



Clover Flo - Bill Davis - Clover Flo is a simple combination of standard moves that dancers at All levels should accept easily. From the starting position for a Trade By (one couple facing each other in) the facing out couple does a standard Cloverleaf - then follow it with a normal pass thru - the facing in dancers pass thru first then a Cloverleaf... You end in an eight chain thru position. When your rade by set up is made up of couples in normal position is also normal. The figure times out well and is easily set up and also easily learned. Note - Like many calls if used too often in a tip it is like grand square, fun but who wants to do it 10 times in one tip!!! Encourage the dancers not to rush thru the figure but takes the steps in time with the music and they will accept this one at all levels.
