MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE FLORIDA FEDERATION OF DANCERS



As we start a new calendar year, why not take time to recheck the square dance resolutions we made when we first graduated from a beginner's class? Remember how excited we felt as we ventured to our first open dance? We tried to remember every thing our teacher had imparted to us. Actually the dancing was almost the easiest part because we automatically reacted to the calls we knew--even from strange positions. It wasn't quite as easy to be friendly because we were a bit nervous, but when the experienced dancers smiled, then we did too. Reviewing square dance etiquette from time to time is a good idea. Probably we do most of it naturally but perhaps there's an occasion when we forget some of the points. Here are some suggestions from Dancers Callers Publications of Southern California (known as D.C.P.), a group interested in the mutual welfare of square dancing.

JIM & BUNNY WHITEMAN

- DO dress gaily & comfortably appropriately..DON'T drink before a dance
- DO get to the dance on time..DON'T forget to use that deodorant
- DO concentrate on enjoying the dance; leave your personal problems at home..
- DO form squares promptly. DON'T fail to be friendly with everyone
- DO listen closely to the caller. DON'T ever walk away from a set
- DO get acquainted with everyone at the dance whom you don't know
- DO keep your dancing standard. DON'T take dancing so seriously you can't laugh
- DON'T refuse to serve on club committees. DO remember that good dancing is nice but the greatest contribution you can make toward the enjoyment of a dance is friendliness, good humor, cooperation and a real desire to have fun.

The above appeared in the January 1976 issue of Square Dancing magazine. We thought the resolutions were so well stated that we telephoned Bob Osgood for permission to copy the article in Bow & Swing.

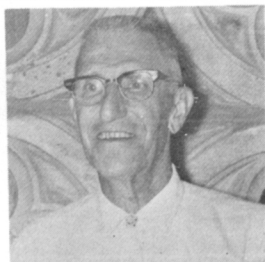

CALLER OF THE MONTH

GEOFFREY W. (JEFF) FLASH - Jeff was first introduced to square dancing at a church group in 1942 when nobody could get gas to travel anywhere and home and local entertainment was the rule. A former Caller from Texas asked him to set up a sound system for the church group as Jeff was at that time Chief Inspector for the Marconi Int. Marine Co. at New York and was the only one around who knew how to build an amplifier. Back in '42 there wasn't the equipment or records we have available today. After a few months of dancing, Jeff caught the calling bug and started doing what amounted to one night stands for local groups and USO Centers, and in 1948 started the club that became the Staten (Island) Square Set and is still going strong today with an average turnout of 12 to 14 squares. Jeff remained their



Caller from 1948 till his retirement to Florida in 1964, a 16 year stint, but before leaving started a second club for Senior dancers in the early '50s which is also still active. Shortly after settling in Florida, Jeff contacted the Port Charlotte Culture Center, and became their first square dance instructor, running regular 10 weeks sessions and in the summer of 1965 formed the first group of 10 weeks graduates into the Charlotte Promenaders. In 1970 he stepped down from the club to semi retirement from calling, confining his square dance activities to seasonal calling for Mobile Home Parks and dancing himself. In all his activities he was ably assisted by his Tow Rose whose greatest regret is that she had to give up dancing because of her health. She still goes to dances with Jeff to visit and maintain contact with the many friends that they met in the years they have been Florida residents. Jeff made it a point to contact and join the Florida Callers Assoc. and has been a steady member since 1965. He also was a member of the New Jersey Callers & Teachers Assoc. of Northern New Jersey from 1949 until its dissolution in 1956.

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - CLUB LEVEL - PING PONG CIRCULATE - Don Beck ✓

Don the author of Ferris Wheel has sent along an interesting and simple idea. The figure starts from the formation set up when the head couples pass the ocean. A wave between two couples. The complicated individual action is all "red tape" as the following teach will make it very simple. The dancers in the wave will pass thru the wave and then pass thru with the outside couple. The dancers now facing out will partner trade while the center dancers will step into an ocean wave. The ending formation is similar to the starting one. You could make the figure very directional by calling it that way. The only thing gained by the teach and call by the name Ping Pong Circulate is the fluid motion of the exchange. My own comments are that unless you are using the figure like Chain Reaction which require the same starting formation the figure will be considered a gimmick and not have long lasting appeal. It is however a cute workshop figure if you need one?

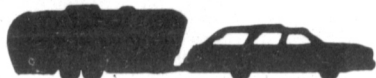
