



FLORIDA FEDERATION OF SQUARE DANCERS - A BRIEF HISTORY

Who knows where and when it began? The first recorded evidence is about an organization meeting in Jacksonville probably in the fall of 1957. The first regular meeting was held in Melbourne on January 12, 1958. Those in attendance were Chairman, Harry Moore from Miami Beach; Vice Chairman, Carl Heath from Winter Haven; Secretary, Al Cody from Kissimmee and Treasurer, Tom Egleston from Jacksonville. Delegates were Harry Edwards, Harley Sanderson and L.T. Hatcher with Gene Baylis as Liaison from the Fla. Callers Assoc. Also in attendance were Helen Moore, Ruby Heath, Dot Cody, Susie Edwards, Margaret Sanderson, Anne Hatcher, Ethel Perry and several members of the Melbourne Allemanders and their caller Bob & Mrs. Stone. The charter was ratified and filed in Osceola County on March 19, 1958.

Out of this beginning came the National Convention to Miami Beach four and half years later. The original motion was for the approval to bid on the Nationals for 1960 (a brash young crew). As it turned out it would take three bids before Florida did get it for 1962 at the 1960 Convention in Des Moines. Those presenting the bid were Harry Moore, bid chairman supported by Bart Bartley, President of the Florida Callers Assoc, and Tom

Smith from the Miami Convention Bureau.

With that out of the way the callers would be asked to let the dancers have the State convention in 1959 as this was a prerequisite for the National, a federation of dancers capable of conducting a convention. Prior to this the convention had been called the Fla. Square Dance Festival sponsored by the Fla. Square and Folk Dance Callers and Teach! ers Association formed in 1953. Continued next month


CALLER OF THE MONTH - Who is Singin' Sam? Singin' Sam Mitchell has been referred to as a "high level" caller with a "beat". He is 6 feet 4 inches tall, which accounts for the "high level" and he is a former Policeman (10 years in K.C. Mo.) so that accounts for the "beat". After moving from Missouri to Arizonz in 1957 to avoid cold winters, Sam and his wife Betty joined a square dance class in Tucson, Ariz. In less than a year Sam was devoting full time to Calling and teaching beginner classes and has not stopped since. The exposure in Tucson good and as the winter travelers went home they had their clubs write to hire him and he began his traveling. Soon he was gone from home more than he was there so in 1962 the family moved to Lansing, Michigan, a more central location with a very good school for the special education of their blind daughter. While in Michigan Sam called for 7 clubs and still travelled over 80,000 miles a year. He earned his 100,000 miler air card

from United Airlines long ago. By 1973 he had driven over one million miles for square dancers. In April 1972 he suffered a severe heart attack. He was a lucky survivor, and only limitations the Dr. put on him was to get plenty of rest and lots of exercise. The cold winters seemed longer and colder and drove the Mitchell's to seek a warm climate again where Sam could get his exercise on his days off and enjoy life more... so they

moved to Holiday, Fla. in Aug. 1973.

Along with the 55 miles a hour driving law, the gasoline shortage of last winter and the high cost of living on the road were the major factors in changing Sam from a Full time Professional Traveling Caller to a full time Callers who travels the state and flies out on week ends. Sam calls for 4 regular clubs and many festival dates. He has called in all but three states (Washington, S.C. and Alaska) He has called for over 200 Festivals 80 week-end Institutes, 8 State Conventions, 5 National Conventions, Numerous Callers Classes and Clinic W/S Groups. He has been calling on the staff for Kirkwood Lodge for 12 years, Washington D.C. Festival for 9 years, Cherry Ridge Campgrounds 5 years, Atwood Lake .odge 4 years, Boyne Highlands 5 years and many others. He has recorded for the following record labels; Dash, Kalox, Windsor, Grenn, J Bar K, Elite and is currently on Thunderbird. He has cut 25 single records and 2 L.P's albiros Sam & betty have three grown children and five grand children. He is a member of the Callerlab and the Fla. Callers Assoc. Sam got the tag of "Singin' Sam" because he sounded deep rich like the old Barbasol man "Singin' Sam" of years ago. ([ronically the son of the original S.S. is George Hinkel, another Fla. Caller) Betty gave him the nickname and its stuck altho his love is hash.

They joined the Florida Round Dance Council and are full members in that group. 



The committee has selected one experimental figure for this quarter. The selected figure is COORDINATE.

