





SPIN CHAIN THE LINE - A spin chain thru idea that starts from facing lines. To teach bring the set to a 1P-2P line and for your teach do sa doe to a wave. Swing or turn right 1/2 - Boys turn left 3/4 - Girls at this point have a wave thru the center of the set, the center girls trade then turn with the end girl 3/4 ending in a left hand wave boys on the ends girls in the center. Easily taught however, the dancers who trade in the center are a little "surprised" at being able to trade so easily. The timing is a little bad for the for the boys who are left waiting on the ends for the new wave to form. Once the idea is well established you can circulate the outsiders just as in the normal Spin Chain Thru. This on could be a sleeper, to early to tell but give it a try.

Examples

1P-2P Spin Chain the Line Girls run - bend the line Right & left thru-flutter wheel Slide thru - left alle.

1P-2P Rollaway 1/2 sashay

Spin chain the line (turn rt-girls 3/4 ctr. boys trade cast off 3/4)

Boys cross run Right & left thru

Dive thru-pass thru-left alle. Box 1-4

Dancing the Basics

Choreo Note: From standard parallel waves the following two calls are equivalents of each other Spin chain thru - Girls circulate double----

and Swing thru - girls circulate - boys trade--

You can interchange these two combinations and the end result is idential dancer positioning....The following are themes or combinations that start from 1P-2P and must be repeated twice, the end position will be in a line and in sequence and the dancers will have partner or opposite as indicated...When using these themes like this rather then repeating exactly the same combination try inserting equivalents but always in the proper sequence of calls.

1P-2P Star thru-swing thru-boys run

Tag the line right Girls circulate - boys trade - girls run Spin chain thru-girls circulate double Boys run bend the line Repeat to 1P-2P 1P-2P Star thru-Swing thru-girls

circulate boys trade Boys run - bend the line - right & left thru Flutter wheel .

Zero Repeat to end in 1 o-20 line

1P-2P Right & left thru-ladies lead Dixie Style to a ocean wave-
