





CALLER'S CORNER

REVIEW BASIC - FLAIR THE STAR

Flair the Star was catching on fast as a nice smooth dancing idea that was easily learned and along came Flutter Wheel and Flair the Star died fast. However Flair is still a very pretty figure and now that Flutter Wheel is here to stay and is a standard call I thought unight like to review Flair the Star. To refresh your memories: Flair the Star starts from facing couples, they make a right hand star, and as the star turns, at the 1/2 way point when the boy has reached the other side of the set, the boys make a large left face Flair Turn and end facing back in. The girls keep a two hand star turning full around, back to their original starting spot and are met there for a courtesy turn. From normal facing couples the end result is a right & left thru and two ladies_chain.

The figure works nicely in combination with flutter wheel, but the order of combination is important in that a flutter wheel is best after a Flair the Star.

DANCING FLAIR THE STAR

Heads Flair the Star Sides Flair the Star Four ladies chain-circle left-left alle.

Box 1-4 - Star thru Pass thru-partner trade Flair the Star-dixie style tp a wave Left alle.

1P-2P- Flair the Star Flutter wheel-Zero Heads Flair the Star Square thru four - equals heads lead right

1P-2P Flair the Star Dixie style to a wave Boys run-bend the line Star thru-left alle.

Promenade with partner in sequance Heads wheel around-pass thru Partner trade-Flair the Star Star thru-dive thru Swing thru-turn thru-left alle.

An all eight Flair the Star is a real pretty figure also, and you can almost get away calling it cold after the basic idea is working O.K. All Eight Flair the Star - all eight right hand star, when the boys reach the opposite side of the set they Flair Out while the girls kept staring back home for the couresty turn.

Example: Four ladies chain - All eight Flair the Star - Circle left - Alle, left
