





## Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

The objective of this cloumn is to provide callers with challenging material using the mainstream basics. Pending a hoped for revision by Callerlab, the basics used here will be the Sets In Order 75 + 10 list (see Square Dancing, Nov. 1974). Any mainstream dancer should be able to dance this material, but to do so they must know their basics. To save space, the four positions you know from using Jack Lasry's material in past years will be used to indicate starting and ending points for some figures; you can then use your own set-ups and get-outs. I hope you find this material worthwhile.

This month's figures use the basic Trade-By.

1P-2P Pass thru - Wheel & deal
Double Pass thru - Centers in cast off 3/4
Square thru - Trade by - Swing thru
Girls run - Box the gnat - Rt. & Left Thru
Slide thru - Pass thru - Left Alle.

Box 3-2 Ocean Wave - Girls trade Swing thru - Pass thru - Trade by Curlique - Men fold - Ladies chain Dixie style to Left Alle.

Box 3-2 Swing thru - Boys trade Pass thru - Trade by - Curlique Boys fold - Girls Turn thru - Star Thru Boys trade - Girls Run - Girls Trade Pass Thru - Grand Right & Left. 1P2P Pass thru- Boys run- Swing thru Centers run- Wheel & deal-Square thru 3/4- Trade by- Curlique Boys circulate- Boys run-Bend the line- Star thru- Pass thru Trade by- Left Alle. As tired as we were from driving all day, we hurried up and showered and changed and went to the dance and had a most enjoyable evening, making new friends that we still hear from . On a flight back from the Nationals at San Antonio, baller Bobby Andrews got some of us up and put us thru a couple of movements to earn our 41,000 feet badge. Afterwards a passenger started asking Bir questions about square dancing and if there were any clubs for singles. She was from San Diego and Bir sent her the California book and now Nancy is going thru two classes and even recruited seven more people into the class. We hear from her regularly as to the progress she is making and she is very enthusiastic about it all.

We would like to encourage dancers from Florida to dance with others in other states as you travel around and while doing so spread the good word about dancing in Fla. Take along a few extra copies of Bow & Swing, or your local square dance magazines, and give them out. We find that when we do this the people are very appreciative and interested in seeing what is going on in dancing elsewhere and while they may not be planning an immediate trip to Florida, usually they have a square dance friend who is heading our way .. so spread the good will of dancing every opportunity you get.

## The International Association of Square Dance Callers CALLERLAB WORKSHOP POLL

The Callerlab Experimental Workshop Committee has made the following selections for the coming quarter: *Transfer the column* and *Half tag trade and roll*.

The quarter has been adjusted to coincide with the calendar year and the present selections will be for the April, May and June quarter.

The committee feels that these selected workshop figures are the best of the experimental ideas explored over the past several months. By no means should a caller feel obligated to teach any experimental basics even those selected by Callerlab if the selected figures do not fit into your club level. For instance, it would be foolish to attempt to teach *transfer the column* to a group of new dancers who just formed a club after graduating from 30 weeks of lessons. The selected workshop figures are aimed at the mainstream dance program that finds itself overwhelmed with experimental figures and just plain tired of having every dance turn into a workshop.

Our aims and goals are to help the mainstream caller and dance leader in the selection of worthwhile experimental figures as we recognize that they are part of the square dance picture. By selecting only a few figures each quarter (no more than two), the average dancer will get a steady flow of good workshop ideas but not be snowed under.

TRANSFER THE COLUMN BY LEE KOPMAN APPEARED IN THE FEB ISSUE HALF TAG TRADE AND ROLL

This is a smooth combination of three basics which are part of the title. The action is very smooth and easily directed. From any line formation the dancers first do half tag the line, then trade with the adjacent dancer; then each dancer rolls or turns to face the one traded with.

The trade or turn half portion of the figure followed by the roll to end facing is very smooth but exacting. Callers can feel that this movement can be called directionally and actually that is exactly what you are doing. You should feel free to make directional changes in the movement. For example: Half tag, trade and boys run — the boys run is substituted for the roll. This call gives a lot of directional variety and fun dancing.

Heads square thru four Swing thru, boys run Half tag, trade and roll Right and left thru Left allemande....... Heads lead right and circle to a line Slide thru, swing thru Half tag, trade and roll Pass thru
Left allemande...........


