1P2P Centers Box the Gnat - Square Thru Heads Right & Left Thru Ends Slide Thru Everybody Square Thru 3/4 - L. Alle.

Box 1--4 Centers in Ends Slide Thru The others Cloverleaf New Centers Square Thru 3/4 - L. Alle.

Box 1--4 Left Square Thru 3/4 Centers Square Thru 3/4 Ends Trade - L. Alle.

Heads Pass Thru - Separate Around One to a Line of Four Pass Thru - Centers Run Cast Off 3/4 - Ends Fold Centers Pass Thru - L. Alle.

Sides Star Thru - Double Pass Thru Centers In - Centers Trade Ends U-Turn Back Everybody Slide Thru - L. Alle.

Four Ladies Chain Heads Square Thru Slide Thru - Pass Thru Tag the Line Centers In - Cast Off 3/4 Centers Square Thru 3/4 then Cloverleaf The others Slide Thru - L. Alle.

1P2P Right & Left Thru Pass Thru - Ends Trade and Roll Centers Cloverleaf New Centers Pass Thru Right & Left Grand.



## Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami

Roll as you all know has gained a lot of mainstream popularity as part of 1/2 Tag, Trade & Roll. To add the use of roll to other movements so its usage is not limited to only one call is no doubt the reason for its selection. Some calls lend themselves to Easy acceptance of a roll ending while other are more difficult. I suggest you explain to the dancers exactly what he is doing when you call a 1/2 Tag, Trade & Roll How it is only 1/4 turn, ona dime, in direction of boys flow. The previous basic sets up a body motion that is continued into a 1/4 facing turn. My examples will allow for an easy introduction to Roll-from Mainstream basics.

1P-2P Right & left thru - Pass thru - Partner Trade & Roll - Grand Right & Left ✓
1P-2P Touch 1/4 - 8 Circulate - Trade & Roll - Box the gnat - Slide thru - Left Alle ✓

### BE AN ANGEL \* THE SQUARE ANGEL'S RESPONSIBILITY

\*\*\*MIX WITH THE NEWCOMERS as they enter the hall. Become one of them. They will watch as you welcome others and as you mix among the crowd. This procedure will appear natural to them and they will eventually do the same.

\*\*\*SET A GOOD EXAMPLE when dancing. Listen to the instructions; be in the right place at the right time. This will be observed. You won't have to explain it.

\*\*\*BE INCONSPICUOUS. Direct your attention to the caller at the microphene. Remember to be "the best listener on the floor". This is most important when beginners are in the fermative stage.

\*\*\*BE PATIENT. Be aware that it takes seme folks lenger to learn than others. Den't push er pull. Let the newcomer learn to listen and follow. Your patience, understanding and friendliness may be the factors that will keep one frightened couple from dropping out of class.

\*\*\*PON'T SHOW OFF. Of course, you know more than the beginner. Just consider how much longer you have been dancing. The first step is to get the students through each movement in the simplest and most uncomplicated manner. The extra twirls and "turn backs" will come in time.

\*\*\*DON'T OVERDRESS. Expecially on class nights. Be neat at all times. The correct way you dress will be imitated. Wear your simple square dance attire. The fancy dresses and outfits will come later.

\*\*\*DANCE IN DIFFERENT SPOTS. Fill in the squares as you are needed. You will do much to discourage set-up squares and cliques.

\*\*\*PERSONAL HYGIENE AND MANNERS are the teacher's responsibility. You may call his attention to these matters privately and furing rest periods.

\*\*\*EXHIBITIONS are not encouraged. Semetimes a display of faster dancing and the use of styles not introduced do much to discourage the baginner.

\*\*\*YOUR AWARD as a "square angel" will come from the satisfaction that these people will some day become a permanent part of the nebby that you enjoy.