COORDINATE is a smooth action figure starting from single file columns, set up by doing a curlique from facing lines, and ending in a two-faced line.

THE SET UP: Heads lead right, circle to a line, curlique

THE ACTION: On the command COORDINATE all will single file circulate one and a half positions. This sets up three pairs with right hands adjacent in a column formation and two men as lonesome ends facing right. (NOTE: When teaching this position, have the dancers circulate one position, then the half more to establish the set-up of three pairs and two lone ends.)

The three pairs turn half by the right, and the center pair made up of two men will step forward individually to the outside of the girls directly in front to become one end of the forming two-faced line. The lonesome man on the end of the set-up will step ahead to become the other end of the two-faced line. The two-faced line will be in normal couples circulate direction with boys on the ends and girls in the center. (NOTE: A good smooth styling assist can be made by the girls in the column. As they turn by the right one-half, the girls who come alongside of the lonesome end men can "pick them up" as they complete the turn and together they form the end of the two-faced line.

The figure is flowing and the follow-up actions of wheel and deal, couples circulate, or bend the line will dance smoothly.

BASIC DANCING FIGURES: Heads lead right and circle to a line Curlique, COORDINATE, bend the line Star thru, dive thru, square thru ¼ Left allemande............

Heads lead right and circle to a line Curlique, COORDINATE. Bend the line, pass thru Bend the line, slide thru Left allemande......



CALLER'S CORNER

EXPERIMENTAL IDEA - Roll and Follow - Roger Chapman

An easily learned figure that looks at the start a little like cast a shadow but not as complicated and worthy of your time. The Basic Position is a two face line and for teaching I suggest a counter clockwise circulation, set up from a Box 1-4 wave and having the boys run. The couples facing in, will circulate 1/2. The couples facing out will have the Girls roll back and take a right hand hold with the trailing girl, while the men facing out will follow his girl and end beside her as the end of the two face lines formed end to end. From this formation here are a few possibilities for follow up calls...

1. Wheel & Deal back to facing lines

2. Triple trade

3. Couples hinge

4. Girls trade

5. Girls cast 3/4 to a Diamond circulate

6. Boys run to Ocean waves

The figure only takes about two beats, and the only poorly timed spot is the boy facing out takes three beats to get into position. Once the figure is understood this is not a problem as the following calls gives him time to keep moving into the next command.

Examples - Dancing Roll and Follow

Box 1-4 Ocean wave - boys run Roll & Follow - boys run - boys trade

Box 1-4 Ocean wave - boys run Roll & Follow - whell & deal Boys run - bend the line - left alle, Box 1-4/Star thru - left alle, Box 1-4

Box 1-4 Wave - boys run Couple circulate - Roll & Follow Girls trade - bend the line Dive thru - square thru 3/4 - left alle. 1P-2P Star thru - do sa doe to a wave Boys run - couples circulate - boys trade Roll & Follow - boys run - boys trace Spin the top - 8 circulate - pass thru-left alle

Box 1-4 Wave - boys run Roll & Follow - Triple trade Couples hinge - bend the line Star thru - do sa doe to a wave - 8 circulate Girls trade - swing thru - turn thru - left alle.

The most popular workshop figure I feel continues to be Transfer and Split Transfer the Column. Here are some additional figures using Transfer and Split Transfer the Column. 1P-2P Curlique - Transfer the Column

1P-2P Curlique - Transfer the Column Swing thru - cast off 3/4 - boys trade Boys run - wheel & deal - square thru 3/4 Spin the top Left alle.

Swing thru - cast off 3-4 - boys trade -

Right & left thru - crosstrail - left alle.

Split Transfer Figures

1P-2P Curlique - Split Tr ansfer the Column 1P-2P Slide thru - Curlique Boys run - centers box the gnat - square

thru four

Ends - slide thru - do sa doe to a wave Recycle - square thru 3/4 - left alle.

Split Transfer the Column - 8 circulate Girls run - swing thru - 8 circulate Girls trade - recycle - pass to the center Square thru 3/4 - left aile. Box 1-4

Note: When using Split Transfer I find it helpful to let the dancers know that 8 will que who turns 3/4. I also find myself saying Split Transfer and leaving off the Column so I add Girls turn 3/4 etc. It takes a little time for the dancers to react to instant recognation so a little help is often appreciated.
