

Gordon was born in Louisville, Ky., raised in Valdosta, Ga. and moved to Lake Worth, Fla. when he was 17 yrs. old. After active duty in 2nd. World War, he decided to settle in South Florida.

Gordon started calling while a student at the University of Miami 22 yrs. ago. He was the first active caller in the Dade County area and taught his first classes at the Y.W. C.A., recreation centers, homes and churches. He and his wife, Edna, formed their first club, the Hurricane Squares 19 yrs. ago this Dec. and the club is still going strong. CHERRY CREAM FREEZE

drained

2½ cups canned cherry pie filling 1/4 t
2 cups whipped topping

1/4 tbsp. almond extract

Combine first 5 ingredients in a large bowl, mix well. Gently fold in whipped topping. Turn mixture into a 9 % 9 mpan. Cover tightly with foil and freeze for 24 hours. May be taken out of refrigerator to soften just before serving with whipped topping. This will keep for several days.

GOOD EXPERIMENTAL BASIC

Scoot Chain Thru---Vince DiCando, Ohio...will come as a welcome addition to the scoot back family. If you use scoot back (if not you really should, with two years plus dancers) you may have already said to yourself "I think the dancers are getting tired of scoot back". Teaching Scoot Chain Thru

From two parralel ocean waves the dancers facing out do exactly the same movement as in scoot back, that being a run into the vacated position of those stepping into the center. The dancers facing in, step into the center - Swing Thru - then turn thru - reform the right hand wave with the outside two. In teaching, have the facing dancers establish the wave in the center of the of the set then swing thru - turn thru. Also direct the swing thru - turn thru with good clear direction and at the end of the turn thru say "step straight ahead - reform the right hand wave". It Helps

Note From left hand ocean waves the facing in dancers do a left swing thru - left turn thru and the facing out dancers run left into the vacated position......

The timing is not the same for each set of dancers. The facing out folks have to wait a couple of beats for the action in the center to be completed. This really does not detract from the figure as the outsides are really guide posts for the center dancers to move forward toward...
