WHEREAS, folk and square dances are an integral, important and expressive part of American art and culture, and

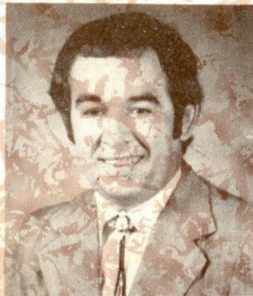

**THE DAWSONS OF SARASOTA** By Milton W. Kelly - Those of you who have traveled extensively may have observed that wherever our favorite recreation enjoys a large

following, a breed of specialist usually develops - that is, our leaders become expert at either square dance calling OR round dance cueing; they rarely excel at both.

Bob & Shirley Dawson of Sarasota to my mind, are in the 'rare' category. During their twenty-five years of professional leadership they have avoided the one-tract route and have devoted their talents to the art and science of Both square and round dance therapy, even prompting contras and quadrilles for variety. This, I think, makes them worth writing about.

Although rounds were always offered the Dawsons were perhaps best known for promoting square dancing. Recently, however, to meet the increasing popularity of round dancing in the area they

now give a substantial portion of their six-day week schedule to rounds in Sarasota and nearby Venice. Their Home Base, as most natives know, is at the Sarasota Mobile Home Park on Laurel St. where they have been dance directors for twelve years. Rounds are featured at five of their seven square dance sessions but the remaining two are reserved for rounds exclusively. A Second Sunday Rounds every month will be instituted in the Fall and for a little frosting on the cake they will repeat a few dinner-dances so well received last year. As the song title goes: Who Could Ask For Anything More?

Once prominent on the national circuit, the Dawsons have elected to remain in Sarasota for the past thirteen years because they found the local scene more absorbing and demanding of their time. Bob's extensive experience in calling squares at all levels has given him a highly ability in timing and phrasing which he now applies with remarkable effectiveness in teaching and cueing rounds. His mellow vocal delivery doesn't hurt either. All his programs lean heavily on the Basic-Plus concept with strong emphasis on smooth dancing and maximum fun.

Of course, petite Shirley (the gal behind the guy who gets the applause), must not be overlooked. She's Bob's bookkeeper, business assistant, and best critic, but her image to dancers on the floor is most noticeable in the demonstrations and teaching of rounds where she reflects poise and styling befitting her role. During the Breaks between dances or tips she becomes Bob's social emissary by circulating among the dancers dispensing typical Irish wit and humor. (If you haven't heard some of her jokes, you've missed a bucket of laughs) If you were to analyze the popularity and continuous success of the Dawsons with both young and old alike, the list would include: easy to intermediate dance choreography, sing-a-long lyrics, non-tiring duration of tips, simplicity of teaching methods, humorous interjections while at the 'mike', and personalities as warm and consistent as the Florida sunshine. ✓

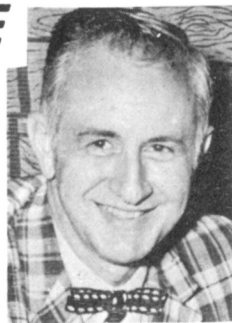

## This is CALLERLAB in ACTION . . . .

Jack Lasry, along with a newly-formed Experimental Basic Selection Committee of twenty members from all over North America, has announced the following choices for the coming quarter of the year. Readers are reminded of Resolution 3 (New Movements) passed by Callerlab members in St. Louis .

Here are the choices and Jack's comments:

The CALLERLAB experimental figures for the quarter are intended to serve as a guide for callers and dance leaders whose clubs dance "mainstream" club level, and who desire some direction regarding what experimental ideas should be used. With the flood of new ideas each month we hope that our "approved" figures will bring back some order in what experimental figures are worthy of mainstream exposure.

We can only suggest. If your club is over-exposed to experimental figures and you are concerned about it, then tell your callers to workshop only the "CALLERLAB approved" experimental figures.

NOTE: Any figure not currently in the Basic 75 list is considered experimental until such time as the next possible revision meeting next March.

