EXPERIMENTAL BASIC FOR MAINSTREAM WORKSHOPS CHECKMATE THE COLUMN - H. Williams

The variations of Transfer The Column continue... This was originally just plain Checkmate.. However the addition of the words The Column add the necessary "clue" for the dancers and because it is in the Transfer the Column Family it has a better Rina.

The action starts from the columns and a basic starting point is the column set up from 1P-2P lines by doing a Curlique. The Figure ends in a two face line and takes approx. 6 beats to perform however at the start I suggest 8 beats. The Lead two dancers in each column will start as if doing a Transfer the Column by walking single file around the adjacent column and moving single file toward the "foot" of the column. In Checkmate the Column I suggest the dancers travel a little further down the line and when they turn to face, that they stay close together as a couple. The trailing two dancers in each column will move ahead single file until they completely pass the oncoming dancers (a full tag if you must) then individually make a Right face turn and as a couple step ahead to become the left end of the formed Two Face Line. From a 1P-2P line followed by the curlique to a column, Checkmate The Column ends in a two face line with boys in the center and girls on the end. If the 1P-2P line does a 1/2 sashay then a curlique to the column followed by the Checkmate action the two face line ends with boys on the ends and girls in the center.

Our workshop dancers felt this call was a worthy addition to the Transfer Family and easily mastered and comfortable to dance

Dancing Checkmate The Column

1P-2P Curlique - Checkmate the Column / 1P-2P Curlique - Checkmate the Column / Bend the line - box the gnat Right & left thru - crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Curlique - Checkmate the Column / 1P-2P Rollaway - curlique Boys trade - boys cross run Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway Curlique - Checkmate the Column Wheel & deal - swing thru - turn thru Left alle.

1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway Curlique - Checkmate the Column Rend the line - 1P-2P line

Bend the line - star thru - left alle.

Checkmate the Column Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Pass thru-U turn back Curlique - Checkmate the Column Boys circulate - girls trade Wheel & deal - dive thru Square thru 3/4 - left alle.

Heads pass thru around one to a line 🛩 Curlique - Checkmate the Column Bend the line - star thru Zoom - square thru 3/4 - left alle.

Note - It really helps to emplasize the action of the trailing dencers in the column. Once the trailing dancers finish their "tag action" that they face right and as a couple step forward to form the two face line. This is the "key" to an easy teach and smooth dancing.




