

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE DANCERS For almost a year the Florida Square & Round Dance Coordinating Committee has been conducting regular meetings in their effort to provide the most desirable program for the Annual State Convention. This committee comprises twelve members, four from the Florida Callers Association, four from the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and four from the Round Dance Council of Fla.

From these meetings the following program was developed for an initial trail period

of one year:

For the next State Convention, one National Caller and one Florida National Caller will be booked to call the Saturday and Sunday evening programs. They will be available for afternoon clinics for the newer members of the Florida Callers Association. In addition, the Round Dance Council will book a National Round Dance couple for teaching sessions and demonstrations as part of the convention program.

The Trail dance and all daytime programming of square dancing will continue to be the responsibility of the Florida Callers Association and the Round Dance Council

will handle their arrangements as previously done.

The State Area Hosting Committee will submit a short list of preferred callers -National & FCA to the Coordinating Committee, from which a final choice will be made.

In the fall, on the third weekend in October, Area Associations have been asked to schedule big area danes using out of state callers. Clubs would be asked to cancel, where possible, their weekend dances and attend the Area Jamborees, in order to release all club callers to attend the annual educational seminar of the Florida Callers Association. Proceeds from the Jamborees would be placed in a special ac: count to be used to defray the expenses of callers attending the educational seminar.

As the new format for the State Convention will increase costs the price of the Convention ticket will need to be raised accordingly. The associations represented on the Coordinating Committee agreed to accept this proposal for a trail period of one vear.

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

Centers In PUSH OPEN THE GATE - Mac Parker

A novelty idea that combines several directional movements into a flowing novelty call. Set Up - From an eight chain thru box such as a Box 1-4 - Centers in and cast off 3 '4 - 1 the new ends move as if to trade and star thru with the one they meet, while the centers pass thru - ending back in an eight chain thru box. The key to dancing the figure is First establish a good centers in and cast off 3 '4 and having the dancers end with a line having the ends facing out and the centers facing in. From this spot the centers can easily pass thru while the ends move ahead to star thru. The figure is a two zero that is repeat it twice and you zero out. Note: You can vary the end position to a completed double pass thru set up if the end dancers upon doing their star thru end facing out notin.

Mac's idea is called Push Open the Gate, in workshopping the idea we found that adding Centers in to the call we got much better starting reaction as that is really the initial action. So we then took the liberty to start calling it Centers In - Push Open the Gate. Strictly a novelty but enjoyed by the dancers.
