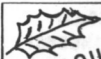

They also formed and call for regularly the Seminole Squares (14 yrs.), the Dixie Rebels (12 yrs.) and have a weekly Club Level Workshop and an Advanced Workshop plus 2 Beginner Classes a year, each running 30 weeks. Once a month for the past 13 years Gordon donates his calling and hall; and, many club dancers and the S.W. Lions Club Members donate their help in a special club dance for the "Guided Missiles" ---an all Blind group. For years they called for the Teen Squares and taught round dancing for Cross Trail Rounders.

All of the Square Dancing - 5 to 6 nights a week - takes place at their Cross Trail Square Dance Center, 4150 S.W. 70th Ct., Miami (see ad). Visitors are always welcome. Right at Cross Trail they operate a small western shop carrying all the items enjoyed by Square and Round dancers.

Gordon was: First President of the S.E. Fla. Assoc., Past President of the Fla. State Callers Assoc. --organizer of the Fla. Short Course at the Univ. of Fla. bringing in callers and Square and Round Dancers from all over the country -- Director of many Square Dance Weekends with out-of-town callers and conducted several Square Dance Cruises. Director of the Blue Ridge Sq. Dance Camp (11 yrs.) ...Participant in many workshops and clinics and calling for State and National Conventions...Choreographer of over 200 dances, many of them written up in square dance magazines and in the Sets-In-Order yearbooks, and with some figures as his

## ADD A NEW LIFE TO AN OLD PETTICOAT

Gladys Fisher of Paisley, Fla., sent in this suggestion to rejuvenate a saggy, droopy petticoat that is still too good to discard: "Remember those petticoats that "get sick" so soon? Here's the answer: Get some 30 lb. test nylon fishing line. With a darning needle run the fish line inside or, base in and out along the bottom hem, all the way around. Do this also with the next seam closest to the bottom hem of the skirt as possible, but not in the same place. This does take a lot of line and will absorb a little time, but is worth it in the long run. Don't use anything but a 30 lb. test line. This can be machine washed, but not machine dried or ironed, just hang on line and let it drip dry. You will then have a new petticoat. This is one thing that really does work. Good luck, Ladies."

## CHERRY CREAM FREEZE

Just ran into a recipe that sounded "delish", so I thought I'd pass it on to you:

1 can sweetened condensed milk	1 can (9oz.) crushed pineapple
1/4 cup lemon juice	drained
2 1/2 cups canned cherry pie filling	1/4 tsp. almond extract
2 cups whipped topping	

Combine first 5 ingredients in a large bowl, mix well. Gently fold in whipped topping. Turn mixture into a 9"x9" pan. Cover tightly with foil and freeze for 24 hours. May be taken out of refrigerator to soften just before serving with whipped topping. This will keep for several days.

## THE CALLER'S CORNER

### GOOD EXPERIMENTAL BASIC

**Scout Chain Thru**---Vince DiCando, Ohio...will come as a welcome addition to the scout back family. If you use scout back (if not you really should, with two years plus dancers) you may have already said to yourself "I think the dancers are getting tired of scout back".

#### Teaching Scout Chain Thru

From two parallel ocean waves the dancers facing out do exactly the same movement as in scout back, that being a run into the vacated position of those stepping into the center. The dancers facing in, step into the center - Swing Thru - then turn thru - reform the right hand wave with the outside two. In teaching, have the facing dancers establish the wave in the center of the set then swing thru - turn thru. Also direct the swing thru - turn thru with good clear direction and at the end of the turn thru say "step straight ahead - reform the right hand wave". It Helps.....

Note From left hand ocean waves the facing in dancers do a left swing thru - left turn thru and the facing out dancers run left into the vacated position.....

The timing is not the same for each set of dancers. The facing out folks have to wait a couple of beats for the action in the center to be completed. This really does not detract from the figure as the outsides are really guide posts for the center dancers to move forward toward...
