--the two men trade--meet the new girl and turn her by the right just far enough to reform the ocean wave with the men on the end.....Now side men **Swing Across**, and repeat the teaching. Repeat to zero out.....

The same rules hold true for the ocean waves with the girls on the end. After the basic idea is worked on have all four ends **Swing Across**. This to me is the best way to use the basic, however the dancers must be able to reform the new waves easily and a good hint along those lines is to tell the centers that they will remain in their exact starting position and as the ends work across the centers can catch left fore arms and "Firm up the Wave"....
