





FAN THE TOP is one of the fringe basics that I feel fit into the "next 25". A well accepted call in many areas as a variation of spin the top but with nice smooth action and good choreography value. Fan The Top is best taught from an ocean wave From normal waves the centers (girls) turn left 3/4 while the ends (boys) move up 1/4 to reform the ocean wave. You have kept the same relationship in the wave but the wave has moved clockwise 1/4. In building dancer reaction to Fan The Top I suggest you work from the already established wave first, then call a do sa doe and move into the Fan The Top without establishing the wave and last move into the call from facing couples. A hint there will be to have the couples move forward as if to pass thru, when the dancers are lined up the centers can take left forearms and turn 3/4 while the ends continue to move around and reform the ocean wave...

#### How to use Fan The Top

Heads do sa doe to a wave Fan The Top - swing thru turn thru - left alle.

Box 1-4 Do sa doe to a wave eight circulate - Fan The Top swing thru - boys run - bend the line dive thru - pass thru - left alle.

Heads do sa doe to a wave Fan The Top - pass thru (heads lead right) Do so doe to a wave Fan The Top - cross trail - left alle.

Box 1-4 Do sa doe to a wave eight circulate - Fan The Top spin the top - (balance) - boys run bend the line - barge thru - left alle.

Now lets put the boys in the center of the wave....

Heads rollaway 1/2 sashay do sa doe to a wave Fan The Top - swing thru-pass thru left alle. box 1-4

do sa doe to a wave Fan The Top - swing thru - girls run bend the line - box the gnat crosstrail - left alle. 1P-2P Rollaway 1/2 sashay

FAN THE TOP works very well when a casting off flow reforms new waves. Last month we talked about curlique followed by a cast off 3/4 being zero. Follow the curlique cast off 3/4 action with a Fan The Top and you can see how smooth the reforming of the wave with the centers catching left hands leads into the fan the top flow.
