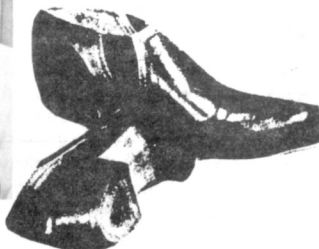

CHAIRMAN OF THE FEDERATION MESSAGE - 12 Commandments of Square Dancing - I will introduce myself to at least one new couple at each dance

I will not "sit out" a dance if one more couple is needed to fill a square

I will serve on the refreshment committee or otherwise do my share of club duties, whenever asked

I'll try to look like I'm having a good time while I square dance

I'll have a pleasant word for the caller, and not ignore him until I have a complaint

I won't glare at my corner if he makes a mistake - after all, I sometime miss too

If I feel like shouting to show my exuberance, I'll do it during a pause in the call, and not when it will drown out the caller

I'll leave the instruction to the caller, and not try to explain the dance to my own square

I'll remember that personal grooming is important to my acceptance in a square dance group

I'll keep my dancing "standard" unless I am sure that the rest of my square approves of those extra twirls, etc.

I'll remember that once upon a time I was a beginner, and be willing to dance with those who had less experience than I have had

I'll try to remember that "a stranger" is a friend I haven't met"

We welcome new members this month, the Fishs, and the Boultons. Also we are happy to see many of our friends returning from the snow country. Happy dancing to all of you.

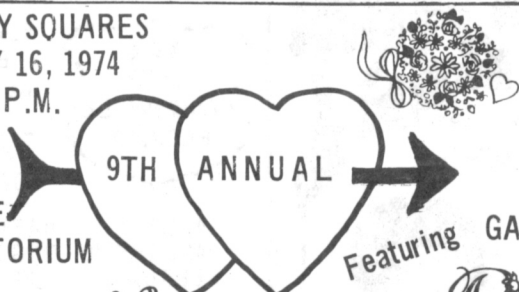

THE CALLER'S CORNER

VIEWPOINT: We find that this month we have nothing of real value to the average dancer to report. Oh sure there are plenty of ideas but nothing that will really add to our activity. We do have two Gimmick calls that may interest the advanced workshop groups who enjoy the choreo mind benders. The chorus of shouts for some sort of control of the flood of confusing experimental basics is again loud and clear. Even the super challenge dancer who dances eight nights a week is crying for relief.....What's the answer ??? I trust that at the caller Lab Convention next April that we can come up with a workable solution..... I have been charged with making the presentation in this area and if you have any ideas please send them to me or to Bob Osgood at Sets In Order We sincerely hope that some good ideas and some real attainable goals can be reached.

BASIC CHOREOGRAPHY

This month lets look at some basic and simple ways to move from a couple of standard lines 1P-2P and 10-20 to a basic Box 1-4 set up.

1. 1P-2P - Pass Thru - wheel & deal - centers swing thru - turn thru - Box 1-4
2. 1P-2P - Star thru - swing thru - girls circulate - boys trade - boys run - bend the line star thru - Box 1-4.
3. 1P-2P - Star thru - spin chain thru - girls circulate double - boys run - bend the line - slide thru - Box 1-4.
4. 1P-2P - Star thru - do sa doe to a wave - scoot back - girls circulate - boys trade - boys run - wheel & deal - right & left thru - Box 1-4.
5. 10-20 - Star thru - spin chain thru - boys run - bend the line - star thru - Box 1-4.
6. 10-20 - Star thru - do sa doe to a wave - boys circulate - right & left thru - Box 1-4.
7. 10-20 - Pass thru - wheel & deal - double pass thru - cloverleaf - centers swing - turn thru - Box 1-4
8. 10-20 - Star thru - swing thru - scoot back - boys circulate - girls trade - 8 circulate - Box 1-4.

