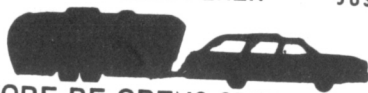

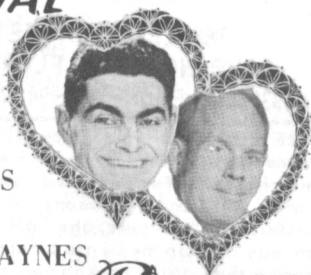

FEATURE EXPERIMENTAL IDEA
FERRIS TRADE & WHEEL - Ron Schneider



This idea came last month and we have given it a good "look". We find it to be a logical extension of Ferris Wheel and one that the dancers will like and learn easily, **The Action:** The figure starts from a two face line. The couple facing out will do the wheel and deal action to end as the trailing couple in a double pass thru set up. The couple Facing In does the 1/2 circulate to form the two face line in the center.

Now the center dancers in the two face line will trade - then they wheel and deal to become the lead couple in the double pass thru set up. You can see the close similarity to Ferris Wheel but with the Trade of the center dancers adding a little flavor to the figure. If your dancers have been doing Ferris Wheel this is a natural if, however they are learning Ferris Wheel for the first time then wait until they have it mastered before trying Ferris Trade & Wheel.

EXAMPLES

Box 1-4 Slide thru - spin the top ✓
Boys run - tag the line right
Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers pass thru
Swing thru - 8 circulate
Girls trade - swing thru - turn thru - left alle.

Box 1-4 Swing thru - boys run ✓
Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers square thru 3/4
Circle to a line - equals heads lead right

Box 1-4 Swing thru - boys run ✓
Ferris Trade & Wheel - centers pass thru
Swing thru - boys run
Bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Slide thru - swing thru ✓
Boys run - Ferris Trade & Wheel
Centers pass thru - do sa doe to a wave
Recycle - left alle. box 1-4

Give Ferris Trade & Wheel a try. It really is a nice dancing variation and I'm sure the dancers will pick it up easy.

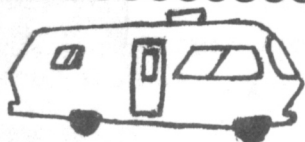

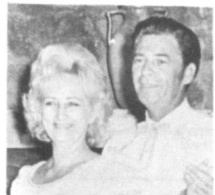