**WALK AND DODGE**— From any four hand or two hand ocean wave, the dancers facing in will walk forward taking the place of the dancer directly across the set. The dancer facing out will slide or step into the vacated spot of the adjacent dancer.

### EXAMPLES:

Heads curlique  
Heads walk and dodge  
Swing thru, turn thru  
Left allemande.....


Heads square thru four  
Swing thru, cast off  $\frac{3}{4}$ , balance  
Walk and dodge, California twirl  
Star thru, dive thru, square thru  $\frac{3}{4}$   
Left allemande.....

**RECYCLE**— The figure starts in an ocean wave and the end result is that the dancers have done a right and left thru and two ladies chain, so you can see the wave is back to a facing box and the two boys have exchanged places. The action of the figure is as follows: From the basic wave, the centers (girls) fold behind the end boys adjacent to them and as the ends (boys) cross fold the girls follow and end back in their original starting spot.

### EXAMPLES:

Heads square thru four  
Do-sa-do to a wave  
Recycle, right and left thru  
Two ladies chain, left allemande.....  
Heads square thru four  
Do-sa-do to a wave  
Girls trade, recycle  
Dive thru, square thru  $\frac{3}{4}$   
Left allemande.....

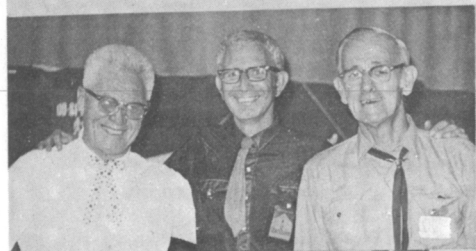

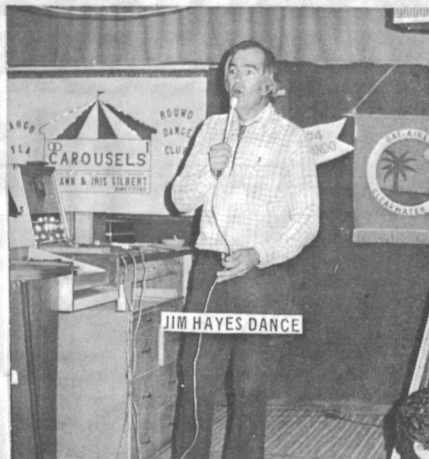
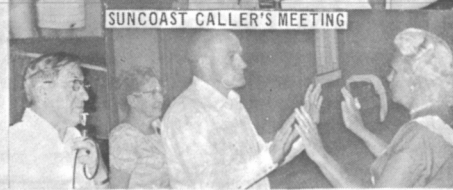

## THE CALLER'S CORNER

### REVIEW EXPERIMENTAL FIGURE - RECYCLE - Lee Kopman

We mentioned earlier in the year that because the figure Recycle has several different positions to react with different actions all under the same command name that we felt it best not to feature. In the past five months One Recycle position has become popular workshop material and really does have good dancing value. The Rycycle from the Ocean Wave is the position we shall review.

### Teaching Recycle From The Ocean Wave

Start in a Box 1-4 - Tell the dancers to see where they are standing now, then have the two boys exchange places and tell the dancers that when they have completed the figure recycle that the boys will have exchanged places and the girls will be back in the same spot they are now in. Now step into your ocean wave. On call Recycle the girls will fold behind the adjacent end dancer and follow him in single file 1/2 circle to end facing right and in the desired box set up. The figure equals a Flutter Wheel in positioning. Note - Some areas are eliminating the girls fold portion of the teach and have the boys start walking toward their end position and the girls will turn and follow along. Our dancers found this way the most acceptable.

### Dancing Recycle For The Basic Ocean Wave

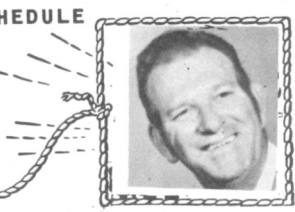

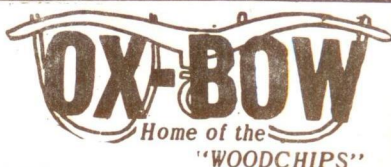
