Among the Trail Dances scheduled in California will be the Tenth Annual Cup of Gold, Sonora, June 18-20; Palm Springs, June 19; and Camarillo, June 22. Should your area be planning a Trail Dance please notify: 25th National S/D Convention, PO Box 1976, Dept. 25, Vista, CA 92083.

For those traveling from foreign Countries a bilingual information center will be available.

The Showcase of Ideas, Publications Display, and Square Dance Hall of Fame Exhibit will be open daily from 10A.M. to 9P.M. A stroll through this display will provide insight into various items utilized in the promotion of our

activity by numerous associations and federations throughout the country.

Daily from 10A.M. to 5P.M. a room has been set aside to afford the opportunity to meet some of the most outstanding personalities in the movement. There will be a different VIP in the room every half hour.

Nationally known callers Lee Helsel, Johnny LeClair and Bill Peters will conduct the Callers Seminar daily from 11A.M. to 1P.M. and 2 to 4 P.M. Covered during these sessions will be all facets of the caller's techniques. Other special sessions designed for the caller are the Newer Caller Instruction Panels, planned for each day and offering individualized help for the beginner caller. Caller-Club Relations will provide views of what is expected from both caller and club. Bill Castner will conduct the Exhibition Panel, for those interested in starting an exhibition group. Assisting the handicapped will be the subject of another panel.

For the ladies, such panels as Petticoat Power and the Sew and Create Clinic will provide pertinent material specifically designed to enlighten all dancers in the woman's outlook. General interest panels include Festival Planning, Singles Panel, Camping Panel, Public Relations Seminar, and an After Party Clinic. Coverage of the subject of Leadership will be handled during the Organization Round Table and the Club Leadership Seminar.

The round dancer and contra dancer have not been overlooked. These subjects will be part of the Round Dance Seminar, Round Dance Panel, Round Dance Clinic for Square Dancers, the All-Level Round Dance Clinic, a Contra Panel and Contra Clinic.

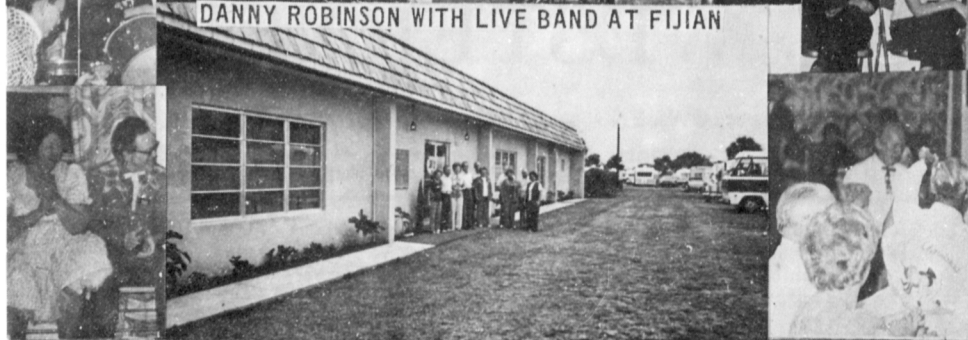

THE

Challenging Mainstream

BY GIL T. CROSBY - Gainesville

This column was begun in hopes of providing callers with interesting and challenging mainstream choreography. In travelling around the state I have been surprised to discover a large number of dancers read the column regularly. I feel this shows that dancers are interested in gaining a deeper understanding of the basics that make-up modern square dancing.

I have discovered this dancer interest because I have been frequently asked to explain two terms: Box 1--4 and 1P2P. I would briefly like to explain these terms this month. These terms refer to dancer relationships produced in the following manner:

Box 1--4: from squared set, heads (or sides) square thru. A figure beginning here means the dancers are in this position relative to the other dancers no matter how the caller puts them there. A figure ending in this position may be followed by any figure which begins here rather than calling the allemande.

1P2P: from a squared set, heads (or sides) lead right, circle to a line. The statements above concerning figures starting and ending at Box 1--4 are also true for those starting and ending at 1P2P.

So dancers, get 4 red and 4 black checkers, number the couples, paint noses on them, and work through the following figures using Centers In without Cast Off.

Heads Star Thru - Pass Thru
Centers In - Ends' Fold
Peel Off - Bend the Line
Square Thru - Trade By
Left Alle. (Box 1--4)

1P2P Centers Box the Gnat
Centers Square Thru
Ends Star Thru
Centers In - Ends Fold
Peel Off - Bend the Line
Star Thru - Pass Thru - Left Alle.

