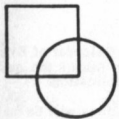
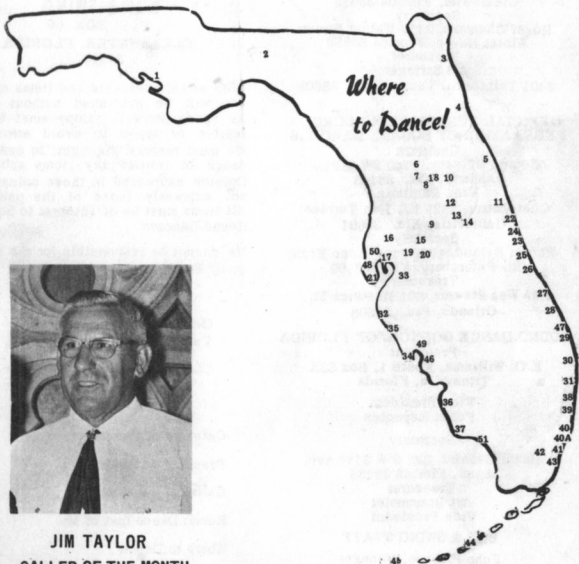

Jim and his wife were introduced to square dancing quite by accident. One night in the summer of 1956 they were driving thru Cape Cod, Mass. and stopped to watch an outdoor square dance. Ann was quite impressed, and persuaded Jim to take her to a class, that started things off.

About a year later some friends suggested that Jim should take up calling, that the area needed one, so Jim enrolled in Charlie Baldwin's Callers class. Traveling 60 miles to Boston for ten weeks to learn the basics of calling. (From the Master himself) Soon Jim was teaching and calling all thru the 6 New England States. Then came the tours that was to change their home. After a few tours down the east coast and Florida, Jim and Ann decided they would like to live here. So in Jan. 1965 the Taylors Jim, Ann and three of their five daughters moved to St. Petersburg. Jim is now kept pretty busy calling thru out Florida and Georgia evenings and weekends, and thru the week works as a Sheet Metal Worker. Jim is a former member of Narragansett Callers Assoc. of Rhode Island, Past President of Old Colony Callers & Teachers Assoc. Past Pres. of Sun Coast Callers Callers Assoc.

Jim served on the comm. to standardize teaching methods in Southeastern Mass. and has conducted clinics on calling and teaching. Jim was the first caller booked for the E.D.S.A.-R.D.A. conv. (now known as the New England Festival) and called for the next 6 festivals that now register 5000 dancers. Jim and Ann still

THE

JACK LASRY

CALLER'S CORNER

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY

The addition of $\frac{1}{4}$ more to the basic calls has caused some confusion among both dancers and callers. I thought I would take the time to review the thinking on $\frac{1}{4}$ mores and pass along a few examples for you to try.

WHEEL & DEEL & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE--Wheel & Deel is a couple movement. The $\frac{1}{4}$ more is then continuation of the wheeling motion bringing the couple thru the wheel & deel and flowing out to form a line of four facing out. The figure actually carries you thru $\frac{3}{4}$ of the wheel & deel circle.....

Examples, 1P-2P line-pass thru-**WHEEL & DEEL $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE** - Calif Twirl cross trail-left alle.

1P-2P line-Pass thr **WHEEL & DEEL $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-cast off $\frac{3}{4}$ pass trail-left alle.

1P-2P line-Pass thru **WHEEL & DEEL $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-boys run right swing thru-swing thru-boys run right - left alle. 1P-2P.

Box 1-4-Swing thru-boys run-**WHEEL & DEEL $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE** boys run right-cast off $\frac{3}{4}$ -swing thru boys run-bend the line star thru-dive thru-square thru $\frac{3}{4}$ -left alle. Zero

PARTNER TRADE & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE--Partner trade is a individual movement has the $\frac{1}{4}$ more tacked on to the individual turning motion, bringing the couple into a face to face position.....

Examples; Heads pass thru-**PARTNER TRADE $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-box the gnat square thru $\frac{3}{4}$ left alle.

Box 1-4 Star thru-pass thru-**PARTNER TRADE & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE** Box the gnat-right & left thru-left alle. Zero

1P-2P-Pass thru-wheel & deel-double pass thru-**PARTNER TRADE $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-star thru 1st couple left-2nd couple right- 1P-2P.

1P-2P line rollaway $\frac{1}{2}$ sashay pass thru-**PARTNER TRADE & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-square thru $\frac{3}{4}$ left alle.

PEEL OFF & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE--Peel off is pretty well accepted as a basic in club level dancing and if it has been taught properly and danced properly the $\frac{1}{4}$ more is easily accepted. Peel off is an individual movement thus the $\frac{1}{4}$ more is added on to your turning about motion bringing the set into a Double Pass Thru set up.

Examples; Four ladies chain-Heads lead right-circle to a line pass thru-wheel & deel-double pass thru-substitute **PEEL OFF & $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-centers-swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

1P-2P-Pass thru-wheel & deel double pass thru **PEEL OFF $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-centers square thru four others divide and star thru-swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

Box 1-4-swing thru-girls fold-**PEEL OFF $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE**-dixie style to an ocean wave-cast off $\frac{3}{4}$ girls run-slide thru-left alle. zero.

