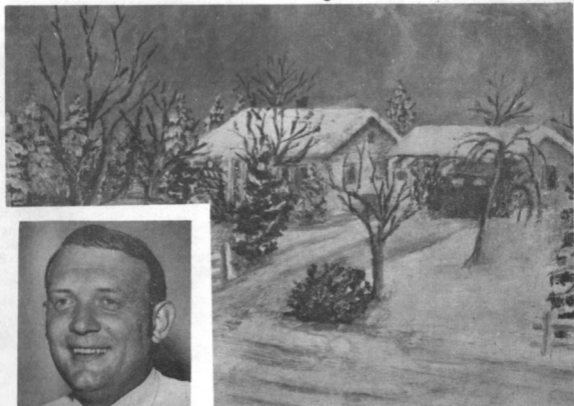

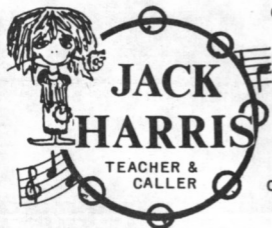

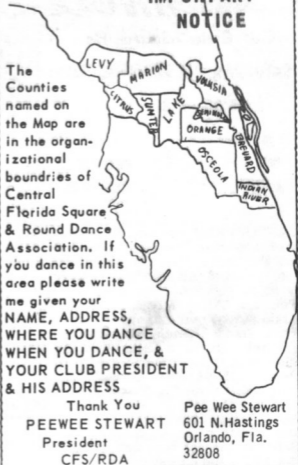

With this bit of food for thought, let us add a small suggestion for food for the table. Here's an easy, yet very decorative dessert for the holidays that can be made without the aid of the oven:

## SNOW BALLS

You will need Pound Cake; Whipping cream or the ready whip cream that can be found in the freezer section, plus grated coconut. If you are using regular whipping cream, add 1/2 teaspoon of plain gelatin after the cream has been whipped, this should be dissolved in a very little bit of water, this will give the cream body to stand up and stay firm.

Put your pound cake into cubes, about 1-1/2", cover with whipping cream and shaping into a ball, sprinkle generously with coconut and presto, you have a cool, tempting dessert with very little time and effort. These can be prepared ahead, placed into your freezer and used as needed. If you wish to add a little color, trim the top with two spearmint leaves and maraschino cherry.

## THE CALLER'S CORNER

### EXPERIMENTAL IDEAS

With Square Dance Week as the kick off to the fall season of classes and club dancing I would like to make a few comments about the lesson series we call beginner classes. So often we are scheduled to teach so many new figures each night in order to cover the necessary figures in a pre-determined number of weeks. In our haste to teach alot of basics but not really well so at the end of class the dancer knows a little about alot but cannot react to the calls well enough to be an acceptable member of the club....So with all there is to learn in todays dance why not slow down and set your goals at teaching people HOW TO DANCE not just teaching 75 basics,.....

Did you note the complete list of calls by S.I.O. include tag the line, peel off, pass to the center and trade by. The basic 75 actually is a very fine program for beginners If you cover the 75 thoroughly during class the foundation of our dancers will greatly improve. You have lots of room to make some challenging dancing based upon this limited number of calls. They should dance these figures inside and out before attempting the experimental material,.....

#### Experimental Idea : Tag The Top

Tag the top is easier to dance than taggers delight so give it a try. From parrallel lines start with a 3/4 tag the line, leaving the lead two facing out and the trailing dancers in an ocean wave in the center, the center dancers in the wave do a normal spin the top while the end or lead dancers face in and turn by the right 1/2 ending in an eight hand wave or two waves end to end which ever way you wish to use it.....

I teach it in two parts; Part one move to the 3/4 tag position - Part two centers spin the top ends face in and turn 1/2.....

I place the figure in the experimental but dancable and very worth while teaching to your experienced dance clubs but stay away from the basic groups as it will be too much.....

#### Dancing Tag The Top

1P-2P - Pass thru - tag the top (3/4 tag centers spin the top ends face & turn right 1/2 ) Balance  
Girls trade - balance back - barge thru - left alle. sdbox 1-4

1P-2P - Pass thru - tag the top - balance - swing thru - boys run - bend the line- right & left thru -  
dive thru - pass thru - left alle. sdbox 1-4

Heads star thru - pass thru - circle to a line - pass thru - tag the top - grand swing thru  
boys run - bend the line - dive thru - Square thru 3/4 - left alle. box 1-4

\*\*\*\*\*

A note of caution: After a completed tag the top give the dancers a chance to recognize their position as an eight hand wave or two regular waves end to end for follow up calls such as swing thrus or spin the tops...
