

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY

The Tag The Line family keeps growing and with it the many possible uses increases. It is very difficult to commit to memory every possible use of this broad basic. This month I thought we would try to pass along some of Tag The Line set ups and zeros with the hope that it will help a little toward a better understanding of this very good but versatile fugire.....

Set up----1 P-2 P (heads lead right-circle to a line)

- Pass thru-Tag The Line-centers in cast-off ¾ box the gnat-right & left thru.---1P-2P.
- 2. Pass thru-Tag The Line-in-box the gnat right & left thru.---1P-2P.
- 3. Pass thru-Tag The Line-Right-wheel & deel sging thru-girls Run-star thru-calif, twirl-
- 4. slide thru, 1P-2P.
 - Pass thru-Tag The Line Left-couples circulate-wheel & deel-swing thru-Boys Run-right & left thru, 1P-2P.
- 5. Pass thru-Tag The Line Out-Calif. twirl. 1P-2P.
- :6. Pass thru-Tag The Line Zig Zag-boys run right-.1P-2P.
- 7. Pass thru-Tag The Line Right (or left)-bend the line. Arky line is seg. (left square thru-arky alle.)

Set up----Any Eight Chain Thru Alignment. The following are Zero movements, bringing you back to the same spot or an equivelant.

- 1. Swing thru-boys run-Tag The Line-cloverleaf-two ladies chain (turn the girl) right & left thru-bardge thru.....
- 2. Swing thru-boys run-couples circulate-Tag The Line-cloverleaf (on a double track) dixie style to an ocean wave-boys trade-boys run-wheel & deel-pass thru-U turn back...

This month I would like to pass along some easy to use zeros built around Swing Thru-Spin

The Top or a combination of the two.....

- 1. Swing thru-boys run-wheel & deel.
- 2. Swing Thru-boys trade-boys run-bend the line right & left thru-star thru.
- 3. Swing thru-boys trade-cast off 3/4 girls run-star thru-calif. twirl.
- 4. Swing thru-cast off 3/4-girls run-box the gnat-right & left thru-two ladies chain-star thru.
- 5. Slide thru-Swing thru-boys run-wheel & deel-right & left thru-star thru.
- 6. Spin the Top-boys run-wheel & deel-star thru.
- 7. Spin The Top-boys run-girls trade-bend the line-right & left thru.
- 8. Spin The Top-cast off 3/girls run-Swing Thru.
- 9. Slide thru-Spin The Top-boys run-wheel & deel.
- 10. Swing thru-Spin the Top-cast off 3/4 boys run right.
- 11. Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay Swing Thru-girls run-wheel & deel-box the gnat.
- 12. Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay-Swing Thru-girls trade.....
- 13. Swing thru-boys trade-Spin The Top-Swing Thru-boys run-bend the line....

Pick on one or two to use in and out of your dances and they will add a little variety to your program. You of course cannot put all to use in one evening but keep changing around and it will help you to keep the dancers alert and not fall into the routine of the dance and anticipate your next call.....

Going to a pet-luck and want to bring something different? Here are a two of the recipes that I've picked thru the years that always seemed to please everyone.

YUM YUM CAKE

1/4 lb. butter 1 cup white sugar 2 eggs Cream butter & sugar, add eggs one at a time, beating after each one.

2 cups all-purpose flour 1 tsp. baking powder 1/2 tsp. salt Sift flour, salt & baking powder three times.

l tsp. baking soda l cup sour cream Add baking soda to sour cream.

l tsp. vanilla

Add sifted flour and sour cream mixture to the creamed butter alternately, beating after each addition. Add vanilla.

Grease and flour spring form pan. Divide batter and filling into three equal portions. Alternate when filling pan, starting with the batter and ending with filling for the topping.

Topping & Filling: Blend 1/3 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup white sugar; 1 tsp. cinnamon; 3/4 cup chopped pecans; 2 tspns melted butter.

Bake at 350° from 40 to 45 minutes

How about a batch of small cream puffs, they really make a big hit and are easy to make.

FILLING:

Prepare your filling ahead of time, so that it will cool properly and be ready for use. I use the prepared vanilla pudding mix, using only 1-1/2 cups of milk for each small package. This makes a firmer and less watery mixture. Cover with saran wrap directly on top of filling so that it will not form a crust. Two pkgs. of pudding will be sufficient. PUFFS:

1/2 cup shortening 1/8 tsp. salt 1 cup boiling water

1 cup sifted flour 3 eggs - unbeaten

Add shortening and salt to boiling water and stir over medium heat until it boils. Lower heat and add flour stirring rigorously after each addition, until it leaves the side of the pan. Remove from heat and add one egg at a time, beating after each. Shape on ungreased pan using about one teaspoon for each puff. Bake in hot oven 450° for 20 minutes, reduce heat to 350° and bake about 15 to 20 minutes longer. Remove and place on cooling rack.

When puffs are cooled, split in half sideways, fill with pudding mixture, replace tops. Sprinkle all with powdered sugar. This averages about 30 to 36 small puffs.
