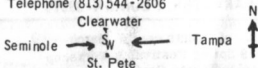

CALLER OF THE MONTH



MEL CLARK

It took two years for CoraBelle to talk Mel into taking square dance lessons (he didn't want anything to do with drinking - fighting Barn dancers), but when he finally took the plunge it was instant love, and a revelation concerning an activity that was soon to become a way of life. In 1955, when the lessons were completed, ten in those days consisting of visiting couple dances and singing calls learned by heart, the Clarks joined three sq. dance clubs and soon were thoroughly involved with this new found type of friendship set to music.

Mel became so imbued with the rythms and patterns of the dance that he began to learn to call, and finally seriously after a Callers Institute at Camdenton, Missouri under the old master Les Gother followed by intensive study. Mel attributes the success of the sq. dance movement in this area and whatever success he may have had to both Bill Muench of Tampa and Joe Curtis of Orlando since deceased. With a great deal of study and some trail Mel found that he was a good teacher. He has taught classes for a great number of people over the years and feels most rewarded when the dancers continue to dance and enjoy the fun and fellowship.

Mel, aided by the most important part of his team, namely; his wife CoraBelle organized Circle 8 of Bartow and a short time later the Sand Mountain Swingers of Fort Meade and the Bar-None Squares of Wauchula. He has called for Buttons & Bows of Lakeland for fifteen of its eighteen years, at first part time basis and then ac Club Caller.

Sandwich in with his job as President of Central Glass Co. Inc. he has numeruos calling engagements thriughtout the state of Florida and has worked as guest staff on the Heart of America Festival and Fontana Village, programed the state convention for four years, was Chairman of the Fla. Callers Clinic, held offices in the Suncoast Callers Ass'n and has been the secretary, Director and President of Florida Callers Association.

Mel is justly proud of his association with Buttons & Bows of Lakeland considered to be one of the oldest continuously organized Clubs in the State. His philosophy, formulated over the years as the results of the countless clinics seems to be based upon the premis that Square Dancing is and should be fun.

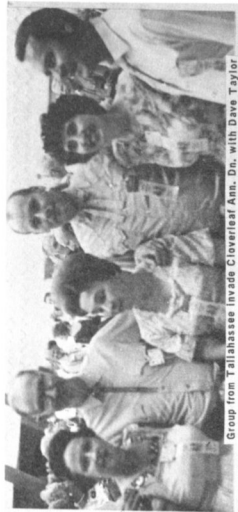

From a wrong way thar you start with a right 1/4 turn then a left 1/2 and a right 3/4 reforming the thar....The initial 1/4 turn is very quick so show that in reality an alamo ring is set up with the initial 1/4 turn - join all hands and the following two movements will fit into place. Although part one is a little quick the dancers caught on quickly and kind of liked the figure.

Re-make the Thar - girls run - promonade
with the opposite

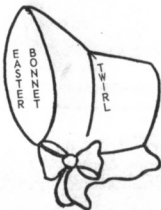
