

of Sarasota, Florida Born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin Died April 4, 1976



## Caller's Corner

JACK LASRY - Miami MAINSTREAM EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP

TRACK I. II, III & IIII Dick Bayer I held back one month on this figure until I had the opportunity to talk with the author regarding one of the Track endings, namely Track I. Some of the other note services were so anxious to publish that they just print blindly!! Dick had the same ending position for Track I and Track II while having different endings for Trach II and III. The Trach Figures Are Really A Tag Type Action From A Double Pass Thru Position That Is Set Up As Follows - If you have your dancers approach the Track figures as follows they will fully understand the action not just the move to a spot they think is cor rect. The Action starts from a Completed Double Pass Thru formation. The boys are in the left Track and the Girls in the right Track. The boys will work together in a tandum formation, the trailing boy following in behind the lead boy and the girls will do the same. The dancers will do what amounts to a tandum partner trade with the two boys walking around the girls to the right as the girls in single file turn inside the boys to end back in a Double Pass Thru Formation With The Same Lead Dancers. Now you are ready to continue into the tag portion. If the lead couple steps into a wave you have the ending Track I Formation. A wave between the outside couples facing in. Track II has the dancers move single file into 1/2 tag position ending in two parallel ocean waves. Track III moves to a 3/4 tag formation with the wave in the center and the outside couples facing out. Track IIII is a full tag ending back in the completed double pass thru formation.

For Mainstream Dancing The Track || ending in parallel ocean waves is the best, for extended dancing the Track Lis nice in that you can follow with Ping Pong Circulate or Chain Reaction. Lets explore...

TRACK II 1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Double pass thru-Track II

(Two parrallel normal waves)

Swing thru - turn thru - left alle.

TRACK | 1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Double pass thru - Track I

Centers swing thru - turn thru - left alle.

TRACK III 1P-2P Pass thru - wheel & deal Double pass thru - Track III

Centers swing thru turn thru Leads partner trade - left alle.

Your completed double pass thru formation for the start of the Track figures could be made up of girls in the left track and the boys in the right track so that your ending ocean waves will have boys in the

center and the girls on the ends

P-2P Right & left thru - rollaway 1/2 sashay Pass thru - wheel & deal - double pass thru Track II - boys trade - turn thru - left alle.

Setting up the completed D.P.T. using tag the line odd line make ups IP-2P Pass thru - tag the line

Track II - splite circulate

Swing thru - boys trade - turn thru - left alle.

Kind of much all at once so keep the position stuff for your workshops and advance groups

1P 2P Pass thru Wheel & deal

Recycle pass thru left alle.

1P 2P Pass thru wheel & deal

Centers lock it square thru four Swing thru turn thru left alle.





Quarterly Movements News Realease

Chase Right Lee Kopman

The action starts from couples back to back. On the command Chase Right, those in the girls'

positions do a "large" (but not wide) zoom action brings the girl to a facing in position. The persons in the boys' positions will run or fold into the vacated girls' positions and then the boys circulate one position. The boys will end facing out. From normal lines of four facing out, the Chase Right call will place the square in two parallel ocean waves with the girls facing in and the boys facing out. When the action takes place with the couples back to back in a trade by formation the result is a column formation. All the flow is to the RIGHT as the dancing action takes place, thus the name Chase Right. (It is possible to Chase Left or LEFT Chase, however, for mainstream dancing the basic Chase Right is suggested.) NOTE: A simple zero figure will allow you to easily become acquainted with the actions.

Normal Facing Couples:

Pass thru - - Chase right

Boys run - - Zero (Back to original starting position)

#### DANCING CHASE RIGHT

Heads lead right . Circle to a line Pass thru - - Chase right Boys run Right & left thru

Crosstrail - - Left allemande

Heads lead right . Circle to a line Pass thru - - Chase right Scoot back - Girls run Curlique - - Boys run Pass thru - - Left allemande

NOTE: The above figures end in a wave

Heads lead right . Circle to a line Star thru - - Pass thru Chase right - - Boys run Square thru 3/4 Left Allemande

Heads lead right . Circle to a line - - Star thru Pass thru - - Chase right Single file circulate one spot Girls run - - Box the gnat Right & Left thru - - Left Allemande

NOTE: The above figures end in a column

During the coming Quarter the Committee suggests the review of Dixie Style to an Ocean Wave rather than the selection of another new experimental figure. Dixie Style to a wave is part of the Mainstream program but in many areas could use a good dancing review and some attention given to how it can best fit into the club dancing program.

The action starts with facing couples in motion or in single file. The girls extend right hands and move by to extend left hands to the waiting man. The left hands are joined and as the dancers move by the left hands remain joined and the men reach to join right hands with each other causing all dancers to turn as the left handed wave is formed. The nature of the action leads to the suggestion that Dixie Style be preceded with a right and left thru or square thru % courtesy turn to help lead into the starting action of the girls leading for the Dixie Style. This type of start smooths out the entry into the figure for better dancing. Here are some examples:

Heads lead right. Circle to a line Right and left thru (Ladies lead) Dixie style to a wave Boys trade Boys cross run to the far end Swing thru - Boys run Bend the line - Left allemande

Heads lead right . Circle to a line - - Square thru 3/4 Courtesy turn your partner (Ladies lead) Dixie style to a wave Boys trade - - Boys run Bend the line - - Box the gnat Right & left thru - - Crosstrail Left Allemande
