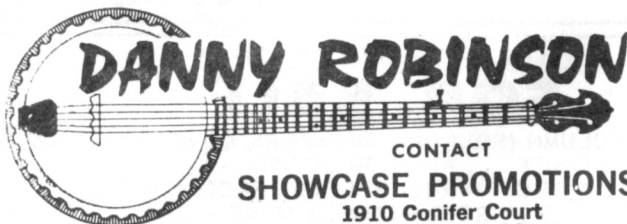

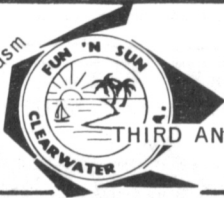

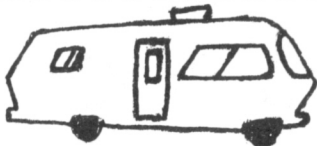

**CALLERLAB - The International Association of Square Dance Callers - Quarterly Movement News Release** - For the three months period starting Jan 1976 the Quarterly Movement Committee of Callerlab suggests one movement for the mainstream workshops and dances in Jan., Feb. and March. The single selection is: **Lockit**. The committee after sorting through all current movements decided that this single choice was appropriate at this time. It is the Committee's hope that all caller/teachers will include Lockit in their mainstream dance program and workshops during the coming quarter. Here is the description and two drills for this Quarterly Movement Selection:

### LOCKIT: LEE KOPMAN

The action in Lockit can start either in an ocean wave or a two-faced line formation (actually the ocean wave set up is the more acceptable). From an ocean wave, the centers of the wave will do a one-quarter arm turn (hinge) while the dancers on the ends move forward and around as in a fan the top. The movements terminates with the dancers once again in an ocean wave at right angles to the original formation. When Lockit starts from a two-faced line the dancers follow the same action with the entire line rotating 90 degrees as the dancers move forward. Examples:

Heads do sa do

To an ocean wave

Lockit

Square thru 3/4

Left Allemande

Heads lead right & circle to a line

Do sa doe to a wave - Lockit

Swing thru - boys trade

Boys run - bend the line

Crosstrail - left allemande

# Caller's Corner

## THE BIG DESTROY THE LINE CONTROVERSY!!!

This situation was discussed a little last month in viewpoint. The name and figure have been the topic of discussion in other note services. I have received a letter from the author Ron Schneider requesting all of us in the notes to urge the change of name from destroy to the most logical Wheel and Cycle. The action now fits the name and should be much more acceptable. I still feel that the specific 3 & 1 line necessary for the figure limits its usage to workshops and the "deep" end of the mainstream level. Ron further suggests that if the set up of the 3 & 1 line has the couple facing in and the recycle couple on the other end then you could call Cycle & Ferris Wheel and the couple facing in will react to the Ferris Wheel. Sounds good. In order to follow this discussion further I have some examples of how you can easily set up the 3 & 1 line and use Wheel & Cycle.

**Box 1-4** Swing thru - boys run  
Girls walk and dodge - (check your 3 & 1 line)  
Wheel & Cycle - star thru - left alle.  
1P-2P

**Box 1-4** Do sa doe to a wave - girls walk and dodge  
Wheel & Cycle - swing thru  
Girls circulate - boys trade - boys run  
Wheel & deal - left alle. **Box 1-4**

1P-2P Pass the ocean - scoot back  
Boys run - boys circulate - girls walk & dodge  
Wheel & Cycle - swing thru  
Boys run - bend the line - crosstrail - left alle.

### CYCLE & FERRIS WHEEL

**Box 1-4** Swing thru - boys run  
Girls walk & dodge - girls U turn back  
Cycle & Ferris Wheel - centers pass thru  
All pass thru - left alle.

Try out the above ideas with your workshop and evaluate for your self. The 3 & 1 line is quite unusual at the mainstream level and if its confusing to your group forget it as it has a limited length of popularity, around the corner is another idea.

I compliment Ron Schneider for his thinking and taking a stand on clearing up the muddy water a little.

So many have asked for the Knitted Cape pattern so I asked Mary Nichols of Orlando if she would help me out as she has made one for me and I receive so many nice comments on my cape and since I do not knit I needed Mary's knowledge and pattern. So many thanks to Mary Nichols.

## KNITTED CAPE

2 4 oz. Skeins Knitting Worsted 2 long or circular Size 10 needles

Cast on 72 stitches (Always knit first 6 and last 6 stitches)

Row 1 - K 6, then 11, inc in next st (place marker)

K 1, inc in next st

K 4, inc in next st (place marker)

K 1, inc in next st

K 18, inc in next st (place marker)

K 1, inc in next st

K 4, inc in next st (place marker)

K 11, then K 6 sts (80 sts on needle)

Row 2 - K 6, Purl back every other row, K 6

Row 3 - On this and all other knit rows, knit to within 1 st of marker, inc in this st and slip marker. K 1, inc in next st. Work to next marker and repeat across

Continue to increase in every other row until there are 208 sts on needle.

On purl row add 2 sts to make 210 sts. Now pattern as follows with right side towards y

Row 1 - Knit - Row 2 - Purl

Row 3 - K 2 tog, 3 times(\*Y.O. & K 1 for 6 times, K 2 tog, 6 times). Repeat from \* across row and end K 2 tog, 3 times

Row 4 - Knit

These four rows make pattern. Continue in pattern for desired length (12 patterns is a good length). K garter st for 2 inches and bind off

Pick up 56 sts around neck and Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row for 1 inch. Then Purl 1 row, Knit 1 row for 8 inch. Bind off

Fold over and out and sew done.

For variation you can do borders & collar in seed stitch. I use 1 1/8 in Prim buttons covered with a seed stitch square, 7 stitches cover it. To make loops cast on 3 stitches work in seed stitch 7 or 8 inches. Make in a figure 8 loop. Sew buttons in center of border at neck edges just below collar.
