CALLER'S CORNER

REVIEW BASIC...CROSS RUN - is a real part of the RUN family and should be considered a good basic for all dancers to know. A handy Choreography Tool we see the move as part of many combination basics being thought up which compiler uns with cross runs. These are quite danceable But without a good background of dancing Cross Runs the dancers are behind the eight ball...

R:call, a Cross Run from lines or waves will have the end dancer move forward and move into the center position closest to the far end of the line or wave. On the call Centers Cross Run, the centers will move forward to the far end of the same line or wave. Like the Run family the active dancers will chance facing direction, and the inactive dancers should move in or out to fill the vacated positions to keep the waves or lines uniform.

As I indicated earlier some nice combinations can be danced using cross runs and runs. I would like to explain two such movements. Switch The Wave: From ocean waves the ends will cross run while the centers run into the vacated end position adjacent to them Both ends & centers move simultaneously and you end in a two face line. Switch thewave works smoothest from waves to lines as the traffic pattern flow of the dancers is away from each other. Will work from two face lines back to waves but not as smoothly as the next idea.

Cross Roll To An Ocean Wave: Cross roll has the Reverse Pattern from switch - The Centers Cross Run while the ends run into the adjacent position. Both centers & ends move simultaneously. Cross Rolls work best from two face lines, ending in ocean waves. The traffic pattern again is a crossing one and really is smooth. Like Switch, you can start from ocean waves but the traffic is not as smooth.

I have given some thought to the difference in names when one figure is really the reverse action of the other. Our group opinion is that you are more likely to confuse the dancers with the term reverse. take on the figure. Please!!! If your workshoppers are the danilar with these figures don't try to present both at the same time. Pick on one then after it is mastered then try the other...
