## THE CALLER'S CORNER

For the workshopppers, here is a review of some of the better dancing Experimental Ideas of the past few months....

**Switch Er Ru:** This movement is providing quite dancable and smooth flowing. If you passed it up before re-read as I have a new teach that makes the figure easily learned. From Parallal Normal Waves the Ends (boys) start to trade places, at the half way point in the trade they will meet right shoulder to right shoulder and with right forearms cast off 3/4. The centers of the wave (girls) will at the same time run to the right into the adjacent vacated position and then as a outside position circulate one position, ending in a two face line. Of course you can have the girls on the end of the wave and proceed in a similar manner. The figure dances well is easily taught and the starting position of an ocean wave and the end position of a two face line are very standard.

### A few teaching examples...

Box 1-4 Ocean wave-Switch Er Ru  
(boys by the right 3/4 girls run and circulate)

Swing thru-boys run

Bend the line-cross trail-left alle.

1P-2P Star thru-do sa doe to a wave

Scout back-Switch Er Ru

Bend the line-barge thru-left alle.

Box 1-4 Swing thru-Switch Er Ru-

(girls by the right 3/4- boys run and circulate)

Wheel & deal-pass thru

Left alle.

Once the basic pattern is learned you can move from alot of nice motion into Switcheru. All eight circulate - Switcheru - swing thru - Switcheru etc.....For workshopppers this is a worthwhile combination.

**Cross Roll To An Ocean Wave:** is another of the newer calls that I find very dancable and usable...It seems to be a bit contraversial due to the old call switch the wave having opposite action and some feel it should be called "reverse the switch" or some other manes...However I've enjoyed calling and teaching Cross Roll because I like what it does and how it happens. Moving smoothly from a two face line into an ocean wave, from the two face line, the centers cross run to the far end while the ends "Roll over" into the vacated adjacent position ending in the ocean wave. In teaching the call from the two face line I've said "Girls, as centers now cross run to the far end and the boys just "flop" over into the vacated spot and form the wave", The term "flop over" seems to make sense to the dancers. The basic idea is very acceptable and perhaps the word usage can be adapted to be directional by calling "cross and roll" direct who crosses (cross run) and the others "roll over" into the vacated adjacent spot. You could then direct "ends" cross & roll, meaning ends cross run, centers roll into adjacent position. This may cause an uproar with what does a "Roll" mean....Roil as in roll right to a wave or Roll as in right & left roll???? Oh well, some day these terms that sound the same but mean different things will be standardized.....How do you feel????

### Dancing Cross Roll to an Ocean Wave...

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run

Cross roll to a wave(girls cross - boys roll)

Boys run-bend the line

Star thru-Z ero box 1-4

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run-girls trade

Cross roll to a wave

Boys trade-boys run-bend the line

Right & left thru-slide thru-zero box 1-4

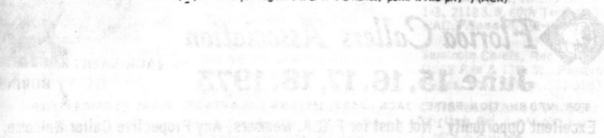
