during her winter residence there. For the past five years with his band, he has entertained Ambassadors and Diplomats from all over the world (26 nations represented on one occasion), movie stars and celebrities in entertainment and society, Royalty and many other Dignitaries from all over the world. Incidentally, Mrs. Post's favorite square dances are: Fast and Slow and the Grand Square - her favorite Round Dance is the Varsouvianna.

A travel consultant during the day, Jay still maintains a busy evening schedule, as guest caller for area clubs, and presenting square dance parties in hotels and condominiums throughout the area. Through this medium and his teaching over the years, he has helped to bring many people the enjoyment of a very wonderful past-time - square and round dancing.

It all began in the fall of 1948 and "Mike" Fenimore at the family reunion in Shipbottom, New Jersey, Uncle Steve had brought along a record player and some of the currently popular dances including: Spanish Cavalero, Solomon Levi, Life on the Ocean and the Grand Square. The Rounds of the time were: Rye Waltz, Glow Worm, Electronic Schottische and the Varsouvianna.

Having been exposed to square dancing earlier in California and realizing the fun and enjoyment this could bring friends and neighbors Jay soon developed one of South Jersey's very first clubs, the Jaywalkers, in his town Vine-land, N.J. For material, he borrowed Uncle Steve's records, copied them on a wire recorder (before the days of tape) and began teaching in an old paint shop which had a pot-belly stove for heat. A short time there after, one of the club members, being a radio technician, brought over a P.A. system with microphone and after some persuasion, Jay took the mike in hand, bought some instrumental only 78's - and was on his way.

Moving to Florida in 1953, it didnot take long before the Fenimores were again teaching and developing square & round dance clubs.

Jay became interested in the work of the Fla. Callers Association and after serving in each official capacity along the line, became president in 1962, the year of the National Convention in Miami Beach. He had previously served in range of officers of the Southeast Fla. Callers Assn. Jay served as co-chairman of the 1961 State Convention along with being program chairman for the National Convention of 1962, he served on the executive committee and again on the programming of some 150 callers for the Convention.

Having a vast knowledge of the older "Easter Style" dancing, Jay was engaged by Mrs. Marjorie Merriwether Post to call for her weekly square dances at the Post Estate in Palm Beach.

(13) TWINKLE (to Bjo); (14) FWD, 2, CHECK; (15) Bjo PIVOT (to SCP); (16) THRU, SIDE, CLOSE (to Bfly);

- 13-15 Repeat the action of Meas 5 thru 7;

- 16 Both step thru, swd LOD, close to end in momentary Butterfly pos with M fc wall;

(17) (to Open) WALTZ AWAY; (18) (Canter) FWD, -, CLOSE (W wrap); (19) FWD WALTZ;

(20) FWD, POINT, -;

- 17 Turn to Open pos and waltz fwd LOD & slightly away from partner L, R, L;
 18 M canter fwd on R, -, close L (W wraps L-fc L, R, L into M's R arm assuming skirt skaters pos); (Note: Both M & W now have same footwork.)
 ("Skirt Skaters": L hands joined at shoulder height, M's R arm around W at waist and W's right hand holding skirt.)

- 19 (Identical footwork) Both waltz fwd LOD R, L, R;

- 20 Both step fwd LOD on L, point R diag twd LOD & wall, -;

(21) (Skaters) TWINKLE LOD; (22) TWINKLE RLOD; (23) CHECK, BACK, SIDE; (24) FWD, LOCK, FWD;

- 21 In Skirt Skaters pos facing diag LOD & wall both twinkle XIF R, L, R ending facing diag RLOD & wall;

- 22 Diag RLOD & wall both twinkle XIF L, R, L turning to face diag LOD & wall;

- 23 Diag LOD & wall both check fwd motion on R, step back L, swd R twd wall;

- 24 Diag LOD & wall both fwd L, Lock R behind L, fwd L;

(25) (Canter) FWD, -, CLOSE (W Roll); (26) THRU, SIDE, CLOSE; (27) (CP-Scar) TWIST - VINE; (28) MANUV;

THE CALLER'S CORNER

SWEEP A QUARTER This month we will take a look at Sweep A Quarter. This little figure by Jerry Helt is well accepted by most callers and yet as a basic it cannot stand alone. By that I mean it depends on the preceding call to start the flow motion in a given direction and the call must end in a facing couples position for the No Hands Circle (usually left) one quarter. The value lies in its ability to change the formation from lines to eight chain thru set ups or from eight chain thru set ups into lines. The most common figures used to set up Sweep 1/4 is a flutter wheel and the two face line wheel & deal. The body motion is to the left so the sweep is to the left continuing the flow. You can set up the flow to the right however I suggest you do so only with experienced dancers who have a good basics foundation. As already indicated Sweep 1/4 cannot stand alone so the zeros I list will be based around simple flow combinations. Don't get me wrong when I say sweep cannot stand alone you could say to any facing couples standing still to sweep 1/4 and you may get across but not smoothly.

SWEEP A QUARTER

From any facing couples

1. Flutter wheel - Sweep A Quarter - slide thru - zero
2. Flutter wheel - Sweep A Quarter - pass thru - equals a square thru
3. Right & left thru - flutter wheel - Sweep A Quarter - equals a star thru
4. Right & left thru - flutter wheel - Sweep A Quarter - slide thru - equals a right & left thru
5. Right & left thru - flutter wheel Sweep A Quarter - pass thru - equals a 1/2 square thru
6. Heads-Swing thru - wheel & deal - Sweep A Quarter - pass thru - equals a lead to the right

Extension of Sweep 1/4 - Sweep 1/4 to a Two Face Line

Circle to a two face line is one of the more generally accepted experimental ideas. Not really a basic it really is in the circle to a line family. Using the circle motion and moving into the two face line can be easily added to the Sweep 1/4 motion which one can easily see is a circle left motion and at the competed sweep position the dancer continues to flow into the two face line. I came up with the thought while calling and called it cold and the reaction was there. Now the group knows circle to a two face line and Sweep 1/4 so I had an edge in trying it but the dancers were right there and acted as if it was a call they had done before. Try it cold and see what your gang does.

EXAMPLES

1. 1P-2P Right & left thru - flutter wheel - Sweep 1/4 To A Two Face Line - wheel & deal - star thru - Zero back to 1P-2P line
2. Box 1-4 - Right & left thru - flutter wheel - Sweep 1/4 To A Two Face Line - wheel & deal - slide thru - Zero back to Box 1-4
3. Facing couple in normal position - swing thru - boys run - wheel & deal - Sweep 1/4 To A Two Face Line - bend the line - Equals a right & left thru

Dancing the Newer Figure

1P-2P to Box 1-4
Right & left thru - flutter wheel
Sweep 1/4 to a two face line
couples circulate - girls scoot back
boys circulate - bend the line
slide thru - left alle. box 1-4

Box 1-4 to 1P-2P
Curlique - swing thru
scoot back - scoot chain thru
boys run - bend the line - (1P-2P)
curlique - boys run - left alle.