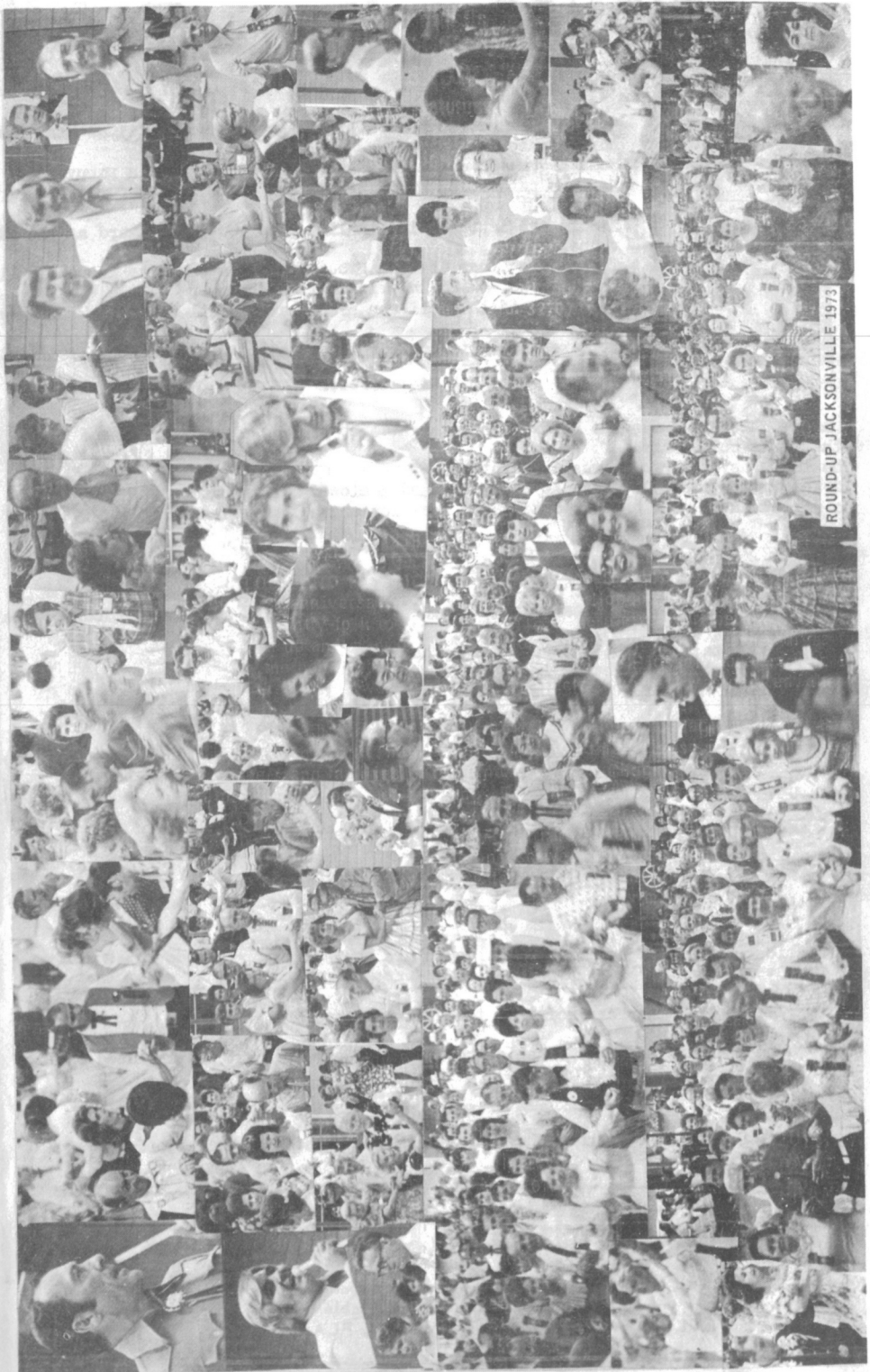

JACK LASRY'S NOTES FOR CALLERS
