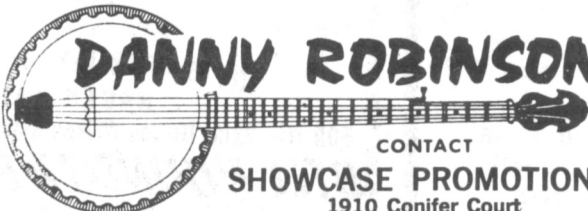

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN Let's talk a little bit about the Fla. Federation of Square Dancers. What is it, and why? It is a state organization made up of representatives of the four area associations in the state; namely, Northeast, Central, West Coast and Southeast Dancers Assoc. The delegates from each area are the President of the area assoc. and three other representatives. The only other voting members of the Federation are the Past Chairmen. The primary function of the Federation is to unite the state in every way possible for the good of square dancing, as a whole, and to work in close coordination with the Fla. Callers Assoc. and the Round Dance Council of Fla. The Federation has the financial responsibility for the State Conventions - the area assoc. hosting the convention has the operating responsibility (work). The Federation helps promote

BIRDELL & LEN LEVITT national conventions and would host a national if so desired. The Federation meets 3 or 4 times a year, usually at the State Convention, Knothead, in October (the first weekend this year) when the new officers and delegates are seated, and if the chairman deems necessary a meeting is held in the Spring. There is no reimbursement for the time and money spent and, apparently, it is one of the ways the people serving are giving back to square dancing for some of the pleasures and benefits they have derived from it. I'm sure they consider it a privilege to serve - I know I do. All meetings are open to all. The time and the place is always posted at the functions where they are to be held and, as Chairman, I want to extend an invitation to you to attend. We are working for you and the best way to help us help you is to let your delegates know your desires - or better yet, get involved! People wanting to give of themselves and share their talents are always welcome - anywhere. See you in Jax, Len Levitt

GETTING BETTER ACQUAINTED WITH HINGE

We have established an increased interest in the Hinge family, This month lets use Hinge from parallel waves and set up columns. From any waves set up the call Hinge or Single Hinge (I prefer Hinge) is a Cast Off or an Ends Of The Wave Arm Turn 1/4. Although it is a short action the "experienced" dancers have been accepting the action as an evolution of the Partner Hinge Family. Getting the most out of such a figure requires that the dancers fully accept the basic action and that the following figures compliment that flow. After that is established then some action getting into the Hinge is worthy of your exploration.
