

This month let's look at a combination of two basics which dance together nicely: Peel Off and Bend the Line.

Heads Pass Thru Separate around 1 to a line Pass Thru - Tag the Line Peel Off - Bend the Line Star Thru - Zoom Centers Curlique - Left Alle.

Box 1-4 Curlique Girls Fold - Double Pass Thru Peel Off - Bend the Line Spin the Top - Centers Trade Boys Run - Slide Thru Left Alle. (Box 1--4)

Box 1--4 Swing Thru Girls Fold - Peel Off Bend the Line - Pass Thru Wheel and Deal - Curlique Left Alle.

Box 1-- 4 Swing Thru Boys Run - Tag the Line Peel Off - Bend the Line Men Pass Thru - Men Fold Girls Turn Thru - Star Thru Couples Circulate - Bend the Line Star Thru - Pass to the Center Curlique - Left Alle.

1P2P Pass Thru Tag the Line - Peel Off Bend the Line - R & L Thru Flutter Wheel - Sweep 1/4 Square Thru 3/4 - Left Alle. (NOTE: From any lines of 4 facing, Pass Thru - Tag the Line - Peel Off Bend the Line is a Zero.)

Heads Star Thru Double Pass Thru - Peel Off Bend the Line - Star Thru Square Thru 3/4 - Left Alle. (NOTE: From any Double Pass Thru set-up with dancers as normal couples, Double Pass Thru Peel Off - Bend the Line Star Thru is a Zero.)

Try ending a tip with this one: 4 Ladies Chain 3/4 - 4 Ladies Chain Heads Square Thru - Swing Thru Boys Trade Boys Run Bend the Line - Pass Thru Tag the Line - Peel Off Bend the Line - Pass Thru Wheel and Deal - Centers Sweep 1/4 Bow to the Partner.



### Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami FEATURE EXPERIMENTAL IDEA FERRIS TRADE & WHEEL - Ron Schneider



This idea came last month and we have given it a good "look". We find it to be a logical extension of Ferris Wheel and one that the dancers will like and learn easily, The Action: The figure starts from a two face line. The couple facing out will do the wheel and deal action to end as the traiting couple in a double pass thru set up. The couple Facing In does the 1/2 circulate to form the two face line in the center.

Now the center dancers in the two face line will trade - then they wheel and deal to becaome the lead couple in the double pass thru set up. You can see the close similarity to Ferris Wheel but with the Trade of the center dancers adding a little flavor to the figure. If your dancers have been doing Ferris Wheel this is a natural if, however they are learning Ferris Wheel for the first time then wait until they have it mastered before trying Ferris Trade & Wheel.

### **EXAMPLES**

Box 1-4 Slide thru - spin the top ✓ Boys run - tag the line right Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers pass thru Swing thru - 8 circulate Girls trade - swing thru - turn thru - left alle.

Box 1-4 Swing thru - boys run Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers square thru 3/4 Circle to a line - equals heads lead right

Box 1-4 Swing thru - boys run
Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers pass thru
Swing thru - boys run
Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Slide thru - swing thru Boys run - Ferris Trade & Wheel Centers pass thru - do sa doe to a wave Recycle - left alle. box 1-4

Give Ferris Trade & Wheel a try. It really is a nice dancing variation and I'm sure the dancers will pick it up easy.
