Our hearts were saddened to learn of the death of one of most active, long time square dancers, Paul Lane, on November 19, 1971 who passed away in the intensive care unit after undergoing surgery. He and his wife were suppose to be up front at the NEFSDA Round-Up Grand March, but because of surgery he could not attend.

Paul and Mary were past presidents of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, The Northeast Florida Square Dance Association, permanent delegates to the Fla. Federation, members of Friendly Frolics and Challengers square dance clubs.

They started their interest in square dancing back in the '50's and not only watched the number of dancers grow but promoted it all the time. Paul's passing is a great loss and he leaves behind many friends that will miss him dearly. To Mary, all of us join in offering our condolences and our thoughts and prayers will be with you. Chairman of Fla. Federation of Sq. Dancers

I am honored to have been elected by your delegates to the position of Chairman of the Board of Delegates of the Florida Federation of Sq. Dancers. We will do our best to live up to the confidence placed in us.

A number of years ago the chairman had a column in the Bow & Swing and with the co-operation of the present editor Jack Pierson I would like to revive that column.

Let's talk a bit about the Federation. It is made up of four delegates from the four Associations; South east, West Coast and North East. The primary function is to tie the Four Associations together and try to promote Sq. Dancing statewide. It was formed so that Fla. could host the National Convention in 1961-

FRANK AND IRIS GILBERT

Frank and Iris Gilbert started square dancing in the greater Kansas City area in 1951 and round dancing a short time later. Their experience in ballroom dancing swayed them to start teaching round dancing in 1957. Every year since then they have conducted at least one beginners class. They have conducted for many years easy level, intermediate and advanced round dance groups and have studied extensively ballroom international basics which they have applied to dances for their advanced group.

The Gilberts have served on the staffs of many dance camps, state and area festivals and week-end fun fests and have taught at four national square dance conventions. They served as president of the Heart of America Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs and as chairman and secretary for several years of the Mid-America Round Dance Teachers Association.

"Love Ya", "Canadian Sunset", "So Long Baby", "Twilight Time", "Sweet and Hot", "Sombbrero", and "Heart Beats" are dances they have written, with "Heart Beats" being listed in the top ten for eight months.

The Gilberts moved to Largo, Fla. from Kansas City, Missouri, in April of 1971 and were encouraged by Ed and Kay Mack to get into teaching here in Florida. They joined the Round Dance Council of Florida in Sept. 1971, and are presently teaching and enjoying an advance group with the Macks on Monday night and also a beginners group. They conduct an intermediate and advanced group at Sun City Center.

The teaching of Square Dancing is Johnny's first love. To introduce people to a hobby that becomes a way of life, opening a door to friendship that might not have been, to watch a person that has never moved to music before blossom forth, who needs a better reason than this for becoming a Square Dance Caller and Teacher.

Incidentally, you can call it a forecast of the future, or what you will, but Johnny's first date with Louise, was a square dance.



JOHNNY WALTER

Johnny was born and raised in Waukegan, Illinois, was employed as a draftsman for the Johnson Motors the year he enrolled at Arthur Murrys School of Dance. He and Louise met while both were students, and were married in the spring of 1954. They moved to the Florida Keys that same year where Johnny owned and operated an Outboard Sales and Service Shop. In 1959 the shop was sold and Johnny attended the Miami Barber College. After serving his apprenticeship, he operated his own Shop in Marathon until 1970.

In 1964, with much persuasion from two of his customers, Johnny and Louise attended the first Square Dance Class to be held in Marathon, after graduation, became Charter members of the newly formed Key Hoppers, a Square Dance Club dancing to records.

With a growing interest in Square Dancing on the Keys, Johnny taught his first Class in the Fall of 1965 and was conducting the Wednesday night workshops for the club. With a background of teaching classes for the Marathon Power Squadron, and substitute teaching at the High School, Johnny found great pleasure and gratification in the teaching of Square Dancing. The ability to convey this knowledge to others, was a deciding factor in his decision to sell the Barber Shop, and concentrate on Calling on a full time basis.

His association with the Miami Spring Swingers, brought him to the Miami area in Oct. '70. Calling for the club on Monday nights and teaching a class on Tuesdays for the club, Johnny and Louise realizes the distance traveled from the Keys each week was proving a hardship, so in March of the same year, when he became the Club Caller for the Dixie Twirlers, they located their travel trailer in a park on the Trail and divided their time between the Keys and Miami.

With ever growing popularity, guest dates take Johnny to both the East and West coast and North to Jacksonville. Tours out of the state have taken them west to Nebraska, north to Illinois, and southeast to North Carolina. He teaches one class a year and runs an intermediate and advanced workshop, combines camping and calling with the Weekend Warriors, is on the staff at the Infantinos Round-dez-Vous Lodge in North Carolina and secretary for the Florida Callers Association.

