WHAT IS A STATE CONVENTION? The Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention is a large festival put on by three organizations of the state. The Fla. Callers Assoc., Fla Federation of Square Dancers and the Round Dance Council of Fla., for the pleasure and education of all in attendance. A chairman is appointed (Len Levitt) with a liaison from each organization (Pete Sansom & Bill Beattie) to guide, advise and help him. A convention site is picked that is large enough to handle the expected crowd and that has the facilities needed; air conditioning, parking, water, etc. and the contracts are signed. (Miami Beach Convention Center, approximately \$2,000.00 per day) and conditions are met such as policemen, fireman protection, first aid, hospitals, union labor, etc. Governmental reguirements and restrictions are studied and met or arranged for-taxes, licenses, permits, etc. We were then approved as part of the Bicentennial Celebration, Square Dancing is part of our National Heritage. A headquarters hotel is selected, a place that has enough fine rooms to house the people who choose to stay there; has meeting rooms for all the meetings that will take place; large enough for the Callers Clinic, the Trailsend Dance, the After-parties, the skits, the daytime activities, the after-dance and late dance; has enough air conditioning and has shown by past experiences it is capable of meeting all our requirements and desires. The and onlt then is the selection made and contracts signed (Deauville Hotel contract signed in 1973) with our commitments and theirs spelled out. In some areas the hotel requirements differ; but in the southeast area one of the Hotel's requirements is that we fill X number of rooms for our stay there in order to be able to use their other facilities at no extra charge. This is one of the reasons that we ask Your Support in our push to fill the place first. Dancers of long standing are usually aware of this fact and support the efforts of the convention committee who start working four years in advance of the convention date. They also know that all the activities will center around the headquatters location and that is the place to be. Newer dancers, some times not realizing this, get left out and consequentlyn lose some of the better things offer ed at our conventions. Then other hotels are contacted for any overflow reservations. Outof-state callers and leaders contacted years in advance and choice is made based on their ability, and contracts signed (1974 John Hendron, Bob Fisk, Anita & Leroy Stark). Now the real work starts, appointments are made for various jobs, selecting people who have done good work for square dancing and round dancing before, workers that you as the Chairman knows you can rely on and that you can work in harmony with them ones that give their all to improve square dancing as a whole and are proven leaders and organizers. Fortunately we have many square and round dance friends and people who fit this category; but, unfortunately, we do not have that many top jobs to place them all in. However, we still hope they will be there when we need them for some last minute detail or help, Buses are arranged for to transport people who are staying at the headquarters hotel back & forth to the Convention Center, ribbons and badges are designed and ordered, as are stationary and registration form, programming is done, a million and one details are worked out (that the average dancer is not aware of) and taken care of. Our secretary (Nita & Byddy Shelton) sends out numerous letters to our callers and leaders selected, vendors, city offices, the hoteletc. It is all there, for your enjoyment! Now it is up to you-come and enjoy the fruits of our labor. Our only reward and pay for four years of work is seeing you come and enjoy it and hearing dancers going away saying, "It was a Great Convention". So please register, and Register Early as we can use the money, and it also makes the load a little lighter on our Registraion Chairmen (Bert & Alan Ashcroft) if your registrations caone in regularly over the next few months instead of all at the last minute. Caller's Corner

REVIEW FIGURE WITH EXPERIENCED DANCER MAINSTREAM POSSIBILITES

Not very long ago we had the introduction of Diamond Circulate and from it came so many
variations that we all had our fill of Diamonds. There are several Diamond figures that do
have good dancing qualities and I feel have some lasting possibilities. Lets look at the
following Diamond program.

BASIC DIAMOND CIRCULATE

Set up from a two face line, centers of the line can cast off 3/4 or they can Hinge (arm turn 1/4) to set up the Diamond Formation. The dancers who arm turn are the centers of the Diamond while the inactive dancers become the points of the diamond. A Diamond circulate amounts to some what of an elongated four point star circulate with each dancer stepping into the next spot in their Diamond. The Circulate gives you an exchange of dancers in the center and out on the points of the Diamond.

GET ACQUAINTED FIGURES

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run
Girls cast off 3/4-(check your diamond)
Diamond Circulate-Diamond Circulate
Girls cast off 3/4-bend the line
Right & left thru-slide thru-left alle.
(Zero)

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run-girls hinge (check your diamond)
Diamond Circulate-boys cast off 3/4
Boys cross run-girls trade
Bend the line-right & left thru
Slide thru-left alle. Zero

FLIP THE DIAMOND

An excellent way of getting out of the Diamond and ending in an ocean wave. From the Diamond Formation the Centers of the Diamond, Diamond Circulate to become the ends of the wave. The points of the Diamond "Flip" over which is an about face turn toward the center of the Diamond. The points that flip over become the centers of the wave. Note The points when they make the about face turn towards the center of the diamond and do not pass by the other point but simply "rollover" toward the center.

Box 1-4 Swing thru-boys run
Girls cast off 3/4-Diamond Circul ate
Flip the Diamond-Zero to Box 1-4 Waye

CUT THE DIAMOND

Similar action to Flip but ends in a two face line. From the Diamond Formation the Centers will do a Diamond Circulate to become the ends of the two face line. The points of the diamond slide together and trade to become the Centers of the Two Face Line.

Box 1-4 Do sa doe to a wave-girls trade Girls run-tag the line right Girls cast off 3/4-Diamond circulate

Cut the Diamond-wheel & deal-right & left thru Zero

The two Diamond get outs, Cut & Flip give you the choice of two endings, a two face line or wave. Note - The above figure works well after one Diamond Circulate as you have some "motion" that carries you into the next action for a smooth flowing forward dance action.

DIAMOND CHAIN THRU The last Diamond figure is for you advance kids or after all other diamond figures are well danced. From the Diamond formation, the dancers do one diamond circulate. The Center two dancers in the wave formed thru the center of the set will trade then turn the end dancer 3/4. I like Diamond Chain Thru for advanced dancers as it allows for nice body flow within an interesting change of poition.