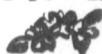

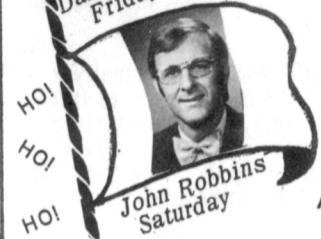

EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

Not a lot of excitement in the experimental lab this month. The best of a weak month are both extensions from the Drift family. Both danceable but somewhat similar so in the interest of keeping the dancers sanity it will be best to show these at different times rather than both on the same night.

DRIFT BACK - Dick Kenyon

Normal couple back to back Boys action is the same as in a Drift Around, or actually a Run Right into the vacating Girls position. The Girls will start the Zoom action as in a Drift Around but at the point in the center of the set where they meet, the girls will turn thru and come back to extend right hands to the awaiting boy. From lines back to back you end in a parallel wave set up with girls facing out and boys facing in. When the starting set up is the Trade By Formation you end up in a Column. The action equals a Boys Run.

1P-2P Pass thru - Drift Back -
Scoot back - boys run
Crosstrail - left alle.

1P-2P Pass thru - Drift Back -
Split circulate - (box) boys run
Slide thru - swing thru
Turn thru - left alle.

Starting from the trade by position to end in columns

1P-2P Star thru - pass thru
Drift back - 8 circulate
Boys run - square thru 3/4
Trade by - left alle.

1C-2C (set up from a box 1-4 Star thru)
Square thru four - Drift back - 8 circulate
Boys run - swing thru
Girls circulate - boys trade - boys run
Bend the line - square thru 3/4 - left alle.

I feel Drift Around is a quite acceptable workshop idea which continues to explore the Drift Family. It may help to have the Girls hesitate in the ocean wave formed at the 1/2 Zoom position so they can see where the turn thru starts its action to bring them Back to the boys.

NOTICE I KEEP SAYING CALLER'S TAW RATHER THAN WIFE; AT HOME YOUR'RE HIS WIFE, AT THE DANCE YOU FILL ANOTHER ROLE NOT NECESSARILY A WIFELY ONE, BUT ONE THAT HAS BEEN CREATED BY PUBLIC OPINION AND EXPECTATION.

HOW IMPORTANT IS SHE TO SQUARE DANCING IN GENERAL? SHE MUST SET A GOOD EXAMPLE BY BEING UNDERSTANDING - SHARING - RESPONSIBLE - FRIENDLY - HELPER(WITHOUT DISRUPTING) - POISED- DEMONSTRATOR OF DANCES - CHARMING - GRACEFUL - BEAUTIFULLY DRESSED - HOSTESS AND AN ADVISOR ON SQUARE DANCE ETIQUETTE AND ON TOP OF THIS SHE MUST CONVINCCE THE DANCERS THAT SQUARE DANCING IS FUN.

WHAT IS HER ROLE TO HER CALLER-SPOUSE IN PARTICULAR? IT IS HER GREATEST RESPONSIBILITY TO SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGE HER HUSBAND TO THE FULLEST. HER ROLE INCLUDES BEING A BOOKING AGENT - SECRETARY - TRAVELING HOUSEKEEPER - PUBLIC RELATIONS AGENT - SOUND JUDGER - PROGRAM PLANNER (FOR SPECIAL EVENTS, SKITS, & ETC.) - EVALUATOR OF HIS PERFORMANCE AS A TEACHER AND AS A CALLER (TO BE A CRITIC ONLY WHEN NECESSARY) - SEES TO IT THAT HE TAKES OFF FOR A DANCE IN PLENTY OF TIME WITH A CAR FILLED WITH GAS - HAVING HIS MEALS READY AND HIS CLOTHS WAITING - AND TO CREATE A PLEASANT ATMOSPHERE SO WHEN HE TAKES HIS MICROPHONE IN HAND HE WILL CALL A GREAT DANCE.

WHEN WE GO OVER ALL THE THINGS A TAW MUST BE , SHE WOULD HAVE TO BE A SUPER, SUPER WOMAN TO ACHIEVE ALL THAT IS REQUIRED EVERY TIME HER HUSBAND GOES TO CALL. BUT ONE CAN LOOK AT ONESELF AND PICK OUT THE GOOD QUALITIES THAT SHE HAS AND BY USING THOSE AND WORKING ON THE OTHER THINGS SHE WILL ACCOMPLISH MUCH.

BEING A CALLER TAW AND WIFE IS A PLEASURE BUT IT'S NOT THE ONLY THING, BEING A DANCER IS FUN, TOO.
