After getting out of the service he decided to try his hand at calling. He really feels that Bob Rust and Tex Brownlee rendered him help in learning to call. When it seemed rough and he was ready to give it up it was them who would always say, 'keep trying, you will get it'. He feels that if more callers would help the new ones along we would have some good callers in the state.

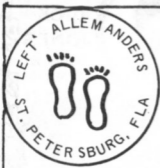

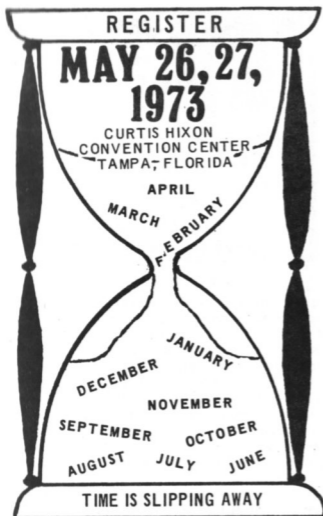

ODDS & ENDS

BY EMILY LEACH

Bette Daggy of St. Petersburg was kind enough to share some of her cooking tips with us and I'm sure you will find them very useful and informative.

LIVER: Cover with milk and let stand about two hours in refrigerator. Dry thoroly and dip in seasoned flour or bread crumbs, then saute or broil.

LIMES: Can be used in most of the way of lemon. They are also excellent meat tenderizers. Squeeze over meat and let stand 1/2 hr. before cooking.

ONION: For juice, sprinkle a little salt on the cut surface and then scrape with a knife or spoon to get the juice. You can also chop and then freeze them in a plastic bag and they will keep for months.

RAISINS: For extra flavor in cookies or puddings, chop them instead of using them whole.

OLIVES: To keep them shiny roll them in a few drops of salad oil.

STEWs: Don't put too much liquid in the stew pot, only enough to cover the contents. To avoid having it boil away too soon, cut a sheet of wax paper the size of the pot punch a tiny hole in the center and use it to cover the stew. Then put on the lid and cook over a slow flame. To add more flavor, saute your vegetables in butter first then add to stew.

PRUNES: For richer syrup when cooking prunes, use prune juice instead of water. Another tip, use honey in place of sugar, or add a few thin slices of lemon while cooking.

CRANBERRY JUICE: For easy removal from can, punch hole in bottom of can.

OATMEAL COOKIES: If you toast the oatmeal first, the cookies will be more flavorful and crunchy. Spread oatmeal in a shallow pan and let the oven toast it while heating it to baking temperature.

TEA: Add an orange peel to the teapot a few minutes before tea is served for added tang.

SOUR FRUIT: A pinch of salt added while cooking will greatly reduce the amount of sugar need to sweeten them.

POTATOES: If you soak them in salt water for 20 min. before baking, they will bake faster.

BACON: Soak the bacon in cold water for a few minutes before frying and it will lessen the tendency to shrink and curl.

HAMBURGERS: Add one grated potatoe to each pound of hamburger for juicy, luscious burgers. This should also be good in meat loaf.

LEMONS: Will keep fresh if you place in a glass jar filled with water and covered tightly.

RICE: If you would like to be fluffier simply add 1 tsp. lemon juice to each quart water while cooking.

COOKING MILK: To keep it from scorching, rinse the pan in hot water before using.

EGGS: When hard-boiling, add salt to the water to make shelling easier.

CELERY: For crisping, let stand in cold water to which 1 tsp. of sugar for each quart of has been added.

SCRAMBLED EGGS: Add bread crumbs to improve the flavor and enlarge the portions.

FRENCH FRIES: Let raw potatoe stand in cold water for at least 1/2 hr. before frying and they will be more crispy.

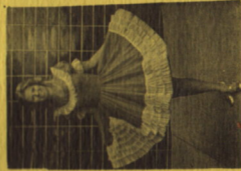

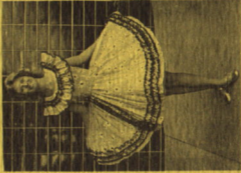