ODDS & ENDS

HELPFUL HINTS

When hemming a skirt, instead of pinning or basting, why not try this method: Use hair clips or bobby pins. Measure the hem and slide on the clip or the bobby pin and then as you machine stitch or hand sew slip them off as you go along. No pin marks or pricked fingers.

Try this on your steam iron: Add a few drops of cologne to your water for your iron and your drawers and closets will have a pleasant fragrance that your clothes will leave. Also, if you use ordinary tap water, try using one tablespoon of ammonia to one cup of water. This will keep your iron from clogging and help keep the lime deposit down.

To take the shine out of trousers or dresses: Try dampening a press cloth with a solution of 1/4 cup of vinegar to one cup water. Wring out cloth dry and use to press. Then brush with a nice stiff brush or sandpaper.

When using ric-rac for trim try this simple method of shrinking before sewing. Leave the ric-rac on the card and immerse it in hot water, dry thoroughly with a towel before unwinding. This can be sewed on either damp or dry. Also, when you're attaching it to your dress use cellophane tape to anchor it instead of pins, then you can sew right thru the tape and pull it off when you're done. No pins to contend with or worry about getting it on straight.

To perk up the lace around a dress or blouse, just brush on a little starch with a toothpick while ironing.

After fighting for many years to get the lint out of my husband's shirt pockets, I found this method to be most useful. Just take a hand brush, turn pockets inside out and brush the lint away. If they still show dark, use a little soap or detergent.

Want to eliminate pin marks from wearing badges, try using a little piece of white felt under the spot and pin your badge thru material and felt. The added thickness of material will keep the pin marks from becoming so prominent.

Have you ever thought of using one of those plastic ice cube trays for an earring container? In this way each pair has it's own compartment and you can find them in a hurry. This is also a good method of keeping buttons sorted by sizes and colors.

Instead of buying a commercial eyeglass cleaner, why not try washing them with a little alcohol and wiping them off with a tissue. This cuts through the grease and film makes them clean and sparkling.

If you have a rug or mat that keeps slipping and sliding, try using one of the thin, filmy plastics from the cleaners underneath your mat. This will keep it from sliding as it anchors it pretty well and it may save you from having a fall.

If the grout around your tub is dingy with mildew put some household bleach into a plastic squirt bottle and squirt all around the grout. Let it set overnight and next morning it will be neat and clean again.

Did you know: That a dash of vinegar in the dish water will help fight detergent hands and keep them nice and soft?

That if you keep your nail polish in the refrigerator when not in use, it will go on much easier, stay better and can be used to the last drop?

JACK LASRY

THE CALLER'S CORNER

Flair the Star: This figure will be a winner at All levels of dancing and I encourage you to give a real good look. From facing couples Flair The Star works this way.

Teaching Flair The Star: Tell the boys they will end up across the set in the position of the boy in the opposite couple. The girls will end up right where they started. Make a right hand star, as the boys move to the opposite side of the set they break out of the star and make a Large Leftface Circle Turn To End Facing Back In. The girls keep their star turning until they get back to their starting position and the opposite boy will reach out and courtesy turn the girl. It will take the boys several tries to make a Large Left Face Circle Turn Ending Back Facing In as they have a feeling that they must make it a quick about face.

The figure equals two boys chain or a right & left thru - two ladies chain. The figure is an exact equivalent of flutter wheel. The courtesy turn on the end of Flair The Star lends itself to following with ladies chain or dixie style figures real nice. A really nice zero is Flair The Star followed by a flutter wheel. The reverse combination is also a zero but not nearly as smooth.

Dancing Flair The Star

Heads Flair The Star
sides Flair The Star:
four ladies chain - left alle. (besure you courtesy turn the girl)

Box 1-4 Star thru - Pass thru - partner trade
Flair The Star - flutter wheel
slide thru - left alle. zero

Box 1-4 - Star thru - pass thru - partner trade
Flair The Star - ladies lead dixie style to a wave
left alle.

Promonade - heads wheel around
pass thru - partner trade
Flair The Star - star thru

All Eight Flair The Star - A real nice figure that after calling Flair The Star a few time you can call "cold" and with a little direction the floor will react.

All eight make a right hand star - when the boys reach the opposite side of the set they "roll out" while the girls keep their star turning to reach their starting spot and are courtesy turned by the opposite boy.

Example

Four ladies chain - All Eight Flair The Star
(boys courtesy turn your own) left alle.

Although you cannot twist this figure into a million different positions it really has the potential to last a long time....
