





NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION REPORT More than 22,000 dancers from every State in the Union and foreign countries enjoyed the 24th National Convention in Kansas City this last June 26,27,28. With five large halls and over 500 callers programmed, it was easy for the dancer to find their pleasure. Over 2,000 youth dancers enjoyed their own hall and program. Over 2,400 Round Dancers signed in the 48 Teaches and Workshops. The evening was highlighted by 18 Exhibition Groups. The free Caller's Seminar, sponsored by the National Executive Committee again had more than 400 callers sign through. This is planned again for next year and also a new R/D Leaders Seminar. Seventy-four organizations displayed their Assoc. activities including Florida with Mori Sogolow leading the group from Fla. The 25th Convention will be in Annaheim, California, on June 24, 25, 26,1976. It's a "Once in a Lifetime Event", since it is bi-centennial year plus a return to Calif. the site of the first convention. Five thousand dancers are already signed up for this big event. Many special package deals are being offered by Travel Agencys which include Air fare, housing and dancing.





Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

DANCING 1/2 TAG TRADE AND ANYTHING FROM LINES TO SET UP COLUMNS.

1/2 TAG TRADE AND ROLL and its many variations really are interesting to dance and easily followed. The usual spot for the 1/2 Tag Trade and Roll is from two parallel two face lines set up by calling a swing thru boys run. Lets use some similar set ups BUT start from facing lines and end in columns or back in lines. I suggest that you call a few simple figures and progress into the more complex, not that any of the following are tough but it will depend upon the dancer experience with 1/2 Tag Trade & Anything from basic parallel waves.

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run · 1/2 Tag..Trade..& Roll-crosstrail Left alle.

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run. 1/2 Tag.. Trade and Boys Run Pass thru - left alle. (Pass thru to the corner box)

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run•
1/2 Tag.. Trade & Transfer the Column
Center trade - scoot back
Boys run - left alle. Zero to 1P-2P line

P-2P Rollaway 1/2 sashay.
Swing thru-girls run-1/2 Taa, Trade & R

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run.
1/2 Tag ..Trade & Roll
Curlique - 8 circulate - boys run
Square thru 3/4 - trade by - left alle. Box 1-4

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run-1/2 Tag . Trade & 8 Circulate Boys run-trade by -left alle. Box 1-4

1P-2P Swing thru - boys run -1/2 Tag .. Trade & 8 Circulate Transfer the column - centers trade Boys run - slide thru - square thru 3/4 Trade by - left alle. Box 1-4

Swing thru - girls run - 1/2 Tag, Trade & Roll 1P-2P Right & left thru - rollaway 1/2 sashay.
Slide thru - left alle.
Swing thru - girls run
1/2 Tag. Tade & Girls Run
Box the gnat - square thru 3/4 - left alle.

1P-2P Right & left thru-rollaway 1/2 sashay, Swing thru - girls run 1/2 Tag. Tade & 8 Circulate Boys run - square thru 3/4

Trade by - left alle. Box 1-4

The above figure will build into good position dancing but easily developed .. You should find a few interesting variations to share with your dancers
