FLORIDA FEDERATION OF SQUARE DANCERS - A BRIEF HISTORY - Continued from Jan & Feb issues - Other dates of interest might be May 28, 1972 when State Convention moved to Memorial weekend; Oct 22, 1972, first meeting of co-ordinating committee which resulted in a National and State caller for the convention and Sept 2, 1973, when an invitation went out to the Ga. Board of Delegates to be our guests at Orlando and the hopeful beginning of close co-operation between the dancers of Georgia and Florida. The Federation meeting held on Oct 20, 1974 at Orlando was the 54th since that day in Jan 1958. Nine of the fifteen past chairmen are still active in square dancing with Harry Moore and Al Cody from the original group back in 1958.

FONTANA VILLAGE, N.C. The square dance session will begin with the opening session of the Spring "Swap Shop". It is the oldest established square dance festival of its kind in the U.S. This will mark the 44th time the semi-annual event has been held. With 18 staff members and 8 guest staff assisting it will be filled with 800 dancers from all over. For the 22 time, Rebel Roundup will have a staff from seven states to assure the dancers of a week chock full of activities. Then Accent of Rounds with Squares, traditionally a different festival featuring round dancing, is limited to 200 dancers on first come first served basis. FunFest will then get underway and the Village will respond to the music of the band, which is a feature of the festivals, the use of live music. The Recreation Director is Tex Al Brownlee, national caller for more than 25 years. He is host caller and with his wife Jean, Tex is a year round resident of Fontana Village.

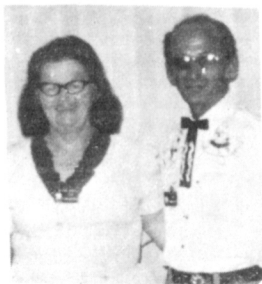

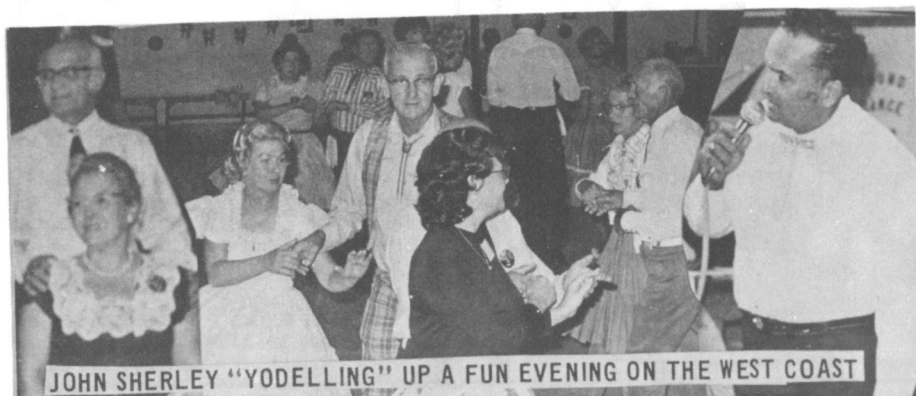

THE JACK LASRY CALLER'S CORNER

FEATURE EXPERIMENTAL IDEA ✓

RIGHT (left) HAND STAR CHAIN THRU ...ED NOVAK

This is the first time in a long time I have featured an Experimental figure. I feel the figure will acceptable to our basic 75 dancer as well as the Mainstream dancer.

Basic Teach - Box 1-4 Have the dancers form a Right Hand Star and turn the Star just a bit over 1/2 so that the four girls line up thru the center of the set in a wave, while the four boys are back out on the ends of four corners. The Center Girls will Trade and then the center girls will turn the end or inactive girl 3/4 as in the "chain thru" while the four boys will circulate one position on the outside of the set - Ending in a Normal Two Face Line. The Nice part beside the smooth flow and good timing is from the ending two face line a Wheel & Deal will zero out to an equiv. Box 1-4 or other starting box. Again we suggest starting your command to Right Hand Star Chain Thru while the heads are doing the square thru to the Box 1-4. The timing to get into the Right hand star is important - Give This One A Good Look - I feel strong that it should be well accepted. If you want to start in a Box with the Dancers 1/2 sashayed you can have the boys work thru the center in the "chain thru" part while the girls circulate. Please Don't try to do it upside down and from all set ups until the basic idea is comfortable.
