WALT DISNEY WORLD The biggest and most colorful event ever to take place in Fla.'s history of square dancing happened Sept. 22 as wave after wave of square dancers marched their way down Main St., USA, in the Magic Kingdom of Walt Disney World. Three hundred and fifty-five squares pealed off towards Frontierland and Fantasyland to start this enormous square dance. They squared up from the train station in Frontierland to the Tiki House in Adventure land and down towards the Hall of Presidents in Liberty Square; from 20,000 Leagues Under the Sea in Tomorrowland to Cinderella's Castle and around to It's A Small World. Disney employees, officals and the square dancers are saying they never saw anything like it .. eve:.

This was a big dream "finally come true" for Betty Lee Adams and her daughter Susan Elaine of St Cloud. It all began a year ago when they were invited to sponsor their first square dance. They held it in the ballroom of the Americas of the Contemporary Resort Hotel at Walt Disney World. They hoped and dreamed for at least 400 square dancers and were both shocked when over 1,000 square dancers came poring in from all over the state. When one of the Disney personal complimented Betty Lee on her tremendous effort, he suggested that she should begin thinking of what could be done next time and she said, I'm ready. Five times he commented on the dance and that future plans should be made now and five time she answered, I'm ready. And those plans made over a year ago came true as 4,430 square dancers from every corner of Fla. attended Family Fun Night.

Callers for the evening were Pete Sanaom of West Palm Beach calling the squares and Bill Beattie of Hollywood on the rounds from the balcony of the Country Bear Jamboree and Johnny Walters of Miami handled the calling in Fantasyland. Susan Elaine, the youngest female square dance caller in Fla. did several tips at each area. Four additional callers, who's names were picked from a hat assisted by each doing a tip. They were Robert Andrews of Homestead, Colin Walton of Eau Gallie, Joe DiNatale of Miramar and Bob Frye of Melbourne.

Our nats are off to Betty Lee who headed up the committee and spearheaded all the plans for this super spectacular. As in all things she does - it was a labor of love for square dancers. She received absolutely no pay for the many months work she put in to make the first Family Fun Night at Walt Di sney World the success it was.

At the end of the evening, one of the officals told Betty Lee that he had heard this was the largest square dance ever held in Fla. Pointing his finger at Betty Lee, he said. You made all this possible, now have you given any thought to what you want to do next year? She was heard to say, I'm ready!

THANKS TO CENTRAL & NORTHEAST FLA clubs and officers from Ray Cunningham. For eight years you have given us while calling and teaching for you and dancing with you. Now Bernice and I have moved to Tallahassee where we expect to meet lots more nice folks. Come visit us sometime. Ray Cunningham

He won this title on June 16, 1973, in Slade, Kentucky, at Hoedown Island in Natural Bridge State Park during the 7th Annual National Mountain-Style Clogging Contest, directed by Mr. Richard Jett, of Campton, Kentucky, a fine caller and promoter of clogging and square dancing.

Tony also competed in the World Clogging Championship in Gatlinburg, Tenn. and won 5th place in the Grand-Championship, making him the youngest person to place in the

grand-championships.

Tony, originally of Hendersonville, N.C., learned to clog at the age of eight by mocking his mother who had been a member of a clogging team herself in her teens. Clogging, according to Tony, is very popular in the mountains of N.C. Kentucky and Tenn., but, unfortunately, is not tjat well known in the state of Fla. Tony hopes that clogging will gain popularity in Fla. thru his efforts of giving exhibition lessons, and workshops in Mountain-Style clogging at various square dances throughout Florida.



# FEATURE FIGURE FOR THE MONTH

# THE

**CALLER'S CORNER** 

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - Motivate - Lee Kopman

JACK LASRY

An interesting figure for experience dancers but not only for the challenge dancer. This figure must fit into the Relay the Top - Spin Chain the Gears type. Smooth flowing but action filled our workshoppers enjoyed the figure.

From two parallel ocean waves - Box 1-4 Ocean Waves

All 8 circulate - the ends (boys) circulate another 1/2 - the girls (centers) now cast off or turn 3/4

This will set up a six hand wave boys on each end and have two boys along side the wave

The two boys on the side of the wave put your right hand up to form a right hand star with the two center girls in the wave..

Now - break up the set into three parts - the right hand star in the center and a pair with right hands held at each end. Three Seperate Parts - the ends will turn 1/2 by the right as the star turns 1/2 - as the wave thru the center is reformed, the boys on the "wings" remove their right hand - and those in the wave with left hands holding will then turn 3/4 to become the centers of the new wave - the inside boys step ahead and hook on to form one end of the wave as the girl on the outside moves ahead to form the other end of the wave - ends with two parallel waves boys facing out - girls in..

### Now lets review

Box 1-4 Wave - 8 circulate - boys go 1 1/2 - girls cast off 3/4 -

This will set up the long wave that you will break up into the two ends and the center star - Ends swing 1/2 - star turns 1/2 - those with the left forearms cast 3/4 others step ahead to become ends of the wave..

Helpful Hint - The boys facing out on the end of the starting wave will be the boys in the star ..

## Getting Aquainted With Motivate

Box 1-4 - Do sa doe to a wave Motivate - boys run Right & left thru - two ladies chain (1P-2P) Star thru-swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

Box 1 -4 Do sa doe to a wave Motivate - boys run Slide thru - swing thru - boys run

Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle. Note - you will have re-teach to the set up with sides square thru to the Box 1-4 as

each dancer will be reversed in position from the heads square thru to the Box 1-4... A good dancing workshop call but our early observation is it won't replace Spin

Chain the Gears with the average dancers yet..

#### Dancing The Popular Basics

1P-2P - Curlique - 8 circulate Cast off 3/4 - boys trade Spin the top-scoot back Boys run - bend the line Slide thru - left alle. Bcx 1-4

1P-2P-Centers box the gnat-all curlique - 8 circulate - cat off 3/4 Grand swing thru-spin the top Scoot back - boys run Right & left thru-flutter wheel-left alle.

Box 1-4 - Do sa doe to a wave

Motivate - boys run - right & left thru


