



CALLER'S CORNER

I have been doing quite a bit of "observing" the past few weeks at the "dancing" being done by the dancers at a few weekends and festivals. I'm wondering if it has reached the point that square dancing is just "figure doing" or have we the callers allowed the dancer to become more interested in just figures and not taking the time to Dance In Time With The Music and to use the proper beats of the figure with the proper beats in the music. What I'm trying to say is lets work hard to put The Dancing Backin Square Dancing. A good place to start is with your classes. Have them dance with the phrase of music, emphasize the musical beat to shuffle with, give the dancer the opportunity to hear a command then perform the movement to the music and have the dancer feel the eight beats of the music that take eight steps to do a "ladies chain". Do this with all the basics and lets see if we can put some importance in the moving to music as well as learning and doing the movements of square dancing.

Dancing the Basics

1P-2P to Box 1-4 (good one to use as a set up)
Pass thru-wheel & deal-double pass thru
Centers in cast off three quaters-lines up and back
Centers-swing thru-box the gnat-square thru four
Ends of the line star thru-(Box 1-4)
