**CALLERLAB** Quarterly Movements Committee has announced that there will be no movements selected for July, Aug. & Sept. 1975. When the committee was originally formed with Jack Lasry, as Chairman, it was decided that no more than two movements would be suggested by the Committee for mainstream dancing in any one quarter. During the Dec. to Mar Quarter the movement Coordinate was selected as a single selection. Now, for the first time, because the committee members who voted were not strongly supporting any one or two movements, the quarterly movements clearing house suggests No Quarterly movement for the next three months. In lieu of new material the committee suggests that during the summer months workshop on the existing quarterly movements, Recycle, Walk & Dodge, Coordinate, Transfer the Column and Half Tag, Trade and Roll and drill on any of the 75 basic movements. To those that might be disappointed in not having the maximum number of new movements presented each quarter, it should be pointed out that it would be relatively simple for the Committee to suggest one or two dozen figures recently invented. The Committee deserves special credit for its restraint in adhering to the purpose of the clearing house, to suggest one or two movements when, in the judgement of a majority of the Committee members, there are movements warranting this special attention.

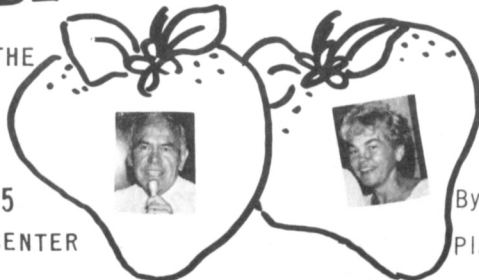

# Caller's Corner

## MAINSTREAM FEATURE WORKSHOP IDEA - SCOOT AND FLUTTER - Orlo Hoadly

I held back in my plans to publish this call as my initial reaction is that another combination call. Our exploration shows me different and for that reason we are saying that it deserves a good look. The action combines the action of a Flutter Wheel with the action of a scoot back and in reality dances smoother than a plane Flutter Wheel. You have the additional option to sweep 1/4 at the end of the action with the same flow as in a basic Flutter Wheel. I suggest you start at the box 1-4 and have the dancers pass thru and U turn back and curlique. This teaching position gives the dancers the best spot to recognize and relate to the comparison of the combination figures. The Girls are facing in and the boys are facing out of the established wave. Tell the Girls that they will perform the basic flutter wheel action of stepping forward turning the opposite girl by the right and pick up the opposite man and bring him back ending in facing lines. The Boys facing out will dance the scoot back action which is simply the "roll over" into the vacating adjacent girls position and be picked up by the opposite girls as in the normal flutter wheel. Once the idea is mastered the timing of the figure is great. The boys roll over into the adjacent position just right for the girls to pick them up. Also the girls action as they step forward is straight ahead not on an angle as the basic flutter. The figure basically takes an ocean wave and changes to a facing line in a very smooth action. Can be used with boys facing in or mixed sexes as from normal waves.

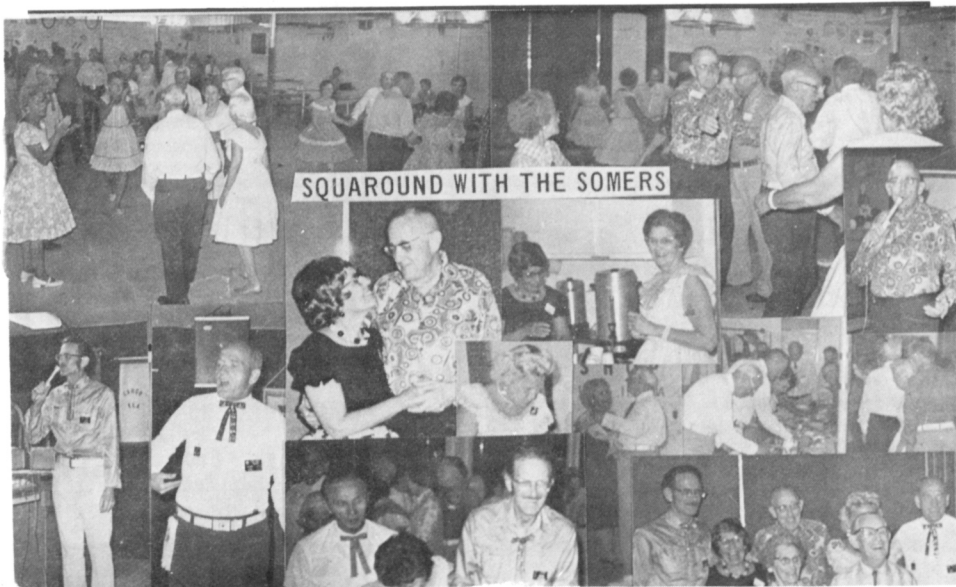
