"To promote fellowship, fun and merriment among square dancers in Florida" is the expression coined in an early bulletin of the FLORIDA KNOTHEADS.

The ORIGINAL SQUARE of Florida Knotheads, Bill and Ruthe Muench, Jim and Helen Galloway, Pat and 'Mac McClumpha and Kay and Ed Mack obtained a charter and designed the Florida

The Florida Knothead Badge, a black rectangle with stick figures, is our REGISTERED TRADE, badge. MARK and belongs solely to FLORIDA KNOTHEADS INC.

Bill Muench served as chairman for 5 years, with Kay Mack, sec. and Helen Galloway, Treasurer. Jim Galloway, our 2nd chairman, served in that capacity until his untimely death in 1971.

A donation to the Florida Sheriff's Boy's Ranch was made in his honor. Ed Mack is present chairman, Kay Mack secretary and Helen Galloway treasurer. Pat McClumpha

is a director member. In 1969 Bill and Ruthe Muench resigned from the board of directors, citing other interests kept them from putting in the time needed for konvention work.

In 1975, two couples Billi and George Dermer and Byrdie and Marty Martin were added to our permanent staff. The Dermers handle new membership and konvention registrations and the Martins are responsible for konvention programming.

Florida Knotheads Inc., promote an annual konvention for members only.

The TRAIL DANCE preceding the knothead konventionis open to those who are pre-registered for the konvention and to those dancers who seek membership and who can meet the 100 miles needed for qualifying HOME P.O. to the TAMPA P.O. After applying for membership, they then register for the konvention.

AWARD STRIPS and BADGES are given to members attending the konvention. The FIRST PIN issued to members, is a bar showing 5 stick figures and is given to members who attend the konvention for 5 YEARS IN SUCCESSION. This bar is for the members to keep. The sixth consecutive year, a number bar is issued which in turn can be exchanged the following year for the 7th year pin etc.

This 20th Annual Konvention will have 19 members who will be receiving their 20th successive

A knothead newsletter was published in our 2nd year, but was of short duration. We soon took year pin. up the offer of a column in the state square dance publication, the BOW & SWING.

First major promotion project was in 1959, when the FLORIDA KNOTHEADS underwrote the HOLIDAY FOR ROUNDS in Clearwater. From this festival the Round Dance Council of Florida

Another promotion effort of the group in 1961, was the distribution of 20,000 pamphlets on the history and purpose of square dancing.

CLEARWATER was our konvention home site from 1956 to 1969. When the JACK TAR Hotel changed hands and became a retiree hotel, we lost use of two large dancing areas in the hotel and so the move to TAMPA for the 1970 konvention was made.

Back to Clearwater for the years of '71, '72, '73 and '74 when the Jack Tar hotel again became available. In 1974 we once again lost a major hall for our dancing when the Clearwater Auditorium was razed, just two weeks before our konvention. And once again the move to TAMPA for the large quarters of the Curtis-Hixon konvention Center. That phrase "ALL ACTIVITIES UNDER ONE ROOF" is welcome indeed.

First year records a total of 461 Knothead members - to date we have a record 24,511 members. Firstkonvention, 392 members registered for the konvention, an almost perfect attendance. for the 19th Annual Konvention a total of 1899 members were registered.

Memories and more memories. Nevertheless Knothead history wouldn't be complete without giveng thought to 'Mac' McClumpha, who passed away in 1958, To 'Mac' and 'Jim' whose memories will always be respected, we pay tribute. ******

Requirements for Knothead Membership are simple. Four couples or more must travel 100 miles or more to a club or open dance, dance one full tip together and let it be known the purpose of the visit, get the club caller to sign the filled out membership application and mail to the Florida Knotheads Inc.



Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami



MAINSTREAM PLUS PLATEAU - Last month we listed the figures selected by Callerlab to be placed in the new plateau above Mainstream. Our plan to review with examples the figures that make up this list continues this month with Peel the Top (I left this figure out last month so add it to your list) and Cloverflow. Both figures are very suitable for this plateau as they have good dancing qualities but are variations of the Basics.

PEEL THE TOP - From ocean waves the ends fold to set up the 'Z' fromation from which Peel the Top starts. The lead dancers will Peel Off as the trailing dancers step forward to join adjacent hands for a 3/4 turn. The dancers who 'peeled' off will move up 1/4 as in a Spin the Top to become ends of the forming wave.

DANCING EXAMPLES

Box 1-4 Swing thru-girls fold Peel the Top-(boys peel & move up, girls turn 3/4) Slide thru-zero

To set up a column equal to a 1P-2P Curlique use the next example 1P-2P Pass the ocean-Swing thru Girls fold-Peel the Top-Curlique-gives you the desired column

1P-2P Swing thru - girls fold Peel The Top-(now in a pass thru to the corner box)

Box 1-4 Wave Boys fold-Peel The Top (girls peel boys turn 3/4)
Boys run - wheel & deal - star thru zero

Box 1-4 Wave-boys fold-Peel the Top Swing thru-recycle-sweep 1/4 zero

CLOVERFLOW - From the trade by formation, the outside couples will cloverleaf and then pass thru, the inside dancers will pass thru and then cloverleaf. The figure ends in an eight chain thru box. The figure has nice movement and is well liked by the dancers as a good moving figure.

CALLERLAB - JULY, AUGUST & SEPTEMBER - QUARTERLY MOVEMENTS

The International Assoc. of Square Dance Callers, held its annual Convention April 12-14 1976 at the Chicago Marriott Hotel. In Attendance were 691 delegates (callers & wives) from all sections of North America plus representatives from Great Britain, Netherlands, The Canal Zone and Germany. The Convention's Theme Professional Responsibilities set the key for the three day conclave with the greatest amount of time being spent on the major topics: Caller Accreditation and Mainstream Basics. The Quarterly Movements Committee came in for many congratulations. Apparently the idea of a limited number of well screened basics over the year has hit home in most areas. Six of the eight movements issued since the start of the project have been retained temporally for mainstream dancing. These include: Recycle, Walk & Dodge, Coordinate, Half Tag & Roll, Ferris Wheel and Pass the Ocean. The new Executive Committee for the Callerlab is: Jim Mayo, Chairman, Frank Lane, Jack Lasry, Angus McMorran and Bob Osgood. John Kaltenthaler has been appointed the new Executive Secretary (P.O. Box 277, Pocono Pines, Penn. 18350). The date and location for the 1977 Convention were decided upon. The site will be Kansas City, the time will be Monday, Tues., & Wed. just prior to Easter. *

THE NEW MOVEMENT SELECTED - TRACK II was a heavy winner according to the report

of the Committee. It would have been relatively simple to suggest a second figure in view of the sizeable number that have recently emerged. Credit should be given to the committee headed by Jack Lasry and composed of a dozen or more callers-leaders, for their restraint and judgement in selecting only one.

TRACK II by DICK BAYER

The action starts from a completed double pass thru formation. The normal form ation is easily set up having the head couples lead right and circle to a line, Line pass thru, wheel and deal and double pass thru. The boys are in the left track and the girls are in the right track. The dancers will work toge ther in tandem, i.e. the trailing boy will follow in behind the lead boy and the girls will do the same (trailing girl will follow the lead girl). The dancers will do what amounts to a tandem partner trade with the two boys walking single file to the right around the girls. The girls will move single file to the left inside the boys to end still in a double pass thru formation. The movement continues as the dancers progress single file to a half tag formation, ending in two parallel ocean waves, boys on the end, girls in the center of the wave.


