THE

Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

This month I'd like to tell you about some of the decisions made at the 1976 CALLERLAB Convention in Chicago. The delegates to the convention spent three days debating several important issues and passed resolutions which will have long lasting effects on square dancing throughout the world.

A system of caller accreditation was approved. This program will be implemented during the next two years.

A club level identification system was begun with the approval of a list of basics for the "Mainstream Plus" club level. Space prevents publishing the list here, but I'll be glad to mail a copy to anyone interested in identifying their club at this level.

The tentative mainstream list approved last year was adopted as "The CALLERLAB Mainstream Program." Procedures were adopted for an annual review of the list to permit its orderly change. The convention also recommends that 41 sessions of 2-2 1/2 hours each be used to teach the basics on this list.

Another resolution deals with the quarterly experimental movements. Nine of these movements have been used. One (Walk & Dodge) is now on the mainstream list. The remaining movements were voted on and five were retained on a list of "Mainstream Workshop Figures." To this list will be added the 1976 quarterly movements. The entire list will be voted on each year and will not exceed ten movements. Any movement remaining on the list for 3 years will be recommended for inclusion on the mainstream list. (The 5 carry-over calls: Coordinate, Ferris Wheel, 1/2 Tag, Trade & Roll, Pass the Ocean, and Recycle.)

A personal note: Never have I attended such a worthwhile meeting. Everyone in attendance was dedicated to the betterment of square dancing. Each delegate was given an opportunity to speak on every issue, and this input was carried back to the committees and considered when finalizing the resolutions. The CALLERLAB programs are not perfect, but they are a start. I hope all callers and dancers will endorse and support these programs, for only in this way can they be properly tested and needed changes made.

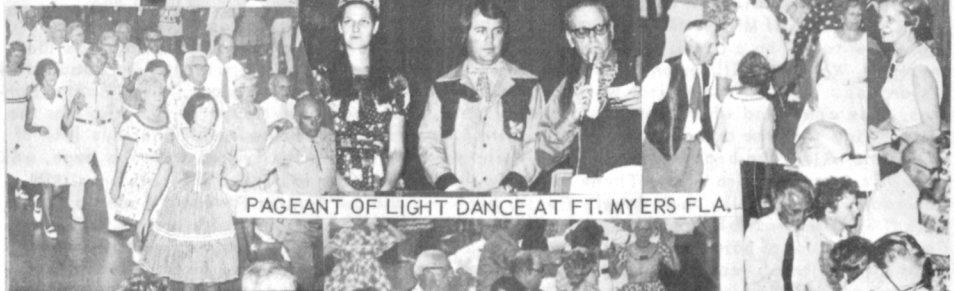

The following ground rules for good square dancing which will benefit the NEW & OLD dancer IF put to use everytime they go square dancing.

1. BE A GOOD LISTNER - Don't worry if you make a mistake So you goofed, EVERYBODY in square dancing GOOFS...The difference is that a good listner will recover quickly
2. GET INTO SQUARES QUICKLY - Never walk by a square needing a couple. - Try not to sit when a couple is needed. Beware of CLIQUES. The true spirit of square dancing is best exemplified in constant mixing within a group. The most successful clubs are those where members voluntarily mix among themselves.
3. BE A COURTEOUS DANCER - In square dancing because it is dancing the main boundary line is the defenition of dancing it-self. Motion set to Music. therefore there is little time for kicking twirling & yelling when you are a courteous & styleful dancer.
4. BE ON TIME FOR CLUBS AND CLASS - If you dance try to arrive on time & stay till the end. You may miss the best part if you do .
5. BE A COOPERATIVE DANCER - If asked to do a job try hard to always be helpful. Don't wait to be asked GO ahead & help. Such as helping your caller in & out with his equipment. Pick up ashtray cups and etc. Go on a banner stealing trip!
6. BE A THOUGHTFUL DANCER - It never hurts to be thoughtful of others by always being Clean Neat & Sweet-smelling. Always thank those who danced with you maybe they will do it again. Thank your caller or instructor for the evening of FUN. One will try to be better next time if they are truly appreciated.
7. TAKE IT EASY - There's 7 other people in your square ALL different but still there to square dance so Take It Easy. If you make a mistake don't worry, they all make mistakes but learning from ones mistakes makes a better dancer & fun for ALL.
8. BE A FRIENDLY DANCER - This is our simpliest easiest & most joyous expression & being friendly is the basic ingredient in our square dance activity. Always have something nice to say about your fellow dancer your club and your caller.
9. YOU'RE NEVER THROUGH LEARNING - Each dance no matter how many you have attended or will attend in the future will have something new if you choose to find it. Be it in the club the caller of the dancers involved. Try to be objective & never be Critical.
10. ENJOY YOURSELF & HAVE FUN - It's up to you and how much you enjoy the activity to make it fun for yourself and everyone in envolved.

EXPERIMENTAL BASICS

AH' SO . . . Lee Kopman

A variation of recycle that is easy to dance and teach, also a functional idea. From parallel waves, Ah' So ends in a column, when the waves are end to end as in a grand eight hand tidal wave you will end in parallel waves, when used in only one wave then those dancers end in a box formation.

The Teach From a box 1-4 establish a wave and start your teach from here. Tell the boys they will do the exact same action as a recycle, walking to the spot of the recycle. The girls will remain holding right hands and "come along" as the boys walk ahead. When the boys have reached the recycle spot the girls will be along side but facing the opposite direction and still holding right hands.

Example

1. Box 1-4 . Wave . Girls Trade . Ah'So . Tripple Scoot (all scoot back) Boys Run Right & Left Thru . Zero
2. Box 1-4 . Wave . Ah'So . 8 Circulate . Boys Run . Swing Thru . Boys Run Bend the Line . Cross Trail . Left Alle.
3. Box 1-4 . Wave . Ah'So . Girls Run . Swing Thru . Girls Trade . Recycle Dive Thru . Square Thru 3/4 . Left Alle.
4. 1P-2P . Do Sa Doe To A Wave . Ah'So . Split Circulate - Boys Run . Zero
5. 1P-2P . Do Sa Doe To A Wave . Girls Trade . Ah'So . Scoot Back . Boys Run Cross Trail . Left Alle.

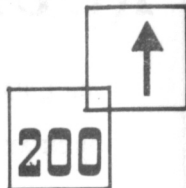

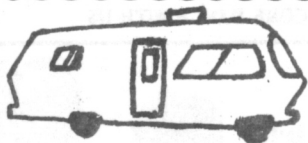
