WORKSHOP IDEAS: PARTNER HINGE

This is not a new idea but may have a larger part in our dance then we let it. We all do partner trade and Partner Hinge, it is easily performed and ends in a useful set up so lets explore a little. To do a Partner Hinge the dancers are really doing exactly 1/2 of a partner trade, they start to move forward and end right shoulder to right shoulder in a wave formation. Lets start easy and get aquainted with Partner Hinge.

1P-2P Pass thru-Partner Hinge-balance Girls trade-swing thru-turn thru-left alle. Scoot back-boys run-bend the line

1P-2P Pass thru-Partner Hinge-balance Crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Pass thru-Partner Hinge - balance Eight circulate-swing thru-boys run Bend the line - pass thru - Partner Hinge Girls trade - swing thru - girls circulate - boys trade Boys run-bend the line-barge thru-left alle.

Partner Hinge from couples in a two face line:

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run Partner Hinge - balance - scoot back Boys run - right & left thru Flutter Wheel -slide thru-left alle. Zero Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run-couples circulate Partner Hinge - balance Split circulate - boys run - right & left thru Rollaway 1/2 sashay - star thru Trade by - left alle.

Partner Hinge from columns 1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay Curlique - eight circulate - Partner Hinge Boys run - bend the line - left alle. SD box 1-4

1P-2p Curlique-eight circulate Partner Hine - fan the top Girls run - tag the line right Wheel & deal-left alle. Box 1-4


