



EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - MAINSTREAM LEVEL

DRIFT AROUND - Al Donahue

Al was at a dance I called in Mass. ealier this month and told me about his idea. I have used it about three weeks with all level groups and find it a reasonable idea. The action starts with couples back to back after having completed a pass thru. We shall use normal positioned dancers for our explination. The girls position will do a zoom action while the boys will run into the vacating girls position to end as facing couples. NOTE Both the girls and the boys starting action is to the Right. The Zoom for the airls can cause a little confusion if the girls do not dance a normal Zoom to take the place of the boy behind her. Also add for the girls the fact that they will end facing the wallthey are looking at when they start as some will not complete the Zoom. The Zoom is a little further then when in a double pass thru set up so see that the girls fully understand a Zoom. Dancer reaction is very good. The flow is smooth and the figure gives us some nice action from couples facing out. The selection of follow up calls is no problem as you use any facing couple figure and if used from lines of four facing out then each pair of dancers back to back work their Drift Around and you end in lines facing.

GETTING ACQUAINTED WITH DRIFT AROUND

1P-2P Pass thru - Drift Around Slide thru - swing thru Boys run - bend the line - crosstrail -Left alle.

Heads pass thru - Drift Around Saugre thru four - Equals heads lead right 1P-2P Pass thru - Drift Around . Right & left thru - flutter wheel Cross trail - left alle.

Heads pass thru - Drift Around Lead to the right - left alle. Box 1-4

1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Centers pass thru - centers only Drift Around Centers pass thru - left alle. Sd box 1-4 To set up a zero figure using Drift Around

Right & left thru - two ladies chain Pass thru - Drift Around - Zero

Drift Around with 1/2 sashayed couples *

1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay Box 1-4 Star thru-pass thru-U turn back. Pass thru - Drift Around - (boys zoom-girls run right) Star thru - trade by - swing thru Boys run - bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

Flutter wheel - pass thru Drift around - Zero





DOUBLE KNIT STOLE OR CAPE by Mary Jane Chapman


First you will need a double knit material that looks the same on both sides and it must be 2 yards by 60 inches wide.

Fold in half and fold again (quarters).

Take a pencil and string and measure down 30 inches and make a circle. This should be 60 inches wide.

Measure your shoulders, divide in half and it should be about 8 inches long. If you are a larger person this will need adjustment. After you have measured the 8 inches on the two folds that open up you will cut a line 4 inches deep at the 8 inch mark. This is your armhole or collar. Bind the edge with a blanket stitch.

Bind the edges with a blanket stitch and add your crochet edging or you can purchase a trim that will look nice on both sides as some times the cape will be worn reversed.



It may be worn as a cape, just fold in half and you have a collar.

Open it up wide and back into it with your arms outstreached and fold the top part back and you have a stole. Also it may be worn as a hood lifted over your head.


