### CALLER'S CORNER

**VIEWPOINT: Lets stop making every dance a workshop.** Thats quite a statement - In talking with dancers in quite a few places it seems that there is not enough seperation of workshop material and just good club level dancing. If you use a lot of Experimental Material at Club dances and find that you end up workshoping every tip in order to get the dancers thru the material planned for that tip then something is wrong. In your honest attempt to keep your dancers up with the so called latest and greatest you have fallen into the trap that can lead to the loss of the philosophy of a square dance club. With so much experimental material and with some dancers wanting it all - Just what is the answer, I say good judgement! How can we practice that? Well, if we spent a little more time putting the basics that we all accept into interesting patterns and not all our effort into new experimental ideas then we could keep the dancers on their toes by being alert to variations of the norm rather than trying to keep their interest only with new names and combinations. Don't get me wrong, I'm not against new material but feel that the dancers who want to spend all evening with experimental figures should attend a workshop dance. Workshoping at club dances is necessary also but one tip is enough. Judging by the floors reaction to your new figure should determine if you call it during the rest of the dance. All the more reason that we need a better way to advertise the philosophy of each club dance.

#### NOVELTY WORKSHOP IDEA - Peel & Streak - Paul Nadeau

It is just a matter of time until this social fad of the college students led to a square dance call. Actually we have received three ideas and have selected this one -

**Set Up** - From the "Z" formation (ends fold out of an ocean wave (such as Box 1-4 ♣ Swing thru - girls fold - The boys or the leaders peel off and circulate "streak" the designated number of spots. Thetrailers, girls, step ahead and turn left 3/4 to ste up a girls wave - center girls trade - and then the end girls cast 3/4 to end back in parallel waves. You can see with one walk thru that the figure dances smoothly and is a variation of peel the top or peel and type choreography. A cute novelty that should get a few laughs and add a little fun flavor to your program.

If you use peel the top or peel off from the Z set up it will be easily learned.

#### Dancing Peel & Streak

Box 1-4 Swing thru - girls circulate - boys trade ♣  
Girls fold - Peel & Streak  
Boys go double - girls run - bend the line - left alle

Box 1-4 Swing thru - girls fold  
Peel & Streak - Boys go double ♣

Star thru - dive thru - pass thru



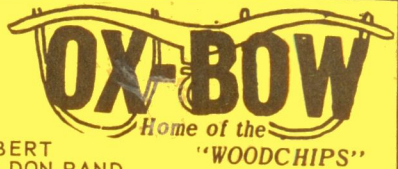