Box 1-4-circle to a two face line (swing thru-boys run) couples circulate-wheel & deel swing thru-boys trade-girls fold-**PEEL OFF $\frac{1}{4}$ MORE** Girls do sa doe to a wave-girls swing thru girls pass thru-star thru-boys trade wheel & deel-swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

RIGHT & LEFT THRU EQUIVALENTS

1P-2P---Centers box the gnat-square thru four ends slide thru-(all) star thru

1P-2P--Pass thru-tag the line-cloverleaf-double pass thru-leads U turn back-star thru.....

You of course can make use out of any right & left thru equivalents but from above two you can easily combine the two into a nice little dance.....For example: Establish the 1P-2P line, call the first figure. This of course equals a right and left thru, but leave the line out of sequence and call the second figure. The second right & left thru cancels out the first so you are back to the 1P-2P line and for a quick get out try STAR THRU-CALIF. TWIRL left alle. Also if at the end of the first figure you have lost a few squares you can easily pick them all up by crosstrailing to the corner and go from there.....

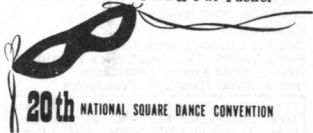

Re: CLARIFICATION ON EXEMPTIONS IF ANY TO (SQUARE DANCE CLASSES)
(SQUARE DANCE WORKSHOPS) (SQUARE DANCES WHERE A WORKSHOP IS
CONDUCTED AS PART OF THE DANCE) (AND DANCES WITH NO WORKSHOP)

This is in reply to request for a clarification of the application of the Florida Sales and Use Tax to "admissions to a square dance hall, whether for (Class) (Workshop) (Dance that is started with Workshop) or a (Dance no Workshop)

Also included information "about a benefit dance, or other Special Dance, where the profits are being donated to Charity.

Rule 318-1.05(6) is of long standing and provides that "Dues paid by persons for membership in clubs such as sewing clubs, bowling clubs, square dancing clubs, bridge clubs and gun clubs, which provide no recreational or other facilities for its members, are exempt." Any charge made by any such club for admission to any event conducted or sponsored by the club is taxable." (Emphasis supplied)

Rule 318-1.05(4) provides that, "Admissions requiring a so-called (service charge or donation) in excess of 9 cents are taxable.

Under the above cited rules, dues charged by square dance clubs to cover the cost of getting out notices of club activities and the like but which (Do Not) entitle the member to any dances, or other recreation are not subject to the tax. Any charge made by the club for admission to any event conducted or sponsored by it is subject to the tax. Such admissions are taxable even though the net proceeds are donated to charity. However, inasmuch as the tax is required to be added to the admission charge and passed on to the patron, it does not come out of the portion donated to charity.

Charges made for class instruction or workshops where the primary purpose is to teach dancing or to deal with problems peculiar to square dancing are (not subject to the tax). However, exemptions must be strictly construed and where there is a combination of a taxable event and an exempt event, (the entire event is subject to the tax. Thus, where there is a dance that is started with a workshop, the (CHARGE OR DONATION) made is construed to be a taxable admission.

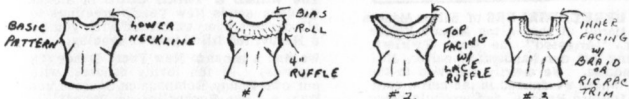
ODDS AND ENDS

BY EMILY LEACH

SLEEVELESS FITTED BLOUSE PATTERN

MATERIAL NEEDED: 1-1/2 yds Material: 18" Zipper: Trim desired:
Simplicity Dress Pattern #4842

Tired of blouses riding up, or looking for a new style. Try this method of fitted blouse, with back zipper closure.



Out dress pattern about 5" below waist line, flaring out at bottom for hip fullness. There are waist darts at front & back and bust darts for a nice, neat fit. Cut neckline lower and slightly out to the width and depth desired. Sew up blouse, zipper, sleeve facing, etc. then you can concentrate on collar trim.

#1. Cut two strips about 4½" wide for ruffle and hem before ruffling. On the bias, cut one strip, or piece together about 36" for collar binding. Baste ruffle to neckline, sew on bias strip and turn in, rolling under, so that only about 1/4" roll will show on the outside. I usually pin this down to get a smooth, even roll, then hand stitch carefully. If bias is too wide, this can be snipped off before rolling. You may have a much simpler way of doing this, but since I'm a self-taught seamstress I may be doing it the hard way.

#2. For a flat outer facing, cut a paper pattern around the neckline you fashioned for your blouse about 3" wide, cut either one piece, or one front panel & two back and piece together. Sew top to neckline, steam press bottom to get that nice rounded edge. Baste lace ruffle and facing to blouse, press before machine stitching.

#3. Cut paper pattern for your square neck line, making sure that it is not cut too low, or too wide at the neck. Pin this to your blouse pattern, fitting it to the shoulders. This will also need a facing, that can be cut from this paper pattern. After completing the blouse, add ric-rac, braid or lace trim for finishing touch.

LOW-CALORIE FEATHER PANCAKES

3 Eggs - Separated
3/4 cup Cottage Cheese (Sieved)
1/4 tsp. Salt

1/4 cup Flour
1/4 cup Milk

Add egg yolks to sieved cottage cheese, salt, flour and milk. Beat until very smooth. Beat egg whites until stiff, but not dry. Fold into batter and fry. Try this unusual batter for breakfast some morning, I'm sure you'll find them very enjoyable.
