



HOW TRUE IT IS, GALS:

'Tis a man's world, and for men it's rosy.
For men INVESTIGATE, while women are MOSY.
Nen stand FIRM, but the women are MULISH.
The male is INDISORRET, the female is FOOLISH.
A man takes CREDIT, a woman is BRAGGING.
A man is only CRITICAL, but a woman is NAGGING.

But, nevertheless, the feminine gender
Has one advantage it well deserves:
Men have TEMPERS, women have NERVES.

Some pray for sun, and some for rain, And sometimes both together, I pray for sunshine, in my heart, And then forget the weather.

Since so many people have enjoyed the household hints, here are a few more to add to the file:

If you need sour milk or buttermilk for a recipe, don't buy a whole quart but just use the sweet milk on hand and add 2 tablespoons of vinegar to a cup and stir. And presto, you have the sour milk for cake or biscuits.

Don't throw away the stale dried up cheeses that may turn up in your refrigerator. You can either grate them and use on spaghetti, soup or on vegetables, or put them thru a meat grinder with a chunk of onion for a delicious cheese spread.

Left-over egg yolks can be kept in the refrigerator by covering them with cold water, or why not poach them until firm, put them thru a sieve and use as a garnish for a salad.

To thicken soups, try a little catmeal. It adds lots of flavor and richness.

To keep cauliflower snowy white, soak for half in cold sals water before cooking.

To keep peeled or sliced apples from turning brown, place them in a basin of cold salted water as you're peeling and leave them there until you are ready to use them.

For a light, flaky pie crust: Always have shortening very cold before using. Use about one-third as muon shortening as flour. Mix pie crust the day before baking and leave in refrigerator. Roll pastry lightly using as little flour as possible. Roll from the center of the dough out, not back and forth. If you can use a pastry cloth over the board and rolling pin, this will lessen the amount of flour needed. If you are making unbaked pie shells, make them the day before using. The pastry will be more crisp.

You can prevent the inside of your metal salt shakers from rusting by painting them with clear nail polish. When dry, pierce the holes from the inside out with a large darning needle.

If you chill candles in the refrigerator for 24 hours before using them, they

will burn evenly and will not drip.

JACK LASRY

TAG & SCOOT CHAIN THRU - Frank Bedell

A smooth extension on the many tag variations. Based upon the scoot chain thru, the line does a 3/4 tag, the centers who form the wave will swing thru - turn thru - while the lead dancers right about face to meet the dancers coming out of the swing thru turn thru and extend right hands to form two parallel waves...

The figure dances well and with a good teach you can work it even if the dancers are not familiar with scoot chain thru, however it helps if they are - I guess this will only be used by a few callers due to the over saturation of Tag variations already on the market.

Teaching Examples

1P-2P Pass thru- Tag Scoot Chain Thru swing thru-boys run-bend the line right & left thru-barge thru-left alle. Heads right & left thru-

head ladies chain-heads square thru four star thru-pass thru Tag & Scoot Chain Thru-Box 1-4 girls run-bend the line left alle.

Get Outs From 1P-2P Lines

Centers box the gnat & square thru four ends star thru-all slide thru crosstrail-left alle.

Dancing the popular newer basics

1P-2P (right hand) Star to a wave fan the top to a curlique tripple scoot-boys run star thru-crosstrail-left alle.

1P-2P Pass thru-wheel & deal double pass thru-peel off 1/2 tag the line (balance) eight circulate-scoot back boys run-couples circulate wheel & deal-star thru crosstrail-left alle.

1C-2C Line-pass thru-Tag & Scoot Chain Thru swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run
Tag & Scoot Chain Thru

boys run-barge thru

pass thru-left alle.

Right & left thru-centers box the gnat centers square thru four ends star thru-all pass thru left alle.

Box 1-4 (right hand) Star to a wave fan the top-swing thru scoot back-girls trade trade the wave-left alle.

Heads pass thru-U turn back circle eight-boys square thru four swing thru-boys trade-girls trade centers run-wheel & deal-do sa doe to a wave-boys run-left alle.
