





FEATURE WORKSHOP BASIC FOR ADVANCED WORKSHOPS - This month we are looking at an advanced level workshop idea - Suggested for high level w/s groups only!

CHAIN REACTION - Lee Kopman

An action figure that has a very interesting flavor that reminds me of Relay the Top of several years ago. Don't let that keep you from looking at the figure as our workshop dancers thought it to be one of the best dancing ideas for advanced level groups that we have seen for awhile. The TEACH is important so read the directions well and work it out with your checkers step by step and you should have no trouble.

Basic Teaching Information Heads star thru - Do sa doe to a wave - From this formation of a wave in between facing couples CHAIN REACTION starts. It ends intwo parallel ocean waves. Teaching Chain Reaction From the basic starting position, Heads star thru - do sa doe to a wave Have the boys in the wave establish themselves. Now have the boys who are ends of the wave in the center walkforward around the outside of the square until their right shoulder is in the middle of the back of the couple they are fac-

ing. The Girls in whats left of the center ocean wave are each facing a man, they will pass thru with the man they are facing. This leaves the girls side by side with their left shoulders adjacent. The Girls join left hands and the girls hinge. This will allow you to establish a familiar set up of four dancers in a right hand star in the center of the set while the end dancers are adjacent to each other with right hands joined. The action continues with the ends turning 1/2 by the right while the center star of four turns 1/4 (one step). The boys are now side by side to finish the action with a left 3/4 turn as the girls step forward to become the ends of the forming ocean waves. The action - center boys walk - as the center girls pass thru the man they are facing -

The action - center boys walk - as the center girls pass thru the man they are facing - the girls will hinge with left hands - the ends turn 1/2 by the right as the center star turns one step - boys finish with a 3/4 turn as the girls step forward to become the ends of the wave - it takes about three walks to establish the action and the dancing is 10 beats

BASIC DANCING EXAMPLES

Heads star thru-do sa doe to a wave Chain Reaction - boys run Wheel & deal - left alle. sd box 1/4

1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Zoom - centers do sa doe to a wave Chain Reaction - turn thru - left alle.

NOTE - Teach the action in five parts - 1. Center boys walk around, 2. Girls with facing man pass thru Heads right & left thru-star thru-do sa doe to a wave Chain Reaction-boys run Couples circulate-wheel & deal Star thru-pass thru-U turn back-left alle.

1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Centers do sa doe to a wave Chain Reaction - boys run Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

2. Girls with facing man pass thru,
3. Girls hinge, 4. Ends turn 1/2 as Star turns one step, 5. Boys turn 3/4 Girls step forward to the wave - Give Chain Reaction a good look if you have the right group of experienced dancers, I'm sure they will like it


