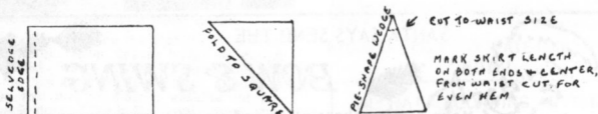
ODDS AND ENDS

BY EMILY LEACH

REVERSIBLE SKIRT

Have you ever considered the idea of making a skirt that will give you a variety at a minimum cost? I saw one the other day and realized the many ways it could be utilized and how it could cut down on your wardrobe, especially when travelling. One skirt and two blouses can give you four separate costumes. The skirt should be a figured material and color matching solid for the other side. The blouses should be also be made of the matching materials. This then would give you a set of four costumes that can be alternated by wearing the solid blouse with the figured skirt or vice versa, or as matching skirt and blouse. The skirt I saw was made in the circular style and was very effective. You will need four yards for each skirt, and about 1-1/2 to 2 yards for each blouse, depending on the style or pattern of the blouse you choose. Just think how much of a variety you can have and how little space it would take when packing for a short week-end or even for a long trip.

The instructions I was given for a circular skirt pattern were as follows: Cut the four yards of material into two pieces, then sew along the selvedge edge and fold to make a square. Make a pattern of a circle to your waist measurements, fold material into a pie-shaped wedge, mark waist and cut. Then measure from the waist down along the selvedge to the length of the skirt you will need mark length for hem and cut. You will need to do this with both pieces of material. Seam up sides on both pieces leaving enough opening for zipper, pin the two skirts together, reverse side out, sew the two hems together and press on reverse to smooth out the stitching. Turn skirt to right side out and press out hem, pinning or basting material from hem to waist in several places so that it will save you time and trouble when you attach the belt. Sew on belt, and presto, you have two skirts in one. If you are unsure of yourself on how to cut out a circular skirt, try cutting out a paper pattern (it can be small) just to give you an idea as to how it should be done. It took several pieces of paper for me to work it out, but it worked marvels and may save you time, aggravation and material.

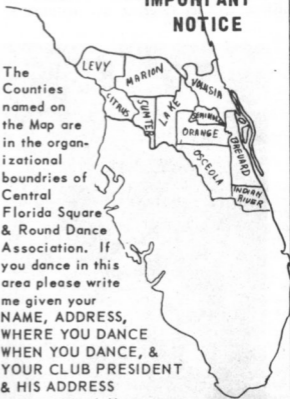

EXPERIMENTAL IDEAS

Tripple Scoot - Idea by Manny Amor and Frannie Heintz.

From two parrallel single file columns facing in opposite directions the dancers facing each other on the diagonal turn thru and return to their partners position. (three pairs of turn thrus)

The two lone dancers facing out on the end of the column run into the partners vacated position...

Tripple scoot has been called grand scoot back but to my knowledge never published as such, the title Tripple Scoot is really very good and the figure dances nicely If you are using scoot back then give this one a good look.

DANCING TRIPPLE SCOOT

Examples by Frannie and Manny

1P-2P Do sa doe to a wave
Cast off 3/4 - Tripple Scoot
Cast off 3/4 - right & left thru
Crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Curlique - Tripple Scoot
Cast off 3/4
Spin the top - swing thru
Turn thru - left alle.

Heads square thru four
Pass thru - boys run right
Tripple Scoot - boys run
Right & left thru - dive thru
Substitute - square thru 3/4 - left alle.

1P-2P Curlique - Tripple Scoot
Cast off 3/4 - spin the top
Boys trade - slide thru - left alle.
