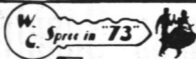

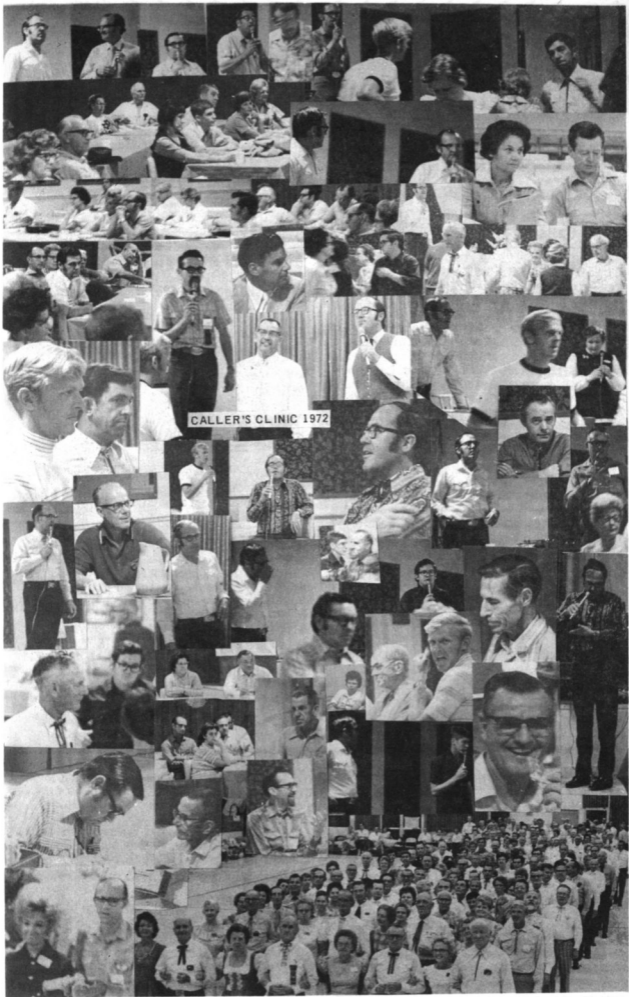

### THE

JACK LASRY

### CALLER'S CORNER

**DIAMOND CIRCULATE** - A cute extension of the standard circulate similar to a Box circulate but due to the formation looking like the shape of a diamond called Diamond Circulate.

To Set Up the desired position the easiest is as follows...Box 1-4-Swing thru - boys run - cast off 3/4 - at this point you have formed two 'Diamonds' on each half of the of the set. The Diamond Circulate means that in each diamond the dancers will move forward and take the position of the dancer in front of them, but of course remaining in their own diamond. It would be easy to see each diamond as a star at first have each dancer put their right hand in the star and turn the star 1/4. The star usage would be only as a teaching guide...You can of course diamond circulate one position or two or three...The part that seems nice is the basic set up lends itself to standard movements to use before and after.

#### Dancing Diamond Circulate

Box 1-4-Swing thru-boys run-girls cast off 3/4 (girls turn 3/4)  
Diamond Circulate-boys turn right 3/4  
Tag the line right-wheel & deal  
Dive thru-square thru 3/4  
Left alle. box 1-4

#### DIAMOND CHAIN THRU - Deuce Williams

This idea was actually called directionally in our Diamond Circulate exploration. The thought of moving directly thru a diamond circulate into the wave action is quite danceable.

The Set Up from a diamond circulate position, do a diamond circulate and the wave formed thru the middle has the center dancers trade and cast off 3/4 with the ends. Ending by reforming the wave or two face line with the inactive ends...

If you have used Diamond Circulate enough so that the dancers are sure of the movement then this one is worth a try...

#### Dancing Diamond Chain Thru

Swing thru-boys run-girls cast off 3/4  
Diamond chain thru-tag the line right  
Bend the line-cross-trail-left alle.

Swing thru-boys run-cast off 3/4  
Diamond chain thru-girls circulate once  
Couple circulate-bend the line  
Box the gnat-barge thru-left alle.

Swing thru-boys run-girls cast off 3/4  
Diamond chain thru-girls circulate once  
Tag the line right-wheel & deal  
Star thru-cross-trail-left alle.

Swing thru-boys run-tag the line right  
Boys cast off 3/4-Diamond chain thru  
Bend the line-right & left thru  
Barge thru-pass thru-left alle.

Swing thru-boys run-tag the line right  
Boys cast off 3/4-Diamond chain thru  
Boys circulate once-bend the line  
Right & left thru-barge thru-left alle.

Do sa doe to a wave-scoot back-boys trade  
Boys run-tag the line-boys cast off 3/4  
Diamond chain thru-boys circulate double  
Bend the line
