**REGISTRATIONS - 1977 NATIONAL** The registration form for the 26th National Square Dance Convention is the first link between dancer and convention, and the accuracy of it's preparation determines the speed of it's implementation into the overall processing system. As of Sept. 1, 1976, approximately 9300 dancers have signified their intentions. One problem has become apparent which concerns dancers, registering from this point on who desire to room with, stay close to, or reside in the same hotel/motel accommodations with friends, relatives, or other club members. Registration Committee members are willing, anxious and able to fill the requests of applicants wishing to room together must send their applications all together at the same time. Very often it is impossible to fill requests for rooms near others who have registered earlier.


**CALLERLAB RELEASE** At the 25th National Square Dance Convention, many records were set in several areas. Certainly attendance and panels were among the standout records. There was an additional record set by individual members of Callerlab and certain other callers who have been invited to attend Callerlab. Specifically, there were 574 callers listed in the Convention program directory. Of these 166 were Callerlab Members and an additional 103 were Callerlab Invitees. There were 34 Callerlab members on the panels and 17 Callerlab members serving on the Contra programs. The Callerlab Board of Governors were also very well represented with 16 of their number at the National. If you put this on a percentage: as is 47% of the registered callers at the Nationals were members of or invited to attend Callerlab.

ARE YOU PROUD YOU'RE A SQUARE DANCER? Think about that....  
How many hours of square dancing have you enjoyed? If you can be honest & admit you have enjoyed more than half of your dancing, then you should be able to convince one non dancing couple to join the activity with you....  
SEPTEMBER is National Square Dance Week and as a square dancer you should be well informed of this. It should be stressed each dancer now dancing SHOULD have a least one new couple ready to take to a new class. If you do not then you as a dancer have not helped the square dance movement and you are depriving someone from FUN & FELLOWSHIP. The average time a couple dances is two years so this means we must have new dancers every year & your job as a dancer should be to see that you get ONE couple. One is not much so get busy and let's make 1976 the best and biggest for new dancers.

In the January issue we have the Raglan Cape and there were errors and here are the corrections.

The error for knitting the ~~R~~ Ragan Cape appeared in the directions for increasing.

Row 1 K6 then K11, Increase in next st. . Place marker  
K1, inc. in next stitch  
K4, inc. in next stitch. Place marker  
K1, inc. in next stitch.  
K18, inc. in next stitch. Place marker  
K1, inc. in next stitch  
K4, inc. in next stitch. Place marker  
K1, inc. Next stitch -----this was left out  
K 11, then K. 6

Also around the neck.

Knit 1 row, Purl 1 row for one inch. Then purl 1 row Knit 1 row, for one inch. NOT FOR EIGHT AS IT SAYS TO DO IN THE JAN. MAGAZINE.

HINTS FROM Bette Daggy.

1. When hanging drip-dry clothes put a piece of plastic - the kind that comes from the cleaners on the clothes hanger first- Then hang the garment over the plastic. It will dry in half the usual time.
2. Buttons stay on longer if you coat the ~~XXXXX~~ centers with the colorless nail polish. This seals the thread.
3. Cover cookie sheet with several layers of foil and when one batch of cookies are cooked- remove the top sheet of foil & set it aside to cool and refill cooked sheet with more cookies.

# Caller's Corner



JACK LASRY - Miami

THE EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOP - Experienced Dancers

WIND THE BOBBIN - Lee Kopman

This figure comes down the pike as a challenge figure but with a slight adaption to use hands for the turns instead of a weave action the figure has GOOD workshop appeal. Interesting starting action and well timed I encourage your experimentation. THE TEACH - Starting formation is a column best started from a 1P-2P line then Curlique. Have the Girls recognize that they are the leaders in each box formation also they are the first and third dancers in each column, For your teach have the Girls Peel Off (turn away from the adjacent boy as they make an about face turn) and have the Boys step ahead to join right hands with the boy he meets. This will set up a left handed wave with boys as centers and girls on the end. The action continues easily seen as the Girls circulate two position while the boys cast off 3/4 - center boys in the wave trade then turn 3/4 with the end boy to end back in a left handed wave. TO DANCE not walk the figure have the column set up and have the Girls peel off and circulate double as the Boys step ahead and start the 3/4 arm turn etc. If you follow the teaching guide of forming the left handed wave after the girls peel off and the boys step ahead you will have no problems at all. NOTE You can place the Boys in the 1 & 3 position in the column to do the Peel Off action as well as setting up left handed column by using a Left Touch 1/4 and then Wind The Bobbin.

### Dancing Wind The Bobbin

- 1P-2P Curlique-Wind The Bobbin  
Boys cross run - recycle  
Squares thru 3/4 - trade by - left alle.  
box 1-4
- 1P-2P Curlique-Wind The Bobbin  
Left swing thru - boys circulate - girls trade  
Girls run - bend the line  
Crosstrail - left alle.

Examples with boys in the Peel off position

- 1P-2P Right & left thru - rollaway 1/2 sashay  
Curlique - Wind The Bobbin  
Girls run - bend the line  
Right & left thru - star thru - pass thru  
Trade by - left alle.
- 1P-2P Pass thru - Tag the line face in  
Curlique - Wind the Bobbin - girls run  
Bend the line - slide thru - left alle.
